

Site Diary: Moorhall Road south watching brief (1C21CVVAM)

Thursday 1st April 2021

Arrived on site this 8am this morning to find most of area of compound watching brief had already been stripped and was under new ground consolidation. Contractors said that there were small areas either side still to strip but would not be doing that work today.



Tuesday 6th April 2021

Maggie Cook covered the watching brief today. She observed the stripping of the north-east of the new compound area, by the main entrance of Moorhall Road, to the top of the gravel. No archaeological remains present.

Wednesday 7th April 2021

I continued the observation of the stripping of the north-east of the new compound area. This completed the anticipated work for the time being. No archaeological remains were observed although several large recent tree boles were observed and some modern truncation of the eastern limit of the excavation area. The contractors were unclear whether there would be further ground reduction works but there would not be any further works for several days.



Wednesday 7th April 2021

I returned to site this morning to complete the surveying the watching brief area.
