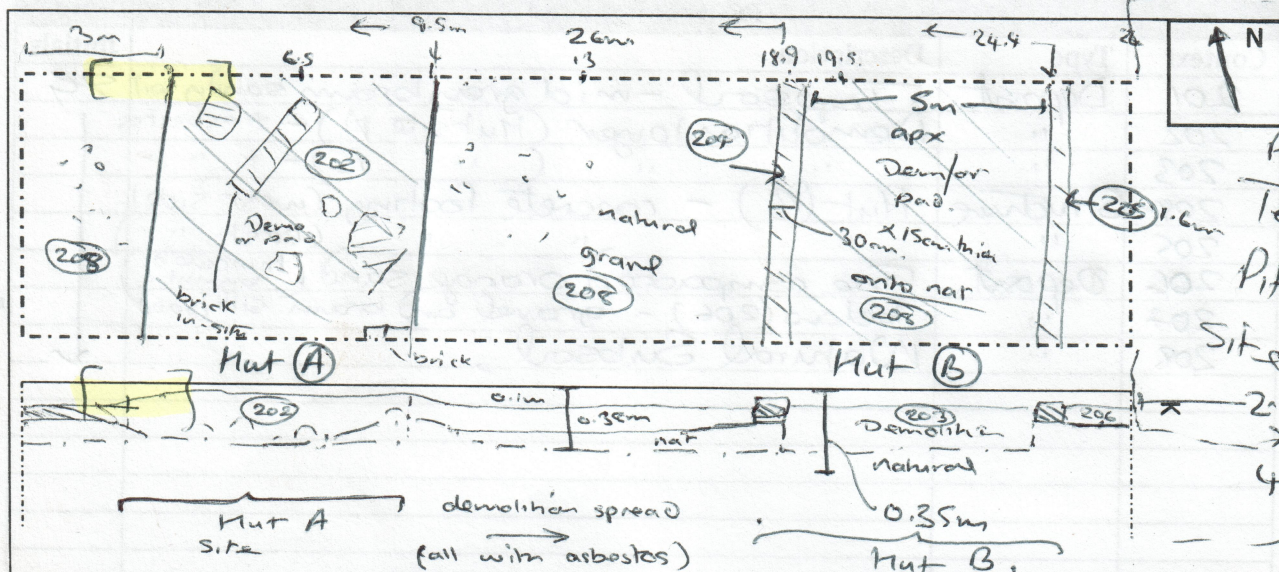

Interpretation

Trenches located across (AP plot) an area of WWII hut sites. Should have identified two sites (Hut A x B) - the latter being slightly narrower. This was the case, Hut A = 6.5m wide, Hut B (defined by concrete footings - parallel to B - 30cm wide) = 5.6m wide (includes footings). Test pit (2.6m x 4.5m) located @ east end of trench. Surviving concrete pad to the east (11m x 5.3m) - See AP plot. Demolition layer(s) contained asbestos, extent (depth) not known. (202) x (203)

Earlier deposits (truncated by construction of the huts) still in situ @ the west end of the trench. (e.g. 206, 207). (206) - a compacted fine orange sand (0.06m) and a mixed gravel and soil (brown) 0.12m - (207) undated. Underlying natural subsoil = gravel (208)
