Pottery Archive for Rear of High Street, Barton Upon Humber (BNDB07)

A small assemblage of thirty-six sherds of pottery was recovered from the site. The material ranges in date from the mid Saxon to late medieval periods and includes a limited range of common vessel forms. Of note is a late mid Saxon shell-tempered ELFS sherd in context 202 the fill of Ditch 203, this type is introduced in the late 8th century and possibly continues in use until the mid 10th century. If the other pottery in this context is of late 9th to mid 10th century date the sherd could be contemporary with the rest of the group.
