## PROBABLE ARCHAEOLOGY

Positive anomaly / weak positive anomaly - probable cut feature of archaeological origin

Positive anomaly / weak positive anomaly - probable cut feature of archaeological origin

Widely spaced curving parallel linear anomalies probably related to ridge-and-furrow

## OTHER ANOMALIES

Magnetic disturbance associated with nearby metal object such as service or field boundary

Strong magnetic debris - possible disturbed or made
