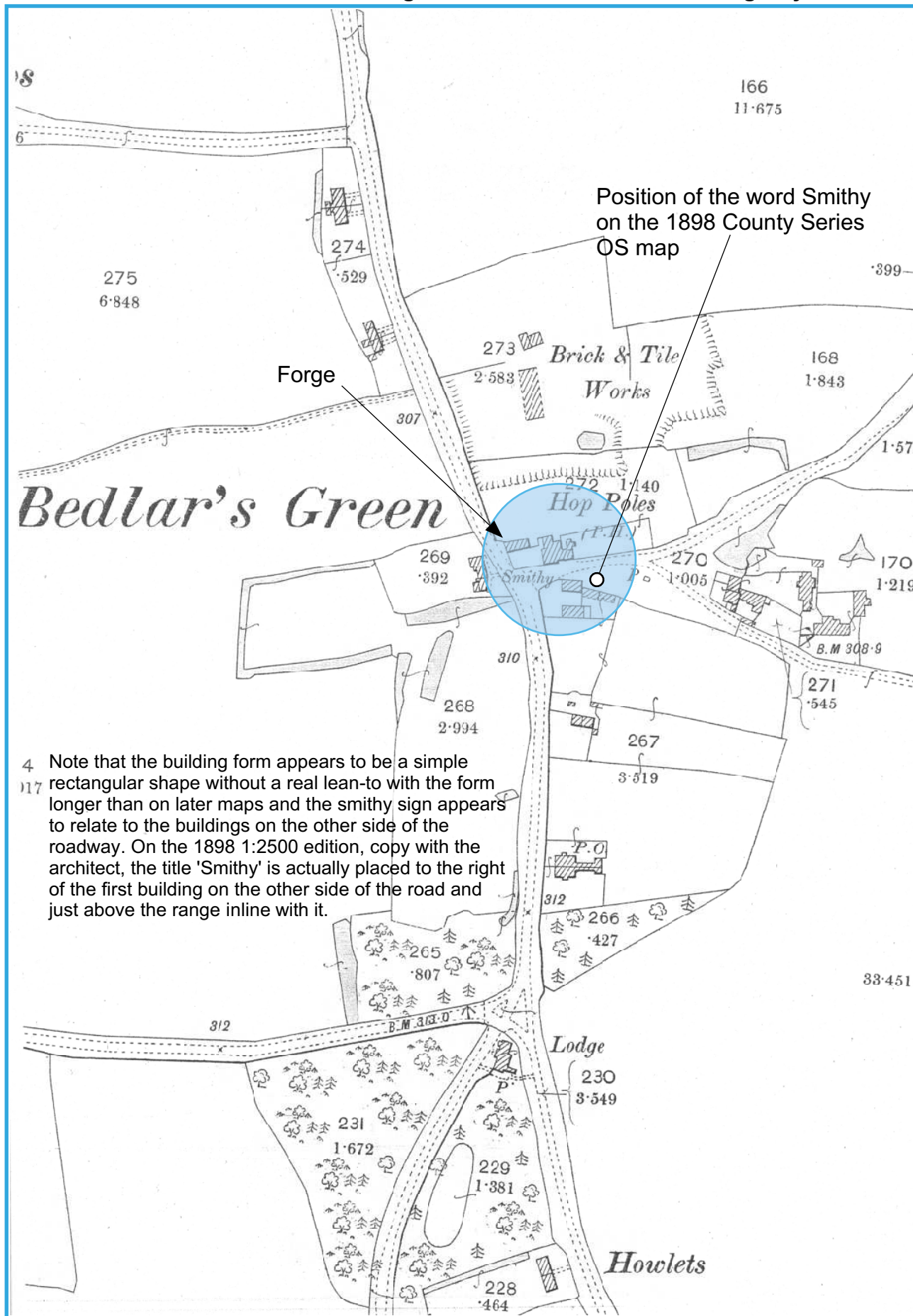


The Old Forge, Bedlar's Green, Great Hallingbury, Essex.



4 Note that the building form appears to be a simple rectangular shape without a real lean-to with the form longer than on later maps and the smithy sign appears to relate to the buildings on the other side of the roadway. On the 1898 1:2500 edition, copy with the architect, the title 'Smithy' is actually placed to the right of the first building on the other side of the road and just above the range inline with it.
