


Figure 2: Location of potential building remains, based off historical mapping.




Figure 5: Plan of Sexton's House and associated contexts.




Figure 6: Plan showing archaeological remains uncovered over the 1st Edition Ordance Survey of 1858.




Figure 7: Pre-19th century walled features north of church. B: Compared to the 1st Edition Ordnance Survey of 1858.




Figure 9: Location of Human Remains within the area of the Sexton's House.




Figure 10: Human remains south of wall (118)




Figure 11: Skeletons under graveyard path.




Figure 13: Human remains by north churchyard wall.




Figure 14: Example section of evaluation area.
