



Berkshire Court Rolls.

UNDER the above heading in Vol. III. of the Berks Archæological Journal were given full translations of the Court Rolls of Manors in Berkshire, formerly belonging to the Duchy of Lancaster and preserved in the Public Record Office. In the same Repository is a large collection of Rolls from every County of England and Wales known as the General Series. This has been well calendared and indexed in Lists and Indexes No. VI., but as this is not accessible to all students of Manorial records it has been thought that lists of the Rolls for the Counties of Berks, Bucks and Oxon in a convenient form would be acceptable to antiquaries of those counties. Similar lists for other collections at the Record Office, British Museum, Bodleian and Lambeth Palace have already appeared in *The Manor and Manorial Records*, and *THE MANORIAL SOCIETY is issuing from time to time Lists of Rolls in private hands; two such lists have already appeared.
