

## THE CHURCH BELLS OF BERKSHIRE

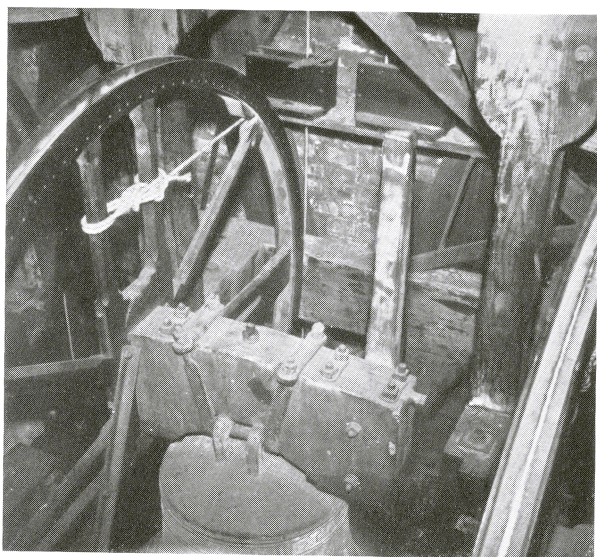


PLATE XL

A portion of the bellframe at St. John-the-Baptist, New Windsor. In the foreground is the third bell, cast by Richard Phelps in 1711. On each side of this bell pit are vertical timbers of unusual design which support the cills of the rider frame containing the fourth and fifth bells. The support on the right has been notched to allow the passage of the third bell on one side of the sixth bell on the other.
