The bibliography covers the British Isles and is divided into seven sections: General, Channel Isles, England, Ireland, Isle of Man, Scotland and Wales. The regional sections start with general works, listed in alphabetical order by author, followed by topographical entries, which are arranged alphabetically by county and then by town or parish. The Greater London entries are grouped alphabetically by Borough. Information about the content of each entry is provided using the codes, which are listed in full at the end of the Annual Bibliography for 1999 also in this volume (see below pp. 193–202). The 1998 bibliography has been generated from computerised entries held in the MPRG National Bibliography database. The database has been compiled using the old county structure and so this bibliography does not take account of recent boundary changes.

For the sake of brevity, the full titles of compilation articles from national and county journals which list completed archaeological projects have not been included here. Thus, the site specific entries from *Medieval Archaeol* 41 (1997) within pages 241 to 328 are from B S Nenk, C Haith and J Bradley (eds), 'Medieval Britain and Ireland in 1996'; those from *Trans Leicester Archaeol Hist Soc* 72 (1998) within pages 156 to 195 are from R Buckley (ed.), 'Archaeology in Leicester and Rutland 1997'; those from *Proc Suffolk Inst of Archaeol Hist* 39 (2) (1998) within pages 209 to 245 are from E Martin, C Pendleton and J Plouviez (eds.), 'Archaeology in Suffolk 1997' and those from *Post-medieval Archaeol* 31 (1997) within pages 257 to 332 are from M Ponsford and R Jackson (eds.) 'Post-medieval Britain and Ireland in 1996'. It is the volume year, 1997, which is given for volume 31 of *Post-medieval Archaeology* rather than the year of publication (which was 1998).
