Abstract

A metal detecting survey was carried out at land off Swanlow Lane, Moulton. The survey was monitored by a qualified archaeologist.

Two hundred and seventy-six artefacts were recovered by the detectorists. The location of each of these was recorded using a handheld GPS and each item was collected and described. The majority of the artefacts were buttons, coins, and unidentifiable fragments of machinery or fittings. These reflect casual loss and the long term agricultural use of the site.

Of interest were a group of four late 16th century coins comprising two half groats, a Queen Mary groat and an Elizabeth 1st threepence. The groat and one half groat were found next to each other. It is likely that all four coins were lost together and two have been dragged by ploughing across the site.

The type and density of the finds do not indicate any areas of potential buried archaeological remains. No further site work is recommended.

1. Introduction

1.1.This report details the results of a metal detecting survey carried out on land to the east of Swanlow Lane, Winsford. The site is centred on 365000, 364670 (SJ649646)..

1.2.The Metal Detecting Survey was conducted by Colin Sharret (a member of the National Council for Metal Detecting [NCMD] North-West Region) and monitored by Chris Matthews of L – P : Archaeology.

1.3.This report was written by Chris Matthews and Matthew Williams of L - P : Archaeology.

1.4.The work was carried out in accordance with the agreed written scheme of investigation (WSI) prepared by Matthew Williams of L - P : Archaeology (WILLIAMS 2015).

2. Site Background

2.1. PLANNING

2.1.1. Planning consent has been granted for the development of the site. An archaeological condition of planning permission required further archaeological evaluation of the site in order to assess its potential. The assessment took the form of the metal detecting survey.

2.1.2. The methodology for the survey was outlined in the Written Scheme of Investigation prepared by L - P : Archaeology and agreed with Cheshire Archaeological Planning Advisory Service (CAPAS).

2.2. GEOLOGY

2.2.1. The British Geological Survey GeoIndex for the site records the superficial (drift) deposits as Devensian Till deposits and the solid deposits as Sidmouth Mudstone formation (BRITISH GEOLOGICAL SURVEY 2015).

2.3. TOPOGRAPHY

2.3.1. The site is located on the south side of Winsford (FIGURE 1). It is bounded to the south and east by open fields, to the north by Welsh Lane leading on to open fields and to the west by Swanlow Lane and modern residential development beyond (FIGURE 2). The site is flat at approximately 57m OD.

2.3.2. The site comprises of two plough fields separated by a wooded hedge.

2.4. ARCHAEOLOGICAL BACKGROUND

2.4.1. The following is summarised from the Archaeological Survey of the site (TRIPPIER 2012).

2.4.2. Welsh Lane may have been part of a Roman Road from Delamere to Middlewich although origins as a Medieval packhorse route or saltway have also been suggested.

2.4.3. The church of St. Chad's is 550m north of the site and the fields immediately to the north of Welsh Lane are considered of archaeological interest on the basis that they may contain below ground remains of the Early Medieval

settlement of Over.

2.4.4. The Tithe map of c.1846 described the land uses within the site as arable, pasture and meadow.

3. Aims

3.1. The aims of the survey were:

- ◆ To identify concentrations of metal artefacts within the site area that may indicate buried archaeological remains.
- ◆ To collect enough information to allow a suitable mitigation strategy to be devised, if required. Any such strategy could consist of further fieldwork followed by a programme of post excavation analysis, reporting and possible publication and dissemination.

4. Methodology

4.1. The field was divided into 10m wide corridors. Each corridor was surveyed by the metal detecting team.

4.2. All finds excavated by the team; the location was measured and they were bagged and marked by a professional archaeologist. The locations were recorded using GPS with an accuracy of +/-1m. The results show that the GPS was accurate to +/-1m.

4.3. For a full description of the methodology please refer to the WSI.

4.4. The intended methodology was adhered to at all times during and there were no obstacles or constraints which impeded the implementation of the WSI. As such the confidence in the results is considered high.

5. Results

- 5.1. Two hundred and seventy-six metal artefacts were recovered. There were no chance finds of non-metal artefacts and no corroded items that required x-ray analysis were found. The artefacts are listed below in Appendix 1 and the location shown in FIGURE 2.
- 5.2. No Prehistoric objects were found. Prehistoric metal objects are rare but previous research (TRIPPIER 2012) and the survey results suggest that there are no prehistoric remains within the study area.
- 5.3. No Roman or Medieval artefacts were confirmed; however one lead spindle whorl (205) and two possible lead weights (223 and 236) were found. These objects were not chronologically diagnostic but were common during the Roman to Medieval period.
- 5.4. Four late 16th century coins were discovered: two silver half groats (143 and 202), one Elizabethan threepence (246) and one Queen Mary groat (247). One half groat and the Queen Mary coin were found next to each other and are in excellent condition. The threepence was found 90m to the southwest and the second half groat 100m to the east (FIGURE 2). It is likely that the coins were lost together and the groat and half groat have not been disturbed, hence the excellent condition, whereas the other two coins have been moved by ploughing.
- 5.5. Map evidence indicates that the site was farm land throughout the Post Medieval period and this is supported by the results, for example machine parts (e.g. 88) and a bull ring (122). This does not imply significant archaeological remains within the site.
- 5.6. One 17th or 18th century musket ball (238) and a small canon ball (109) were found. There is no record of Civil War activity in the vicinity but troops often crossed Cheshire en route to Ireland in the late Elizabethan period (COOK 2002).
- 5.7. The commonest identifiable finds were buttons, of which there were 29, all were 19th or 20th century including one copper livery button decorated with a horse and top hatted rider.
- 5.8. Twenty-four coins were found, all of which were copper except for the silver coins

mentioned above. The dates range from the late 16th century (described above) to modern and most were mid 19th to early 20th century, including one Irish (94) and one South African (70). These are interpreted as casual loss.

5.9. The vast majority of the finds were unidentifiable metal fragments, small pieces of modern fittings or machinery and refuse. These are all interpreted as casual loss or deliberately discarded refuse and do not imply any buried archaeological remains within the site.

6. Discussion and Conclusions

- 6.1.1. The type and density of the finds do not infer any areas of potential significant archaeological deposits. There is no evidence to suggest Early Medieval activity within the site area. No further work is recommended.
- 6.1.2. The survey has revealed an interesting assemblage that provides a snapshot of typical metal items from greenfield sites. Of particular archaeological interest is the group of early 16th century coins. These coins were reported as treasure under the 1996 Treasure Act; the assigned Treasure Number is 2016.T174.
- 6.1.3. All finds have been recorded and assessed within this report. It is recommended that all are retained to be deposited with the archive unless advised otherwise by CAPAS and the Cheshire Museum Service.

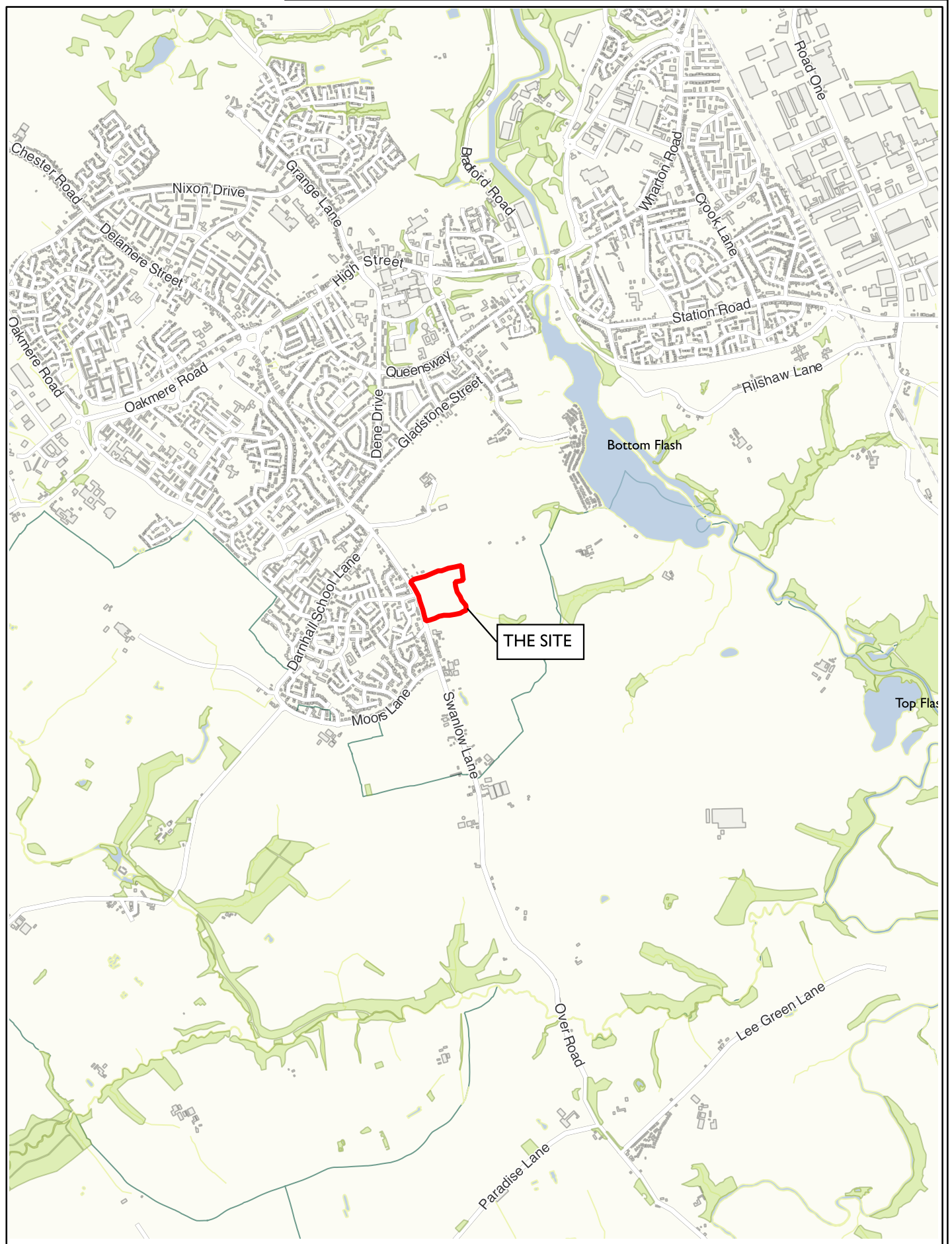

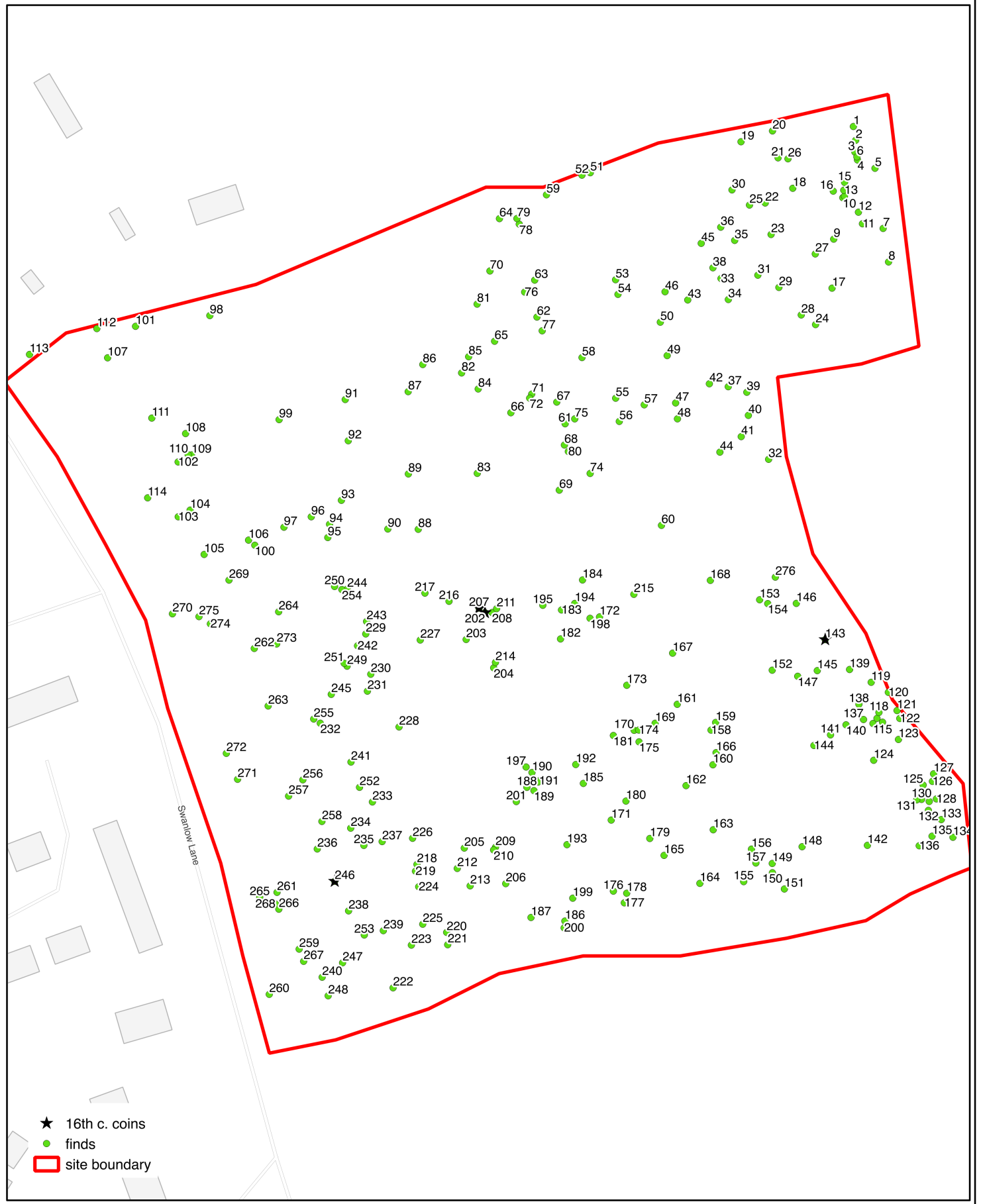
