<p>Section 1: There is a “1” at the bottom of the page after the paragraphs</p> <p>2.1.5: the quoted paragraph would look better if indented to be narrower than the standard body paragraph.</p> <p>2.2.1: format the BGS ref to appear black not blue by setting its format first to 'default' (select text and then Ctrl-m). And then reapply the body_biblio_ref style</p> <p>2.5.4: “THE High Street”??</p> <p>2.5.7: Looks like something went wrong here. Open a previous version (?v1.1?) to recover your text.</p> <p>Section 5: All the paras have been indented once to many. As there is no 5.1, we shouldn't already be on 5.1.1.</p> <p>Section 5: “Made Ground”. Don't use this term in reports. Its a geotechnical term that is used to mean anything human in original and includes archaeological deposits. I appreciate that this term is used colloquially in archaeology to mean anything modern or non archaeological, but it is best avoided to prevent confusion. A better term might be “modern make up layers” or just make up layers.</p> <p>5.1.2: I assume this clay to be natural, but perhaps you could state the interp more clearly.</p> <p>APP 1: OASIS: In my version this has got a bit bugged up with numbering and stuff. Please check yours. A better approach may be to print the original to PDF and then insert.</p>
