Subject: Archaeological watching brief at Churchstyle Farm, Stockland		
Description: Monitoring was undertaken during groundworks for the construction of a swimming pool at Churchstyle Farm, Stockland (planning application No 07/0008/FUL, East Devon District Council). This included the removal of topsoil and subsoil within the footprint of the new pool (an area 10m x 14m) and the excavation of foundation trenches for the new enclosing building. The layer sequence consisted of: 0-0.2m: Dark reddish brown silty clay loam (topsoil) 0.2-0.5m: Firm reddish brown silty clay containing charcoal flecks (subsoil) 0.5m+: Firm reddish brown clay (natural) No archaeological features or deposits were exposed. One flint waste flake of prehistoric date was recovered from the topsoil.	Ref: EA project 6299	Date: 31.10.07 – 16.11.07

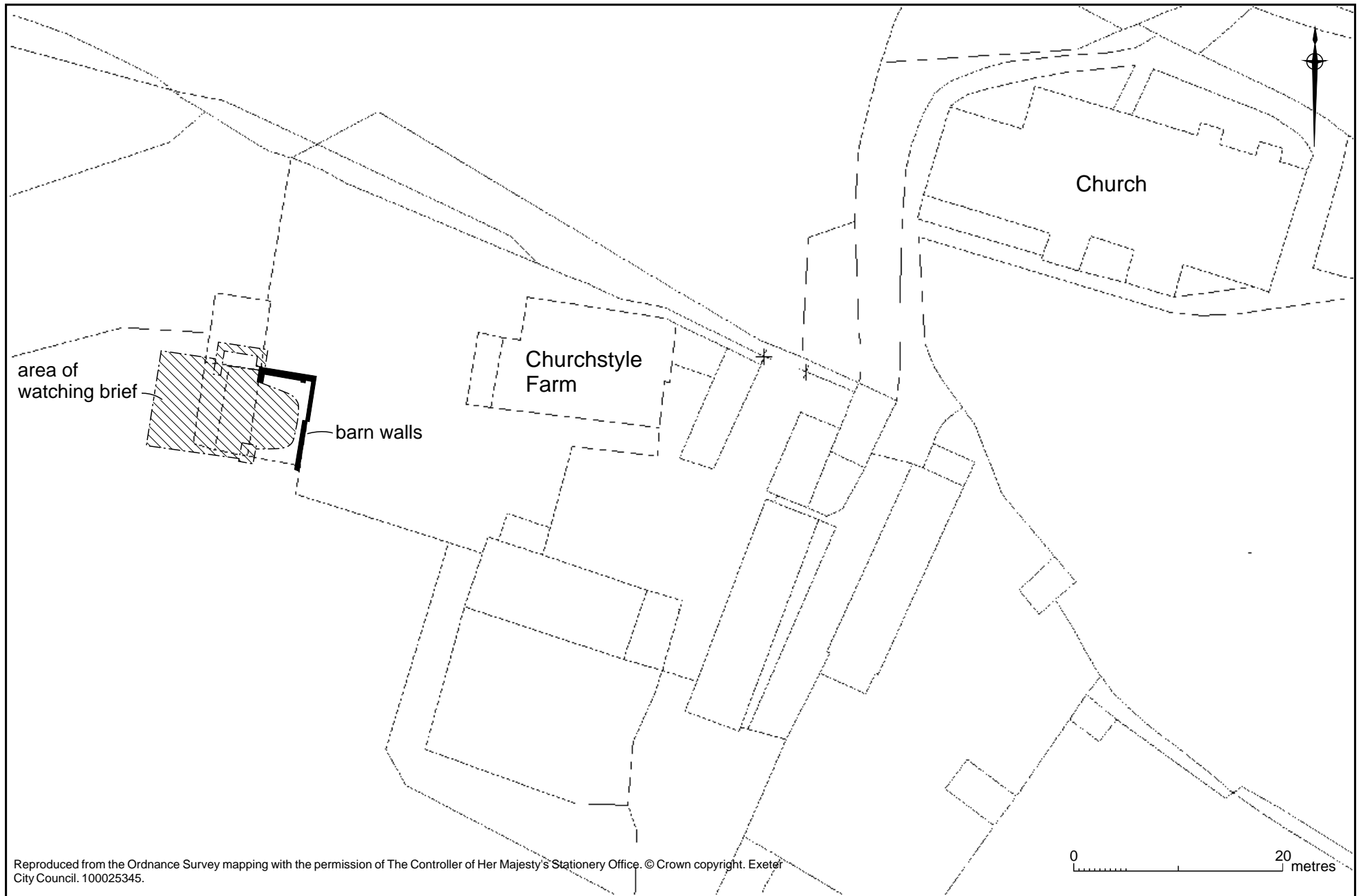


Fig. 1 Location plan (1:500)
