The bibliography is arranged with entries for the British Isles under the headings General, Channel Isles, England, Ireland, Isle of Man, Scotland and Wales followed by a section on the Netherlands. General works relating to each section appear first, listed in alphabetical order by author, followed by topographical entries which are arranged alphabetically by county and then by town or parish. The Greater London entries are grouped alphabetically by Borough. The Annual Bibliography for 1996 is the first for which the text has been generated direct from the MPRG National Bibliography database. The opportunity has been taken to modify the conventions used in the former in accordance with the latter: in the titles of the books and articles, upper case letters are used only for proper names; for books, the total number of pages is given; the date of publication is given in brackets throughout; two new general dating codes, AS for Anglo-Saxon and EC for Early Christian, have been introduced.
