## Constitution

1. The Group shall be known as the Pedieval Pottery Research Group.
2. The office of the Group shall be situate within Great Britain.
3. The object of the Group is to further the study of ceramies from the end of Roman rule in Britain to the advent of the Tudor dymasty in the late fifteenth century by holding innual ileetings and by the publication of a bulletin and any other way that the Comittee may approve.
4. The membership shall consist of Ordinary Members.
5. The expenses of the Group shall be met from subscriptions and such funds as the Group may by donation or otherwise acquire. Each member shall pay his subscription on joining the Group and shall then be entitled to receive a copy of the bulletin for the current year.
The subscription shall be 01.50 p. per amum.
Any member who is more than twelve months in arrears with his subscription shall be struck off the membership list until the subscription is renewed. The subcsriptions and all other property zoquired for the purposes of the Group shall be regarded as being vegted in the officers of the Group as trustees for the members.
6. Attendance at Annual Meetings and any other events that may be organised by the Group shall be open to anyone irrespective of whether they are subscribing members.
7. The Committee of the Group shall consist of the President, the Eonoraxy Secretary, the Fonorary Treasurer, the Fonorary Iditors and three Ordinary Merbers and shall be elected at the Annual Meetings.
All nominations for election to the Comittee shall be submitted to the Eonorary Secretary by the first of February each year.
8. Subject to any resolution of the Group the Fresident shall not hold office for more than three consecutive years.
9. The Honorary Secretary and Eonorary Treasurer shall hold office for one year but shall then be elisible for re-election by the Annual Neeting. The Editors and Ordinary Members of Committee shall hold office for three years. Retiring members of Comittee shall not be impediately eligible for remelection.
10. The affairs of the Group shall be managed by the Comittee. At any meeting of the Comittee the presence of five members shall constitute a quorum. The Committee shell present a report of its proceedings to the Annual jeeting of the Group. Casual vacancies among the Officers shall be filled by comopting members of the Group by the Cormittee until the next Annual Meeting.
11. The Annual Meeting of the Group shall be held on a date approved by the Comittee.
12. The Committee shall have the power to appoint from the members of the Group any other Committees which may be required from time to time.
13. The Committee shall have the power to fix the amount of any fees that it may be desirable to be charged to members or guests at any function of the Group. They shall also have the power to pay such honoraria for assistance as they think desirable.
14. Any proposal for amendment to the Constitution of the Group must be submitted to the Annual Meeting. The text of the proposed amendment shall be circulated to members with preliminary details of the Annual Meeting prozrame. No amendment shali be regarded as adopted unless two thirds of the members present vote in favour of it.
