

Pottery from 1S22NSPTT

The post-Roman pottery was recorded using the conventions of the Museum of London Type-Series (eg. Vince 1985).

The pottery assemblage comprised 2 sherds with a total weight of 299g. They were both fragments of modern horticultural earthenwares (London fabric HORT). One, weighing 1g occurred in Trench 5 context 501 and the other, weighing 12g, was from Trench 7 context 701.
