

THE SEPULCHRAL BRASSES OF
BUCKINGHAMSHIRE.

DEANERY OF BUCKINGHAM.—(Second portion).

Sixteen Churches—twenty-four Brasses in eleven Churches.

BEAUCHAMPTON.

1. Inscr:

I Mathew Pigot the sonne of Thomas Pigot
Esquire of the hovse of Beavchampton do ly
here byried, Ivly, 8. 1598. I was for some twenty
yeres pastovre of this Chvrch & of Calvertō
where I preached the sincere doctrine of Christ
Iesvs, and accordingly beleving, livinge, and
dienge, doe now most comfortablie feele
the inestemable benefite thereof, leavinge
vnto yov my most lovinge and beloved
people as a perpetvall monvmet of my love
and last farewell these fewe* lines toe
pvt yov alwayes in mind to do the like y^t
so in ovr bodies and sovles we may shortly
meete together againe in heavenly felī
city and immortality. Amen.

2. William Bawdyn, blacksmith, in civil dress. 1600.

Inscr: as follows:

Bholde I happie am indeed, of fleshly man reicast
Who having changed y^e meaner state do now enioy y^e best.
For seinge the fixed order set of thinges by God's decree,
Hath, finisht mortall lyfe, to live with God eternally.

* The lines here alluded to are engraved in stone, and are as follows:—
Here yov maie se as in a glas
Hov swift yovr tim awaie doth pas.
Hold fast my chain,
It is thy gain,
Awai thov mvst
Vnto thy dvst.

Here lyeth the bodye of William Bawdyn of
Bechampton, blacksmyth, who dyed the viij day
of October, in the yere of ovr Lord God, 1600.

3. Ales Baldwyn, 1611. Inscr: as follows:

Here lyeth y^e body of Ales Baldwyn davght^r
to William Mathew of Calve^rton Esqvier,
the wife of George Baldwyn, by whom she
had issve 2 sonnes and 2 davghters, viz: Willm,
George, Ianc, and Isabell, and ended her
dayes in childbed and in y^e fayth of Christ
the xxith of Febrvary Ano Dni

1611, Aged xxx yeares.

4. Inscr:

Will: Elmor was bvrjed
the 19th of March 1652.

CALVERTON.

John Rokys, in civil dress, & Johan his wyfe, 1519.

Inscr: as follows:

Of yo' charite pray for the soules of John Rokys &
Johan his wyfe the whiche
John decessed the III day of Nouembre the yer' of o'
lord m^v^cxix and Johan
decessed y^e day of y^e yer' of o' lord m^v^c
o whose soull ihu haue mcj.

MAIDS MORTON.

Two shields, on each of which a chevron charged with three fleur-de-lis; figures and inscription lost.

According to Browne Willis this brass was in memory of two maiden sisters of the family of Peovers, who rebuilt the Church, C. 1450; he thus blazons the arms: Ar. on a chevron gu. 3 fleur-de-lis, or.
