

Parsonage Farm, Parsonage Green, School Lane, Broomfield, Essex.



Western shelter shed with bricks remains and new build to east. Remnant of yard wall to west.



Eastern shelter shed with rebuilt east return wall. roof is covered with single Roman clay tiles.



Rear wall of west shed with good brickwork. End wall from earlier building, earlier brick.



Typical roof structure in shelter sheds, nailed collars, constant sections and ridge board, this is the east shed.



Open shed, The Pig Yard, attached to west wall of barn.



Simple modern roof for asbestos sheet covering.



Modern build, timber framed and clad with corrugated iron roof. Some of the plinth bricks possibly from an earlier brick building with remains forming a brick walled yard area to the north between shelter sheds.



Looking across the north boundary pond and towards the area to the west of the Goose yard building. The failing revetment to the pond may have been the end of a bricked area beside the pond.
