<p>Description of works.</p> <p>A watching brief was maintained during removal of topsoil across a rectangular area measuring 46m east / west by 22m north / south. Clean natural subsoil was exposed across approximately two-thirds of the site, at depths ranging from 200mm - 450mm. No archaeological features or deposits were exposed. Within the eastern third of the site topsoil removal did not fully expose natural subsoil but return visits were not made to this area as no foundation or other deeper excavations were to be undertaken.</p> <p>A number of finds were retrieved, mixed within the topsoil. These included pottery, glass and modern building material fragments with a date range of 18th - 20th century.</p>
