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NON-TECHNICAL SUMMARY

North Pennines Archaeology Ltd were commissioned by Alpha Design to undertake a building recording project at Low Allenwood Farm, Broadwath, Carlisle in December 2005 prior to the redevelopment of a complex of agricultural buildings. The survey revealed that Low Allenwood Farm was in existence by 1843 and is likely to date back to the enclosure of this area in the late 18th century. Much of the complex recorded during this survey date to a late 19th century redevelopment of the site and were subject to later alterations in the 20th century in line with changing agricultural practises.

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
