


PLATE II Lambourn Long Barrow. Butt of tail end of north quarry ditch




PLATE III Prong of broken antler pick on the bottom of the north quarry ditch.




PLATE VI Lambourn Long Barrow. Contracted burial among sarsen boulders in the head of the mound.
