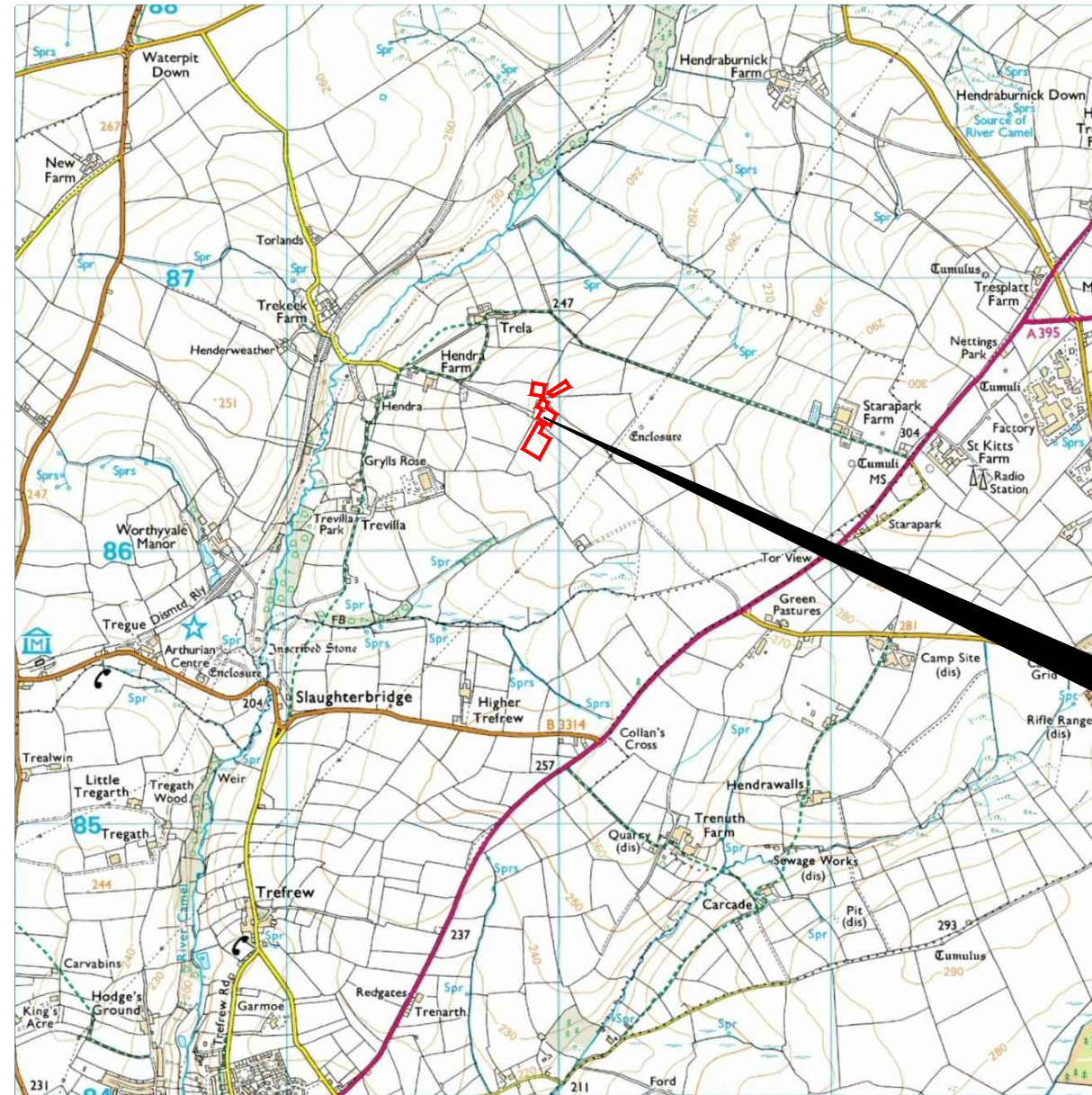

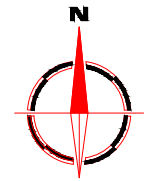
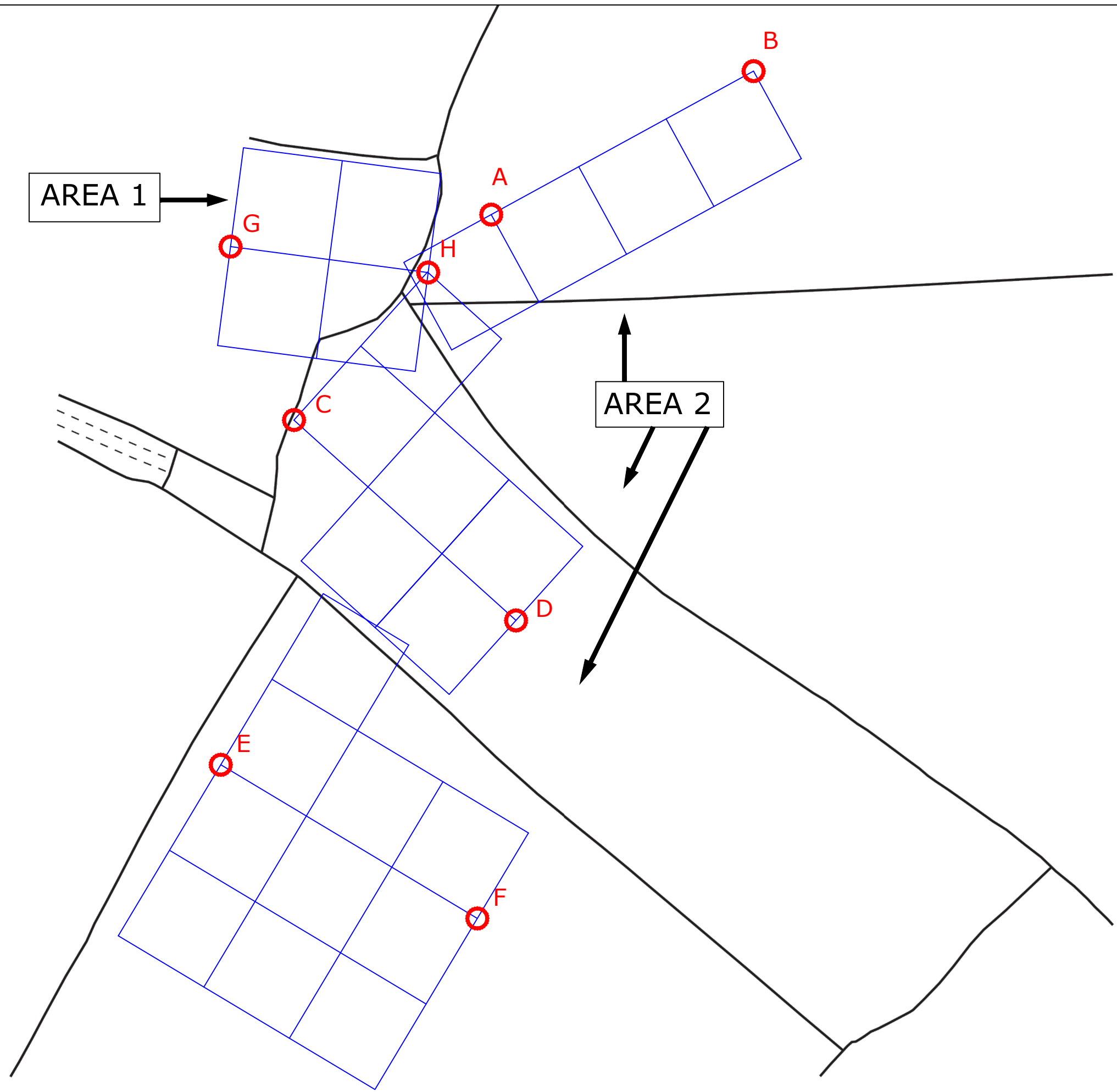

COLOUR PLOT OF GRADIOMETER DATA SHOWING EXTREME VALUES

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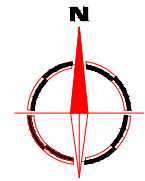

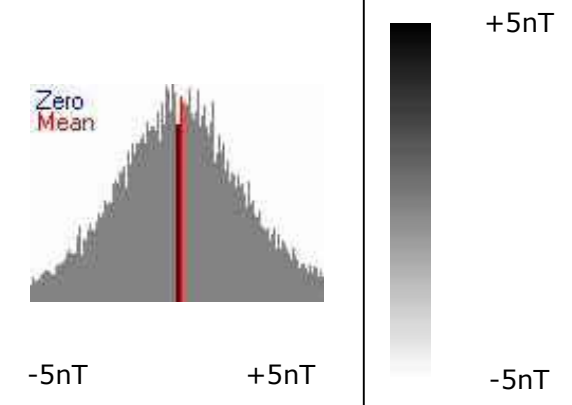

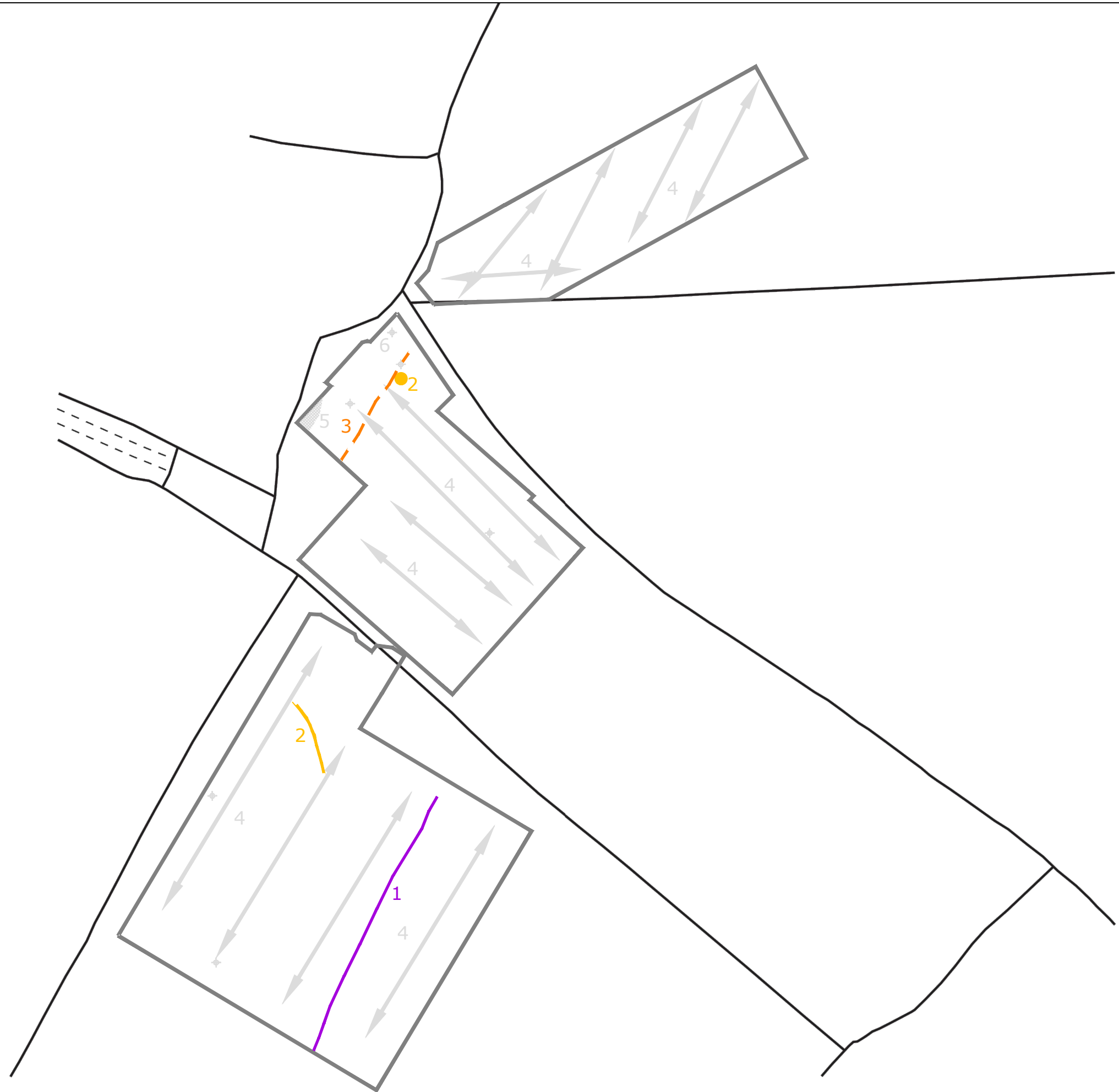

PROBABLE ARCHAEOLOGY

- Positive anomaly / weak positive anomaly - probable cut feature of archaeological origin

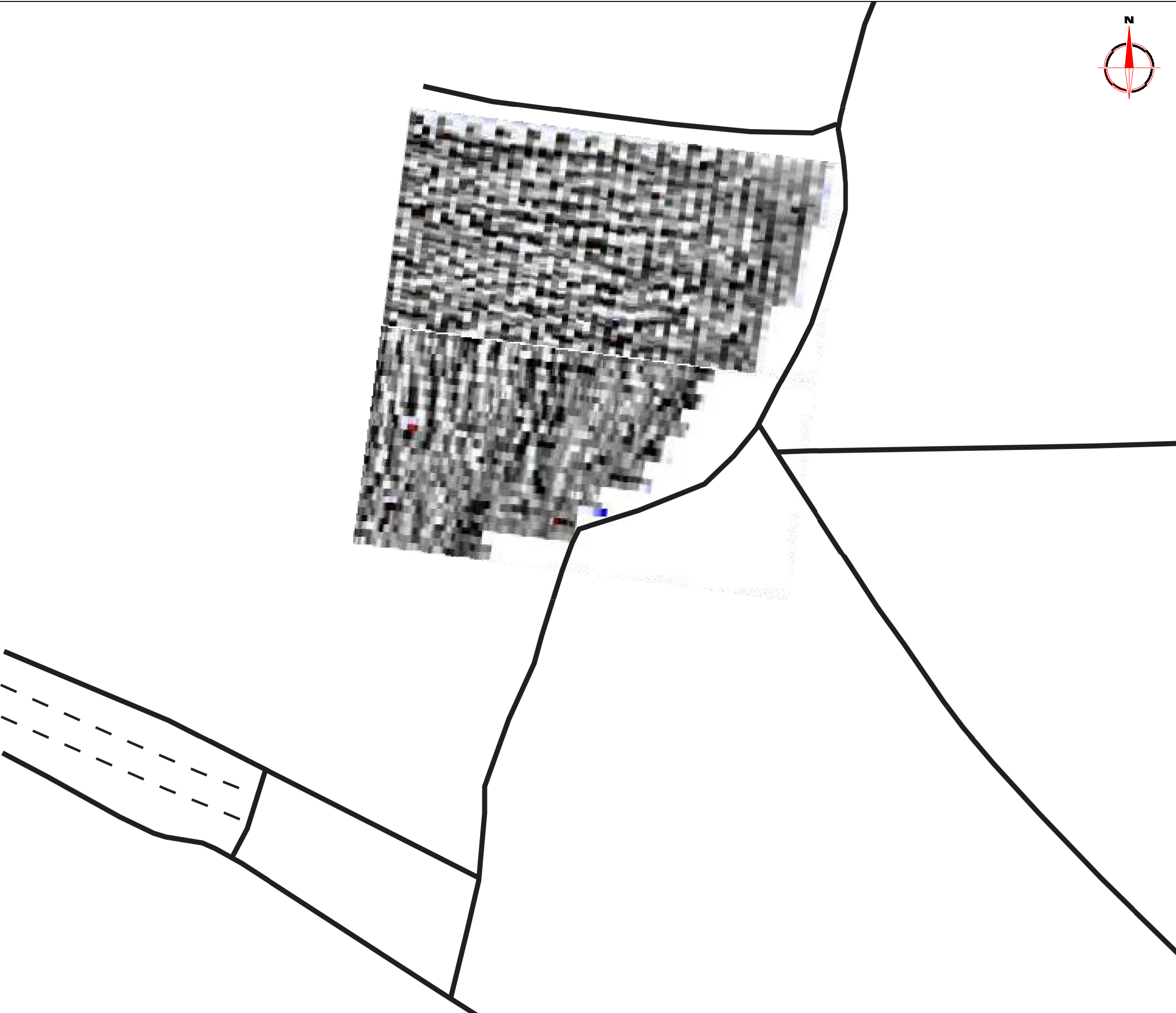

 DATA SHOWING EXTREME VALUES**

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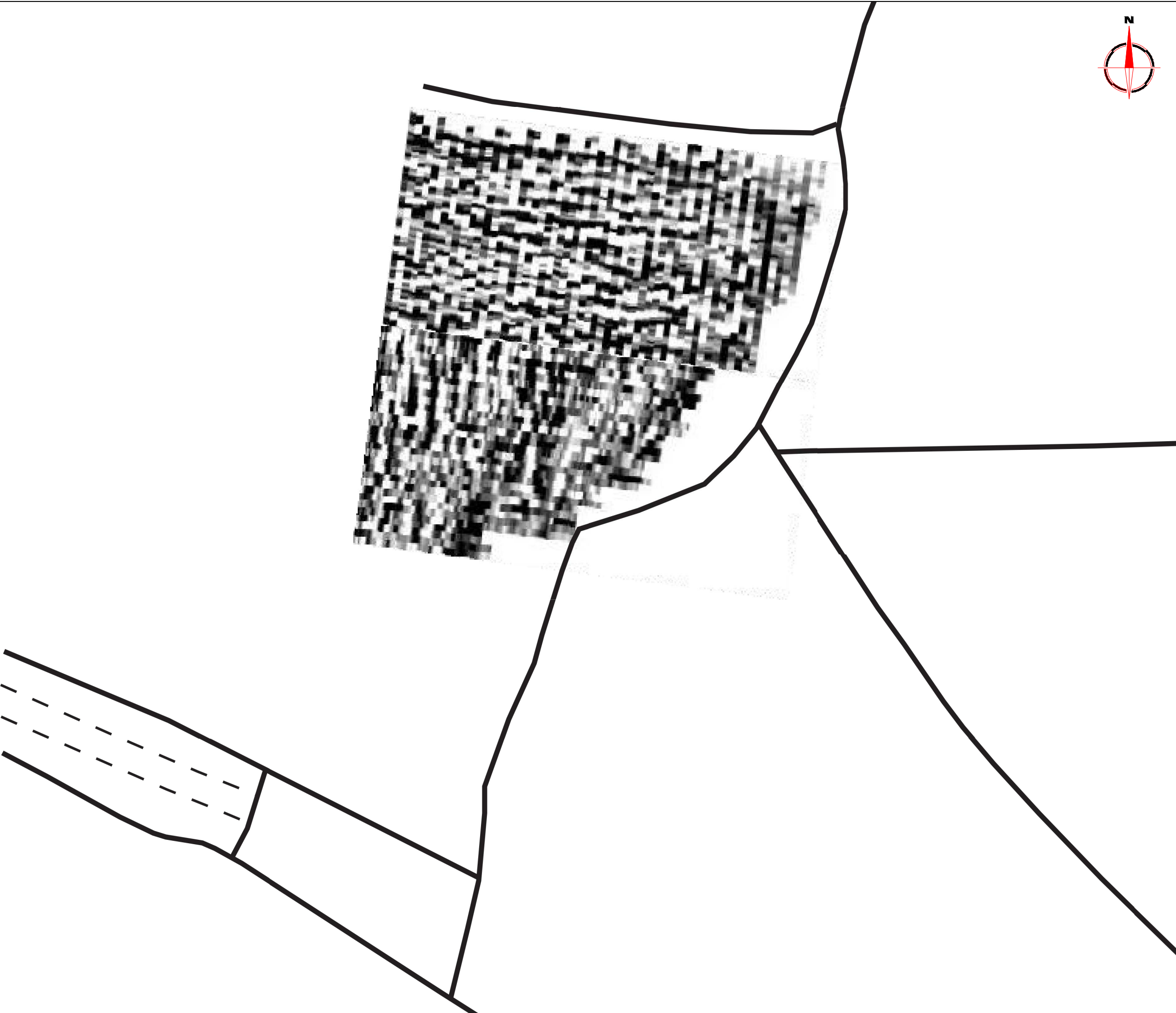

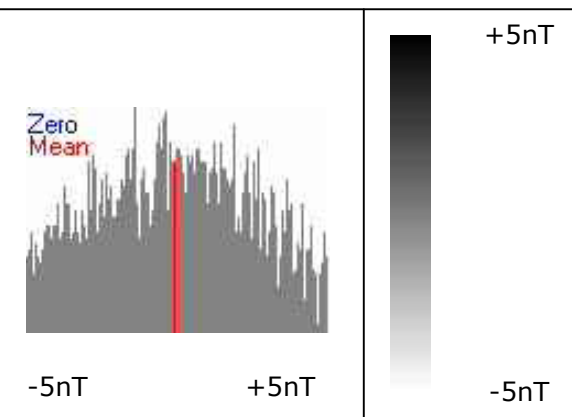

PLOT OF MINIMALLY PROCESSED GRADIOMETER DATA

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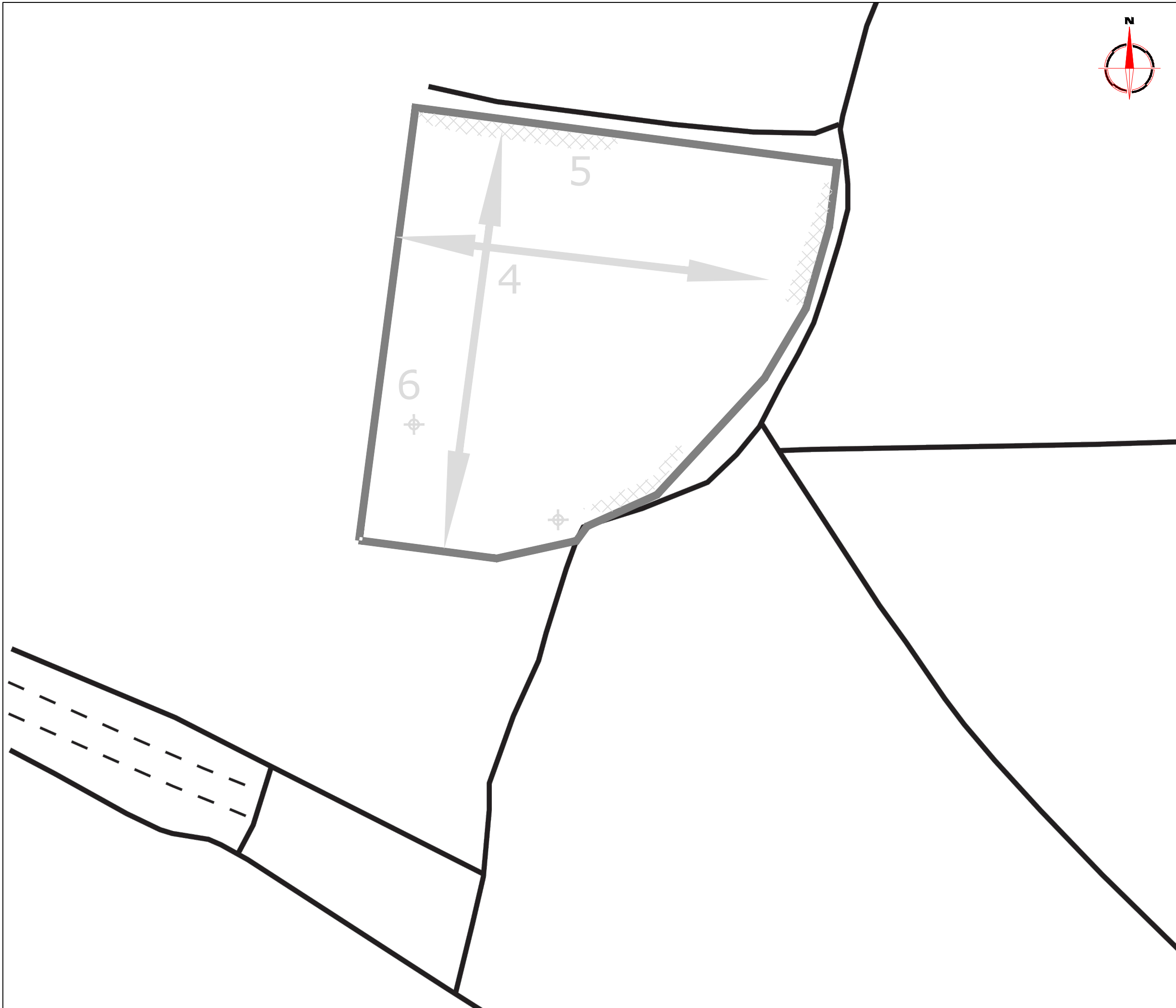



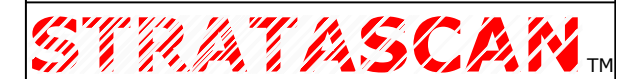
