

MEDIEVAL CERAMICS ANNUAL BIBLIOGRAPHY 1985

An estimated four-fifths or more of the available sources relevant to British medieval pottery studies have been covered for the 1985 bibliography, which consists of 354 entries, of which 324 come from journals and thirty from books or monographs. Sixty-eight of an estimated seventy-five relevant national journals were searched, and sixty-five of about one hundred relevant county journals. Of the forty-two periodical titles remaining, many have either not appeared this year, or are of marginal relevance.

Before summarizing the results obtained, it must be mentioned that coverage was better in some places than others. Good coverage was obtained for Avon, Bedfordshire, Buckinghamshire, Cambridgeshire, Cheshire, Cleveland, Cornwall, Cumbria, Derbyshire, Devon, Durham, Gloucestershire, Hertfordshire, Isle of Man, Lancashire, Lincolnshire, Greater London, Greater Manchester, Norfolk, Northamptonshire, Northumberland, Oxfordshire, Somerset, Staffordshire, Suffolk, Tyne and Wear, West Midlands County, Wales, Scotland and Ireland.

Coverage for Dorset, Hampshire, Hereford and Worcester, Humberside, Northumberland, Shropshire, Warwickshire and the Channel Isles was partial; entries for Essex arrived too late for compilation. The problem areas were Kent, Yorkshire, Wiltshire and Berkshire, Surrey and Sussex -- new compilers are urgently sought for these areas.

An aspect of coverage which was difficult to control or even to assess without going over contributors' results individually, was the extent to which mentions of medieval pottery finds, providing no information beyond the find-spot, appear in the bibliography. Such entries were supplied by a minority of contributors. They were too unspecific to appear in the Index, and very time-consuming to collect. In the interests of formulating a policy regarding such notes, the views of members of the group concerning the desirability of requesting contributors to submit such entries in years to come, would be welcome.

This year an Index has been drawn up, allowing an over-view of the concentrations of pottery studies reported in the past year. The vast majority of articles concerned pottery found at a particular site, but the interest and usefulness of the small number of 'synthetic' articles, and the somewhat larger number of 'multi-site' articles, was often commented upon by the contributors.

There was documentary or historical dating evidence for only a very few (twenty-one, about 5%) of the pottery finds. One of these was Middle Saxon (164), one Saxo-Norman (238), one early medieval (120) and two were of Highly Decorated type (152, 170), otherwise the dating evidence all pertained to the post-medieval or modern periods. The one coin hoard pot reported on was post-medieval.

Fifty-nine reports mentioned kilns, wasters or other industrial evidence. There were no Early Saxon and only one significant Middle Saxon example; several Saxo-Norman and early medieval examples, and many from all the succeeding periods, with a notably large proportion of Highly Decorated examples. Forty-one instances of imported wares were mentioned, belonging to all periods except the Early Saxon.

Floor tiles and roof furniture were published from Avon, Buckinghamshire, Cleveland, Devon, Dorset, Essex, Gloucestershire, Hampshire, Kent, Lincolnshire, Greater London, Northamptonshire, Oxfordshire, Shropshire, Surrey, Tyne and Wear, Warwickshire, Wiltshire, Yorkshire and Ireland.

Finally, one perhaps surprising result to emerge from this cursory study of the 1985 bibliography concerns quantification and fabric description. Despite the time and verbiage devoted to these subjects by the Group up to the present time, only nineteen articles (and fewer authors) provided both this year; it would be interesting to know why.
