

Appendix 2: List of contexts

- 001 Dark brown silty clay topsoil with limestone fragments
- 002 Layer of reddish-brown clayey sand, c. 1.0m deep: hillwash or similar naturally occurring deposit
- 003 Layer of greyish-brown silty clay, c. 2.0m deep: hillwash or similar naturally occurring deposit
- 004 Cut feature, possibly linear, seen in sections of pipe-trench 1; contains fills 007, 008 and 009
- 005 N-S aligned linear feature truncated by [004]; contains fills 010 and 011
- 006 Reddish-brown clayey silty sand sealing feature [004]
- 007 Mid-brown silty gravel fill below 006 in feature [004]
- 008 Greyish-brown silty clay fill below 007 in feature [004]
- 009 Yellow clayey silt primary fill in feature [004]
- 010 Reddish-brown clayey sand and silt sealing feature [005]
- 011 Greyish-brown silty clay with gravel: primary fill in feature [005]
- 012 Pit with fills 013 and 014
- 013 Dark reddish-brown gravelly silty clay: primary fill in pit [012]
- 014 Gravel with silty clay sealing pit [012]
- 015 Greyish-black silt, possibly organic, filling pit [016]
- 016 Truncated cut feature, possibly a large pit, in the section of pipe-trench 2
- 017 Light brown sandy silt with pea-gravel filling feature [018]
- 018 Possible linear feature in the section of pipe-trench 3
- 019 Deposit of made ground
- 020 Mixed silty clays with pea-gravel: natural deposits
- 021 Limestone brash, becoming bedded at depth: local solid geology
