

## MEDIEVAL CERAMICS ANNUAL BIBLIOGRAPHY 1984

Having agreed in November 1984 to undertake the task of producing a yearly bibliography of pottery publications and references for Medieval Ceramics, it seemed desirable for a maiden effort to appear at the earliest opportunity, in the interest of getting Group reactions to and criticisms of both the content (as presently understood, any and all published primary references to medieval pottery from the British Isles), and format (nationally; by county within England; and with codes indicating the nature and extent of the information, as computerised for the MPRG's main Bibliography).

The 1984 Bibliography represents about 75% journal coverage, and partial coverage of books and monographs.

The excellent coverage for many areas is owing to the fine work carried out with despatch by Duncan Brown, Carol Cunningham, Anne Jenner, Sarah Jennings, Nigel MacPherson-Grant, Mike Ponsford, Janet Rutter, Pauline Skipworth and Mike Stokes, all of whom I would like to take this opportunity to thank.

As for readers from areas where time did not allow coverage at the same level - and authors of outstanding pottery monographs published in 1984 but not appearing here! - I hope and expect that you will be much better served in 1985.
