

High Roding Mission Hall, The Street, High Roding, Essex.



View from the east with timber porch to entry door and two sash windows. Main and porch gables have decorated and pierced bargeboards. Roof is slate and the plinth is Flemish bond brickwork. The lime plaster render is ashlar marked. The cottage is attached.



View from the north showing feature gable to the front with decorated and pierced bargeboards as the front. Two sash windows some still with frosted glass to the lower panes as on the front. Upper parts of wall lime rendered with ashlar marking. Lower levels re-coated with cement render. The roof covering is grey slate with a grey ridge tile. The porch has red ridge tiles.
