Plate 4 (right): The southern site boundary, looking east along the North Delph from the south-west corner of the west field. The slight rise in ground level at the edge of the Delph is due to the deposition of dredged material.





Plate 5 (left): The boundary ditch between the parishes of Cherry Willingham and Fiskerton, here forming the eastern site boundary, looking north from the south-east corner of the site. The change in ground level can be seen from west to east across the drain.

Plate 6 (right): The area in which three round barrows and a possible square barrow have been recorded, looking north-west towards Cherry Willingham from the parish boundary ditch.
