MEDIEVAL POTTERY RESEARCH GROUP

Secretary's Report 1987-1988

This year has been another active year for the Group. The volume of work grows year by year, as do the range of activities to report - a healthy sign for a growing organisation. Four committee meetings have been held, at Hawarden (Flintshire), York, Carlisle and the Southampton conference. The usual reports from the Treasurer and Editors have been presented at each meeting, along with a growing list of other topics.

The perennial items are beginning to see the light at the end of the tunnel. The Bibliography, under the guidance of Peter Davey, is making steady progress, despite setbacks during the year. The Glossary is at last under full steam and draft mock ups of the computer-printed text and drawings should be ready for the Southampton conference. As a visual aids index, a series of wall charts has been devised. The Manual, reported last year, is in final draft form and should be ready for circulation at Southampton, complete with draft artwork.

The series of Peterborough-type meetings proposed last year were held at nine venues throughout the British Isles. A series of further meetings throughout 1988 are planned, with much more of a workshop/practical bias and run by a number of different people. Suggestions for themes and venues would be welcomed. The meeting on the medieval kitchen, held jointly with the Finds Research Group and the Vernacular Architecture Group at Leeds in October, appears to have been well received, for over 160 people attended. The follow-on meeting, a residential weekend conference sponsored by the University of Leeds, is to be held on 16-18 September 1988 with the theme of the medieval house.

The Fund Raising Sub-Committee have met three times and have explored a number of avenues for funding. They have proposed a leaflet designed for circulation to potential sponsors. The exhibition, proposed last year, has also been discussed. Approaches have been made to HBMC for possible assistance both with the designing and funding.

The unavoidable problem of having the three elected ordinary members and the President retiring at the same time has been resolved by one ordinary member retiring this year. Terry Pearson has agreed to stand down, but will be co-opted onto the committee to see through the Glossary and the Manual.

Following the initiative taken by the Society for Medieval Archaeology to publish summaries of the activities of specialist groups in its journal, a report on the Group's work in 1987 is to appear in the next Medieval Archaeology.
