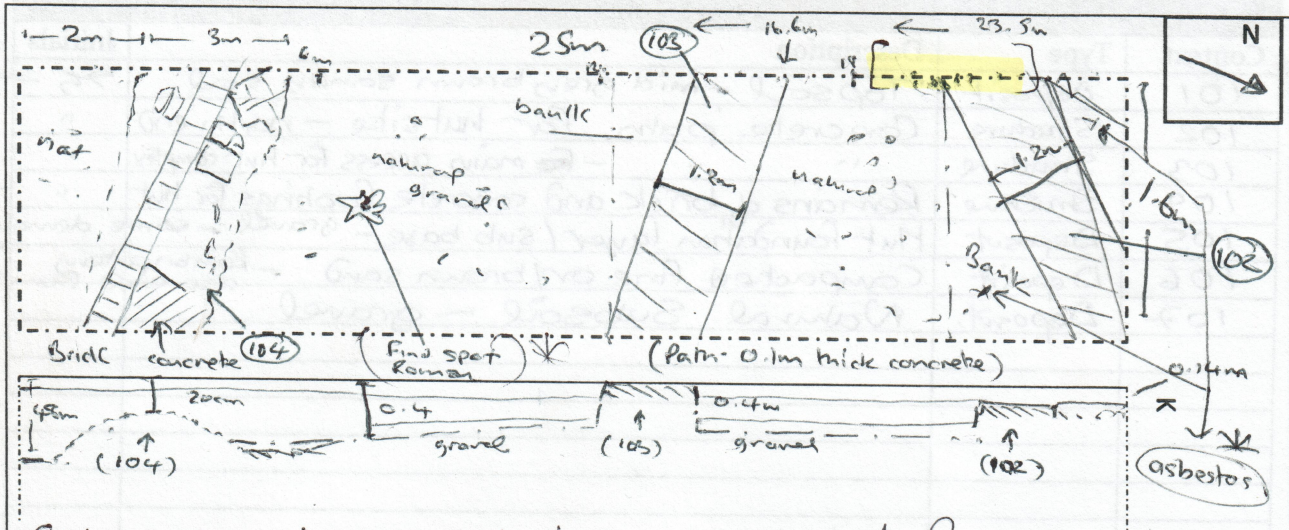


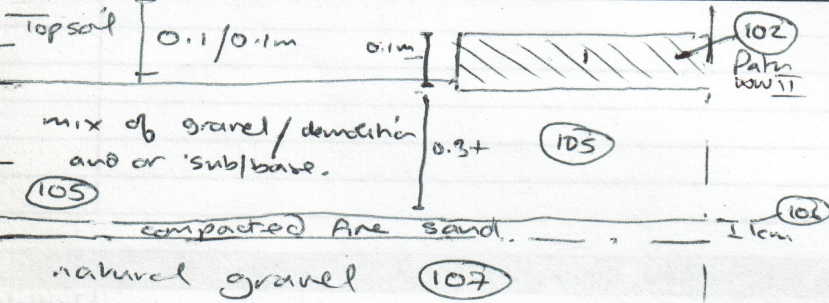

Interpretation

Trench located to ascertain whether or not remains of hut complex (c. WWII) present. Visible evidence of paths to the individual huts remains at surface level. (See 102 & 103 above). To the south, brick & concrete remains of building footings or drainage network possible. Geophysics result & subsequent trench location is extremely accurate. Demolition rubble mixed in somewhat with the original gravel construction sub base (105)
