The bibliography covers the British Isles and is divided into six sections: General, Channel Isles, England, Ireland, Isle of Man, Scotland and Wales. The regional sections start with general works, listed in alphabetical order by author, followed by topographical entries, which are arranged alphabetically by county and then by town or parish. The Greater London entries are grouped alphabetically by Borough. Information about the content of each entry is provided using the codes which are listed in full at the end of the bibliography. The 1997 bibliography has been generated directly from computerised entries held in the MPRG National Bibliography database. The database is arranged according to the old county structure and so this bibliography does not take account of recent boundary changes.
