## MARRIAGE LICENCES.

Berkshire Archdeaconry, 1616—1846. A collection of Marriage Licence Bonds, with a modern Index, containing, perhaps, 15,000 entries. (Archdeacon's Registry, St. Giles's, Oxford.)

Consistory of Sarum. Marriage Licence Bonds begin ca. 1615. Entries in books, from 1632. A regular series of Bonds, in yearly bundles, from about 1660 to 1823, when they were superseded by Marriage Allegations, or Affidavits. (DIOCESAN REGISTRY, Salisbury.)

Berkshire Marriage Bonds, and kindred papers, 1616—1836, 2 vols., containing about 200 papers. (Bodleian Library, Oxford.)

Peculiar of Great Faringdon, 1664—1740. A small collection of a few dozen bonds. (Archdeacon's Registry, St. Giles's, Oxford.)

Peculiar of Great Faringdon—Marriage Bonds and kindred papers, 1665—1738; about 500 papers. (BODLEIAN LIBRARY, Oxford.)

Peculiar of Langford Ecclesia—Marriage Bonds and kindred papers, 1676—1814; about 130 papers (IBID.)
