Summary

The archaeological and historic landscape survey of the Killerton Estate was commissioned by Fiona Hailstone, Killerton Ranger Team, and Martin Papworth, National Trust Archaeologist (South West Region), to bring together the results of previous fieldwork at this National Trust property, combined with an investigation of documentary material. A range of sources including historic documents, maps, aerial photographs and LiDAR data were consulted.

This volume contains imagery derived from the historic maps and aerial photographs of the estate.

Disclaimer: Given the scope of this study, this report cannot be considered exhaustive and is intended as an outline of relevant archaeological features and standing structures known at the time of writing.

2. HISTORIC MAPS

1.1 Introduction

A number of historic estate maps for the Killerton Estate are held in record offices across the South West. A large number of these form part of the Acland Family archives in their respective record offices, a result of the Acland's ownership of estates across a number of South West counties. These estate maps do not necessarily cover the entire estate but generally relate to specific transactions or acquisitions of land, or to particular designs and schemes, not all of which were carried out. Some were not commissioned by the Acland Family but passed into their ownership with the purchase of areas of the estate. Maps produced prior to the 19th century are unlikely to have as high a level of accuracy compared to later maps and employed a variety of scales (e.g. Chains). The first historic mapping to cover the entire Killerton Estate is the 1840s Tithe survey and the first accurate and detailed maps of the entire estate are the 1880s First Edition Ordnance Survey Series. Due to the vast number of documents in the Acland family archives across a number of record offices and the lack of detailed cataloguing for many items, it is possible some estate maps for the Killerton Estate could be unknown at present in the record offices, particularly if they have been catalogued with documents relating to the Acland's other estates (e.g. Holnicote).

1.2 METHODOLOGY & SOURCES CONSULTED

All known maps and plans relating to the Killerton Estate have been researched and recorded in Volume 1: Appendix 1. Where these maps are accessible they have been photographed, georeferenced and reproduced in this volume. The majority of maps reproduced in this volume are located in the Devon Heritage Centre, with a smaller number in the Somerset Heritage Centre. Maps held at the Plymouth and West Devon Record Centre were not accessible at this time of this study due to its closure for renovation. Additional maps are held by the National Trust Archive at Wansdyke or by the Property.

1.3 PRESENTATION

Earlier and less accurate maps are presented in their original format with an inset map to indicate the approximate location of the map within the Killerton Estate (Section 3 of this volume). 19th century and later maps which are more accurate and have universal coverage have been georeferenced and presented as 11 images containing 6 x 1km tiles, with tiles based on the OS national grid (section 4 of this volume). The tiles are numbered and presented west to east, from north to south (like reading a book). Tiles are omitted where the NT does not own any land. There are five images for each set of 1km tiles:

- Ordnance Survey surveyor's draft map, surveyed c.1805
- Tithe maps, produced c.1840
- Ordnance Survey 1st edition 25" maps, surveyed c.1880
- Ordnance Survey 2nd edition 25" maps, surveyed c.1900
- 1946-1948 RAF Aerial Photographs

A final section (section 5) utilises data derived from historic maps to produce maps showing the ownership of land on the Killerton Estate at the date of the tithe survey, the occupier of each of these plots at the date of the tithe survey and a comparison of boundaries across the estate lost and gained from the 19th century to the present. Where possible a key has been provided with each map for ease of reference however for some images this is not possible so a full key for each tithe map has also been provided at the start of section 5.




FIGURE 1: THE KILLERTON ESTATE, DIVIDED INTO NUMBERED 1km SQUARES. NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED RED. THE AREA SHADED GREY DOES NOT CONTAIN ANY LAND OWNED BY THE NATIONAL TRUST SO IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE FOLLOWING MAPS © CROWN COPYRIGHT AND DATABASE RIGHTS 2019 ORDNANCE SURVEY 0100031673.




Figure 2: A map of the Barton of Culmjohn. Hodge $1756\,\mathrm{DHC}\,1148M\,\mathrm{Add}\,23/E1$




FIGURE 3: A MAP OF BUDLAKE IN KILLERTON MANOR, EXTRACT FROM HODGE 1756 DHC 1148M ADD 23/E1




Figure 6: A map of the manor of Killerton and Culmjohn. Hodge $1756\,\mathrm{DHC}\,1148M\,\mathrm{Add}\,23/E1$




Figure 9: A map of the manor of Langacre. 1774 DHC 1148M add 1/T8/168




Figure 14: Plan of the intended new road at Killerton. 1812. DHC 1148M add 21/3/1




FIGURE 15: WOODS AND PLANTATIONS IN THE PARISH OF BROADCLYST (ASHCLYST FOREST) ON OILED SILK




FIGURE 16: MAP AND SCHEDULE OF PLANTATIONS. C.1930s DHC 1148M/21/2/9 Box 21 Bundle II





FIGURE 17: PLAN OF WOODLAND COMPARTMENTS 1949 NATIONAL TRUST 137:58




FIGURE 19: SURVEYORS DRAFT MAP (MAP 1). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 21: 1^{st} Edition Ordnance Survey Map (Map 1). National Trust owned land is shaded.




FIGURE 22: 2ND EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 1). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 24: SURVEYORS DRAFT MAP (MAP 2). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 26: 1ST EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 2). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.





FIGURE 27: 2ND EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 2). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 30: Tithe Map (Map 3). National Trust owned land is shaded.




FIGURE 31: 1ST EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 3). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 32: 2^{ND} Edition Ordnance Survey Map (Map 3). National Trust owned land is shaded.




FIGURE 36: 1ST EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 4). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.





FIGURE 37: 2ND EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 4). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 39: SURVEYORS DRAFT MAP (MAP 5). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 40: TITHE MAP (MAP 5). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 41: 1ST EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 5). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 42: 2ND EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 5). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 44: SURVEYORS DRAFT (MAP 6). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.

FIGURE 45: TITHE MAP (MAP 6). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 46: 1^{st} Edition Ordnance Survey Map (Map 6). National Trust owned land is shaded.




Figure 47: 2^{ND} Edition Ordnance Survey Map (Map 6). National Trust owned land is shaded.




FIGURE 48: 1946-48 RAF AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH (MAP 6). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 50: Tithe Map (Map 7). National Trust owned land is shaded.




FIGURE 51: 1ST EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 7). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 52: 2ND EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 7). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 54: SURVEYORS DRAFT MAP (MAP 8). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 56: 1ST EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 8). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 57: 2^{ND} Edition Ordnance Survey Map (Map 8). National Trust owned land is shaded.




FIGURE 59: SURVEYORS DRAFT (MAP 9). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.



FIGURE 60: TITHE MAP (MAP 9). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 61: 1ST EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 9). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 62: 2^{ND} Edition Ordnance Survey Map (Map 9). National Trust owned land is shaded.




Figure 64: Surveyors Draft Map (Map 10). National Trust owned land is shaded.




Figure 65: Tithe Map (Map 10). National Trust owned land is shaded.




Figure 66: 1^{st} Edition Ordnance Survey Map (Map 10). National Trust owned land is shaded.




FIGURE 67: 2ND EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 10). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 70: TITHE MAP (MAP 11). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 71: 1^{st} Edition Ordnance Survey Map (Map 11). National Trust owned land is shaded.




FIGURE 72: 2ND EDITION ORDNANCE SURVEY MAP (MAP 11). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 76: TITHE LANDOWNERSHIP (MAP 1). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED




Figure 77: Tithe Land occupier (Map 1). National Trust owned land is indicated




FIGURE 78: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 1). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 79: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 1). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 80: TITHE LANDOWNERSHIP (MAP 2). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED




FIGURE 81: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 2). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED




FIGURE 82: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 2). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 83: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 2). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.

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


FIGURE 84: TITHE LANDOWNER (MAP 3). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 85: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 3). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 86: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 3). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 87: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 3). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 88: TITHE LANDOWNERSHIP (MAP 4). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 89: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 4). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 90: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 4). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 91: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 4). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 92: TITHE LANDOWNERSHIP (MAP 5). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 93: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 5). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 94: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 5). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 95: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 5). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 96: Tithe Landownership (Map 6). National Trust owned land is indicated.




FIGURE 97: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 6). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 98: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 6). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 99: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 6). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 100: Tithe Landownership (Map 7). National Trust owned land is indicated.




FIGURE 101: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 7). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 102: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 7). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 103: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 7). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 104: TITHE LANDOWNERSHIP (MAP 8). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 105: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 8). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 107: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 8). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 108: Tithe Landownership (Map 9). National Trust owned land is indicated.

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


FIGURE 109: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 9). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 110: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 9). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 111: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 9). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 112: TITHE LANDOWNERSHIP (MAP 10). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




Figure 113: Tithe Land occupier (Map 10). National Trust owned land is indicated.




FIGURE 114: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 10). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 115: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 10). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




Figure 116: Tithe Landownership (Map 11). National Trust owned land is indicated.




FIGURE 117: TITHE LAND OCCUPIER (MAP 11). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS INDICATED.




FIGURE 118: REMOVED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 11). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.




FIGURE 119: ADDED BOUNDARIES ACROSS THE KILLERTON ESTATE BY DATE (MAP 11). NATIONAL TRUST OWNED LAND IS SHADED.
