# **1 INTRODUCTION**

## **1.1 General**

This report presents the results of Phase 2 of an archaeological strip, map, record and excavation undertaken by CFA Archaeology Ltd in November and December 2016 within a former scheduled area at Hatton Mill Farm, Frockheim, Angus (NO 618 501, centred; Fig. 1) in advance of an extension to a sand and gravel quarry. The work was commissioned by Geddes Group.

A Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) dated 27 January 2015 covering this programme of works was produced by CFA on behalf of Geddes Group. The WSI was approved by Aberdeenshire Council Archaeology Service (ACAS), who provide curatorial support to Angus Council.

## **1.2 Background**

Hatton Mill Sand and Gravel Quarry lies circa 2km to the east of the village of Frockheim within an area of fertile agricultural land adjacent to the Lunan Water. Several phases of quarrying have been undertaken, with the land being reinstated for agricultural purposes following the removal of the sand and gravels.

The area where this programme of works was undertaken was formerly a Scheduled Monument (SM No.6042), but has now been removed from the schedule of monuments by Historic Environment Scotland. Cropmarks identified on oblique aerial photographs suggested that the area contained a number of monuments including a ring-ditch house and a souterrain (NMRS No. NO65SW 31).

An earlier evaluation of the area surrounding the former scheduled area was undertaken by CFA in September and October 2005 (O'Connell 2005). This programme of works identified several undated pits, a ring-ditch (previously known from cropmarks), a possible medieval kiln, a curvilinear feature, and a ditch. A cultural heritage assessment undertaken by CFA in 2006 (Neighbour 2006) identified a concentration of prehistoric activity within the surrounding area with a further eight scheduled monuments lying within 1km of the site.

An archaeological evaluation of the former scheduled area undertaken by CFA in September 2014 (Suddaby 2014) identified a ring-ditch house, three further possible ring-ditch houses, a pit-alignment, and a significant number of other smaller features.

Phase 1 of this programme of works was carried out in February and March 2015 (Savory 2015) (Fig. 1) and covered a strip along the southern edge of the former scheduled area. The features uncovered consisted of isolated pits, pit clusters, and two linear features. Sherds of Neolithic pottery were recovered from a number of the pits.

This report presents the results of Phase 2, a strip within the NE quadrant of the former scheduled area (Fig. 1).

A further programme of works (Phase 3) will be required at a future date in relation to the western part of the former scheduled area.

### **1.3 Objectives**

The objectives were:

- To conduct an appropriate programme of archaeological investigation (monitored strip) to monitor topsoil stripping
- To record any archaeological features that are revealed
- To excavate archaeological features where it is economically viable to do so, and to preserve the feature *in situ* otherwise.

## **2. WORKING METHODS**

### **2.1 General**

CFA Archaeology Ltd follows the Chartered Institute for Archaeologists' Code of Conduct, Standards and Guidance for Archaeological Fieldwork. Recording of all elements followed established CFA methods.

### **2.2 Scope of works**

It was agreed in consultation with ACAS that topsoil stripping of the former scheduled area could be carried out under constant archaeological supervision, with any features that were revealed being mapped and recorded. Features that were revealed were to be excavated where it was considered economically viable to do so. Any features that were considered uneconomical to excavate were to be preserved *in situ* with an appropriate buffer zone.

The stripping of the former scheduled area was to be conducted over several phases, with a new phase commencing as the previous phase neared completion.

### **2.3 Strip and map**

Topsoil was removed by a tracked 360° mechanical excavator, equipped with a smooth-bladed ditching bucket under constant archaeological supervision. Any further excavation required to fulfil the objectives of the evaluation was carried out by hand. Feature locations were surveyed using industry standard electronic surveying equipment.

### 3. ARCHAEOLOGICAL RESULTS

#### 3.1 General

The following text provides descriptions of the archaeological features. Numbers in bold refer to contexts, a full list of which is presented as Appendix 2. A summary of all the excavated features is presented as Appendix 1.

The topsoil (**001**) across the site had a depth of c.0.3m deep and overlay either subsoil (**002**) or natural (**003**). The natural (**003**) consisted predominantly of sandy gravels, but there was a line of fairly clean sand running across the Phase 2 area from north-west to south-east.

#### 3.2 Archaeological Features

Seven significant groups of features were identified, along with numerous isolated pits, pit clusters, and rough pit alignments (Fig. 2A-2B).

The seven areas identified as key features consisted of two six-post structures (Fig. 3, 5); two curvilinear features (possible ploughed out enclosures) with associated pits (Fig. 4, 6); a cluster of large pits (possible prehistoric sand-quarrying) (Fig. 2A); a curvilinear pit feature consisting of three conjoined pits (visible on aerial photographs) (Fig. 7); and a roundhouse (also visible on aerial photographs) (Fig. 8).

##### *Six Post Structure 1*

A pit grouping forming an oval plan was identified towards the north-western side of the Phase 2 area (Fig. 3, 14). It consisted of six pits/possible post-holes (**2231**, **2236**, **2241**, **2242**, **2243** and **2253**) (Fig. 3). These pits typically had a diameter of c.0.3-0.5m and a depth of 0.1m. They appear to have formed an oval structure measuring c.5.8m north to south by c.3.2m east to west. An alignment of a further three pits (**2221**, **2223** and **2224**) were identified a little to the north-west of this group. Prehistoric pottery was recovered from Pit **2221**.

##### *Curvilinear Ditch and Pits 1*

To the south of Six Post Structure 1, a curvilinear feature (**2289**) and a linear pit (**2294**) were identified in association with a large oval pit (**2269**) and a large irregular pit (**2315**) (Fig. 4, Fig. 15). The curvilinear feature (**2289**) measured 8.15m in length and had a width of 0.5m and a depth of 0.3m at its western terminus. As it curved round to the south-east, it gradually got narrower and shallower, reducing to a width of c.0.3m before petering out. This feature had a single fill (**2321**) consisting of mid greyish-brown sandy-silt and may represent the remains of a ploughed out enclosure or ring-ditch.

To the west of curvilinear **2289** a linear pit (**2294**) was identified. It was situated on the same alignment as the curvilinear feature (**2289**) and may represent a continuation of this feature with the 0.6m gap between them being an entranceway. This pit had a length of 2.3m, a width of 0.7m and a depth of 0.4m, and had three fills consisting of (from base upwards) dark-brown sandy-silt (**2317**), orange sand (**2318**) and brown

sandy-silt (**2319**). Three smaller pits (**2322**, **2323** and **2324**) to the south of **2289/2294** may have been associated with this possible enclosure or ring-ditch.

The two large pits (**2269** and **2315**) were located roughly perpendicular to **2289/2294**. Pit **2269** measured c.5m north to south by 3.5m east to west and had a depth of 0.44m, while Pit **2315** measured 3.3m east to west by 3m north to south and had a depth of 0.23m. A single fill consisting of mid-brown sandy-silt (**2335**) was identified within Pit **2315**, while Pit **2269** contained a lower fill consisting of dark-grey sandy silt (**2316**) and an upper fill consisting of dark-grey silt (**2283**). The relationship between these pits and the possible enclosure was not established.

### *Six Post Structure 2*

A pit grouping considered likely to represent the remains of a circular structure was identified close to the southern boundary of the Phase 2 area (Fig. 5, 16). The circle consisted of six pits/post-holes (**2266**, **2268**, **2271**, **2273**, **2277** and **2279**) giving it a diameter of c.4m (Fig. 5). The pits/post-holes had diameters of c.0.3-0.5m and depths of 0.14-0.2m. A number of these features had small stones within the fills suggesting possible packing stones. Within the circle there was a shallow north-east to south-west aligned linear feature (**2286**), which measured 3.1m in length and had a maximum width of 0.6m and a maximum depth of 0.14m. It is unclear how this feature relates to the possible structure.

Immediately to the south of the post-circle was a large but shallow pit (**2281**) with four probable post-holes (**2284**, **2291**, **2292** and **2293**) cut into the base of it. Pit **2281** had a diameter of 1.1m and a depth of 0.1m. The probable post-holes on the eastern and western sides of the pit were mirror-images of each other, with post-hole **2284** mirroring **2293** and post-hole **2291** mirroring **2292**. Post-holes **2284** and **2293** had diameters of 0.25m and depths of c.0.1m, while post-holes **2291** and **2292** measured 0.5m north to south by 0.4m east to west and had depths of 0.1m and 0.07m respectively. This feature may have been something like a small porch associated with the probable circular structure.

### *Large Pit Features*

Three large pit features (**2345**, **2338** and **2347**) were identified towards the centre of the Phase 2 area (Fig. 2A, Fig. 17). Pit **2345** was sub-oval in plan measuring 2m south-east to north-west by 1.3m by 0.2m deep, while Pit **2338** was an irregular L-shape measuring 6.6m north-west to south-east by 6.2m north-east to south-west by 0.38m deep. The third pit (Pit **2347**) was also sub-oval in shape, measuring c.1.9m north-west to south-east by 1.5m by 0.14m deep. Each of these pits contained a single fill consisting of mid to dark-brown silty-sand (**2346**, **2340/2341/2343** and **2348** respectively). Sherds of prehistoric pottery and pieces of worked stone were recovered from the fill of Pit **2338**. The purpose of these pits is unknown, but they were situated within an area of good quality sand and may represent evidence of earlier sand quarrying.

### *Curvilinear Ditch and Pits 2*

To the south-east of the large pit features was a group of eleven pits (**2351**, **2358**, **2366**, **2367**, **2372**, **2376**, **2378**, **2380**, **2382**, **2386** and **2394**) lying adjacent to a curvilinear feature (**2374**), which had been cut by a further pit (**2384**) (Fig. 6 and Fig. 18). Curvilinear **2374** measured c.10m in length by 0.1-0.4m in width, and had a maximum depth of 0.14m. It ran from a terminus at its southern end, but petered out at its northern end suggesting that it had suffered from a degree of truncation. An extrapolated line following the curve of this feature suggests that it may originally have enclosed nine of the pits (**2358**, **2366**, **2367**, **2372**, **2376**, **2378**, **2380**, **2382** and **2394**) within this pit group.

Pit **2384**, which cut curvilinear **2374**, was oval in shape measuring 1.2m east to west by 1m north to south and had a depth of 0.25m. It contained a single fill (**2385**) consisting of dark grey-brown sandy-silt. A number of sherds of prehistoric pottery were recovered from this feature. The remaining pits had diameters ranging between 0.4m and 0.95m and depths of between 0.05m and 0.3m. Prehistoric pottery and worked flint were recovered from pits **2366** and **2372**, while Pit **2380** (Fig. 11, Fig. 19) contained prehistoric pottery, fragments of bunt bone and a saddle quern. Pit **2351** (Fig. 10) contained a significant quantity of fire-cracked stone and may have been a cooking pit.

### *Curvilinear Pit Feature 2426*

Curvilinear pit **2426** (Fig. 7) was visible on oblique aerial photographs, situated c.14m to the north-west of the ring-ditch house. Overall it measured 4.4m in length and consisted of three separate pits (**2432**, **2454**, and **2456**) linked by shallow conjoining channels. The southernmost pit (Pit **2432**) was sub-circular in plan with a diameter of 0.8m and a depth of 0.36m. It contained two fills; the lower fill (**2441**) consisted of beige/light-brown gravelly silty-sand, and the upper fill (**2440**) consisted of mid greyish-brown sandy-silt.

Pit **2456** was situated 0.64m to the north-east of Pit **2432**, linked to it by a shallow conjoining channel with a width of 0.8m and a depth of 0.1m. This pit was sub-oval in plan measuring 1.44m south-west to north-east by 1.12m north-west to south-east, and had a depth of 0.25m. It contained a single fill (**2457**) consisting of dark-brown sandy-silt containing numerous large stones

Pit **2454** was situated at the northern end of **2426** circa 0.2m to the north of Pit **2456** and linked to it by a shallow conjoining channel with a width of 1.16m and a depth of 0.1m. This pit was sub-oval in plan measuring 1.34m north to south by 1.1m east to west and had a depth of 0.25m. It contained a single fill (**2455**) consisting of dark-brown sandy-silt.

### *Roundhouse*

The roundhouse (Fig. 8, Fig. 20-22) was situated on the eastern edge of the Phase 2 area and was clearly visible on oblique aerial photographs. It consisted of a penannular outer ring-ditch (**2458**) with an external diameter of c.9.5m and an internal diameter of c.5m, with a gap of c.1m between the two ends marking the location of



the entrance on the south-west. The penannular ditch contained a ring of twelve fairly evenly spaced post-holes (numbered clockwise from entrance as **2543**, **2503**, **2507**, **2505**, **2515**, **2513**, **2517**, **2518**, **2521**, **2523**, **2525** and **2529**). An additional three post-holes (**2509**, **2511** and **2473**) were identified on the inside of the ring within the north-western part of the ditch. A thirteenth post-hole (**2537**) completing the ring was located outwith the ditch in the entranceway. Within the interior of the penannular ditch there was a smaller concentric ring-ditch (**2483**) running around c.60% of the inner circle on the eastern side; eight individual post-holes (**2599**, **2535**, **2597**, **2531**, **2477**, **2481**, **2479** and **2560**) were identified within this ditch.

Six slots (Slot 1-6) (Fig. 9) were excavated across the penannular ring-ditch and ten sections were recorded. Examples of recorded sections are shown on Fig. 12a-c and Fig. 23. On its eastern side the ditch was fairly substantial, measuring c.2.5m in width and 0.55m in depth, but along parts of its north-western side, it had reduced down to 1.7m wide by 0.12m deep. The deeper parts of the ditch recorded within Slots 1-3 contained two fills, with the lower fill consisting of tightly packed river-rolled cobbles (**2470**, **2494** and **2502**) and the upper fill consisting of dark-brown/black sandy silt (**2469**, **2772** and **2497**). Within Slots 4-6 the ditch contained one fill only (**2487**, **2491** and **2499**) consisting of the same dark-brown/black sandy silt as the upper fill within Slots 1-3. The material from this upper layer extended across to seal inner ring-ditch **2483**. A single sherd of prehistoric pottery was recovered from upper fill **2469** (Slot 2) and a piece of worked flint was recovered from upper fill **2472** (Slot 3).

The thirteen post-holes (numbered clockwise from entrance as **2543**, **2503**, **2507**, **2505**, **2515**, **2513**, **2517**, **2518**, **2521**, **2523**, **2525**, **2529** and **2527**) forming the post-ring typically had diameters of 0.4-0.5m and depths of <0.05m (**2543**) to 0.35m (**2525**). They were generally fairly evenly spread at a distance of c.1.5m apart, although this gap did widen slightly to c.2m apart along the southern curve of this feature (Fig. 24). Sections of these post-holes in relation to the ring-ditch are shown on Fig. 13a-l.

Ditch **2483** was concentric to penannular ditch **2458** and extended c.60% of the way round the interior (c.8m in length). It had a width of c.0.3-0.4m and a depth of c.0.3m. Eight individual post-holes (**2599**, **2535**, **2597**, **2531**, **2477**, **2481**, **2479** and **2560**) were identified. These post-holes typically measured 0.4m in diameter and had depths of up to 0.3m. This would suggest that there was an inner wall to the roundhouse consisting of closely spaced and fairly substantial timber uprights. Where individual post-holes were not identified, there was what appeared to be a continuous post-trench of a similar width (0.4m) and depth (0.3m) to the post-holes. It is unclear why this ditch only extended part of the way round the circle, but three substantial posts (**2509**, **2511** and **2473**) within the penannular ditch on the inside of the post-ring may have served a structural function in relation to the inner wall.

Six shallow post-holes (**2548**, **2550**, **2552**, **2554**, **2556** and **2558**) were identified lying externally to the penannular ring-ditch, curving out in an arc from its northern edge. They typically had a diameter of 0.3-0.4m and a depth of c.0.1m. The function of these post-holes is unclear as the arc is not concentric with the penannular ring-ditch. Three post-holes of similar dimensions (**2539**, **2540** and **2543**) were also identified close to the southern edge of the penannular ring-ditch.

### *Other features*

In addition to the features already discussed, a significant number of pits were identified in isolation, in small diffuse clusters, and in rough alignments. None of these pit clusters/ alignments were identified as having any potential to represent coherent structural remains. Basic details of these features are provided in tabular form in Appendix 1.

### *Rig-and-furrow*

The regular linear features seen on aerial photographs were found during the stripping to be cultivation furrows, with a wavelength of between 9m and 11m and surviving to a depth of c.0.2m. Where they cut the natural, their fills were removed to ensure no earlier features were concealed below them. No finds were recovered from the furrows.

A full list of the finds can be found in Appendix 4. A summary is presented in Table 1. The majority of the finds were prehistoric pottery and stone/lithics and are discussed below.

The only other find was two small pieces of burnt bone from the fill of pit **2369** and these are associated with six sherds of undiagnostic prehistoric pottery.

### **4.1 Prehistoric Pottery by Melanie Johnson**

Sixty-four sherds of prehistoric pottery, weighing 1773g, were recovered from a variety of features. Where possible, wares have been identified and spot dated. A summary is presented in Table 2 below. A catalogue is included in the archive.

Early Neolithic Carinated Bowl rim sherds were recovered from pits **2221** and **2366**, and possibly carinated body sherds were found in pits **2366** and **2241**. The rims are from open bowls and the rim tip tends to be folded over. This pottery would be expected to date to the first half of the fourth millennium BC.

A group of later Neolithic Impressed Ware pottery came from pits **2366**, **2372**, **2380** and **2384**. This assemblage includes decorated rim and body sherds. Body sherds from pit **2366** are decorated with deep rusticated fingernail impressions. Two different vessels from **2372** were recorded, a body sherd with randomly scattered fingernail impressions and sherds from a bowl with a rounded, slightly out-turned rim with a ridged body; the vessel is decorated with fingernail impressions between the ridges. Very similar vessels were also recovered from pit **2380**, which contained three different Impressed Ware vessels; these included two ridged bowls with flattened rims, and a ridged bowl with a slightly out-turning rim with internal bevel, forming a small neck; all of these vessels were decorated with fingernail impressions either randomly dispersed or in rough rows between the ridges, and only one of these vessels had fingernail impressions along the rim top. Pit **2384** contained a large portion of a vessel, including rim sherds, which was a thick, heavy upright bowl with a flattened rim top and a slight internal bevel, with a deep groove below the rim forming a neck; it was decorated with what appear to be large, shallow finger impressions along the neck. The Impressed Ware vessels are a little unusual in that the rims are not heavily embellished, and apart from one vessel from **2380** the rims are undecorated and do not have deep bevels.

Rim and body sherds from Neolithic Carinated Bowl were found in the same pit (**2366**) as some of the Impressed Ware (two body sherds decorated with deep rusticated fingernail impressions); this could indicate that the fill of this pit has a mixed origin. A thin, straight-sided rim sherd from pit **2380** also appears to be out of place with respect to the rest of the assemblage from this feature, and may be a residual earlier Neolithic sherd.

Late Neolithic Impressed Wares are generally dated to the early to mid third millennium BC, although the dating has been pushed back in recent years into the second half of the fourth millennium (cf Cook 2016, Cameron 2002).

Undiagnostic body sherds, but whose fabrics suggest an earlier prehistoric date, came from curvilinear feature **2289** and pits **2338**, **2369** and **2372**.

A single body sherd from **2468=2458** (roundhouse ring-ditch) has been ascribed to the Late Bronze Age or Iron Age on the basis of its fabric, which is distinct from the rest of the assemblage in that it is coarse and contains large rock fragments of a type not seen in the other fabrics. There are no other sherds which can be ascribed with certainty to the later prehistoric period. This is unusual given the well-preserved remains of a later prehistoric roundhouse, and suggests that the roundhouse may be Iron Age in date rather than Bronze Age, as Bronze Age roundhouses would be expected to have reasonable-sized pottery assemblages associated with them (cf. Gray and Suddaby 2012, Johnson forthcoming).

## 4.2 Stone tools by Ann Clarke

Two flint tools including a scraper and knife/scraper both date to the Late Neolithic and were found in pits **2366** and **2372**, associated with the curvilinear ditch and pits 2. A quern (or possible polissoir) was found in another pit (**2380**) in this group, along with a cobble tool.

Other lightly worked hammerstones came from curvilinear ditch and pits 1 and close to the six post structure **2281**.

A flake of calcined flint is re-deposited in the roundhouse cut **2471**.

Further analysis of the Late Neolithic flint tools, quern/polissoir and cobble tool from pit group 2 is recommended. The recording of hammerstones from other features, in particular to investigate whether they can be dated, is also advised.

## 5. CONCLUSIONS

This programme of works identified extensive evidence of prehistoric activity throughout the Phase 2 area.

Seven significant concentrations of features were identified along with numerous isolated pits, pit clusters, and rough pit alignments. The seven areas identified as key features consisted of two six-post structures, two curvilinear features (possible ploughed out enclosures) with associated pits, a cluster of large pits (possible prehistoric sand-quarrying), a curvilinear feature consisting of three conjoined pits (visible on aerial photographs), and a roundhouse. Finds included pottery dating to both the Early and Late Neolithic and to the Late Bronze Age/Iron Age, flint tools dating to the Late Neolithic and stone tools dating to the prehistoric period were recovered during the excavation.

Spreads of pits containing Neolithic pottery are a common feature of this period in Scotland, and their presence here is representative of the typical type of domestic activity found in the earlier prehistoric period.

Ring-ditch roundhouses of this form would be expected to date from the Middle Bronze Age to the Iron Age and are not uncommon in the north-east of Scotland. On the basis of the lack of pottery finds, it is suggested that the roundhouse may be later in date (Iron Age) rather than Bronze Age.

Combined with the evidence from the Phase 1 programme of works, this would suggest that the area was occupied throughout much of the prehistoric period, from the Neolithic through to the Iron Age.

The results of the evaluation (Suddaby 2014) suggest that this concentration of prehistoric features continues further to the north-east. This area will be investigated at a future date when the Phase 3 programme of works is undertaken.

The requirement for a programme of post-excavation analysis and publication is subject to the decision of the Aberdeenshire Council Archaeology Service and would be outlined in a Post-Excavation Research Design (PERD).

The project archive, comprising all CFA record sheets, maps and reports will be deposited with the National Record of the Historic Environment (NRHE) and copies of reports will be lodged with the SMR.

A summary statement of the results of this evaluation will be submitted for publication in *Discovery and Excavation in Scotland* (Appendix 7) and an online OASIS entry submitted on completion of the project.

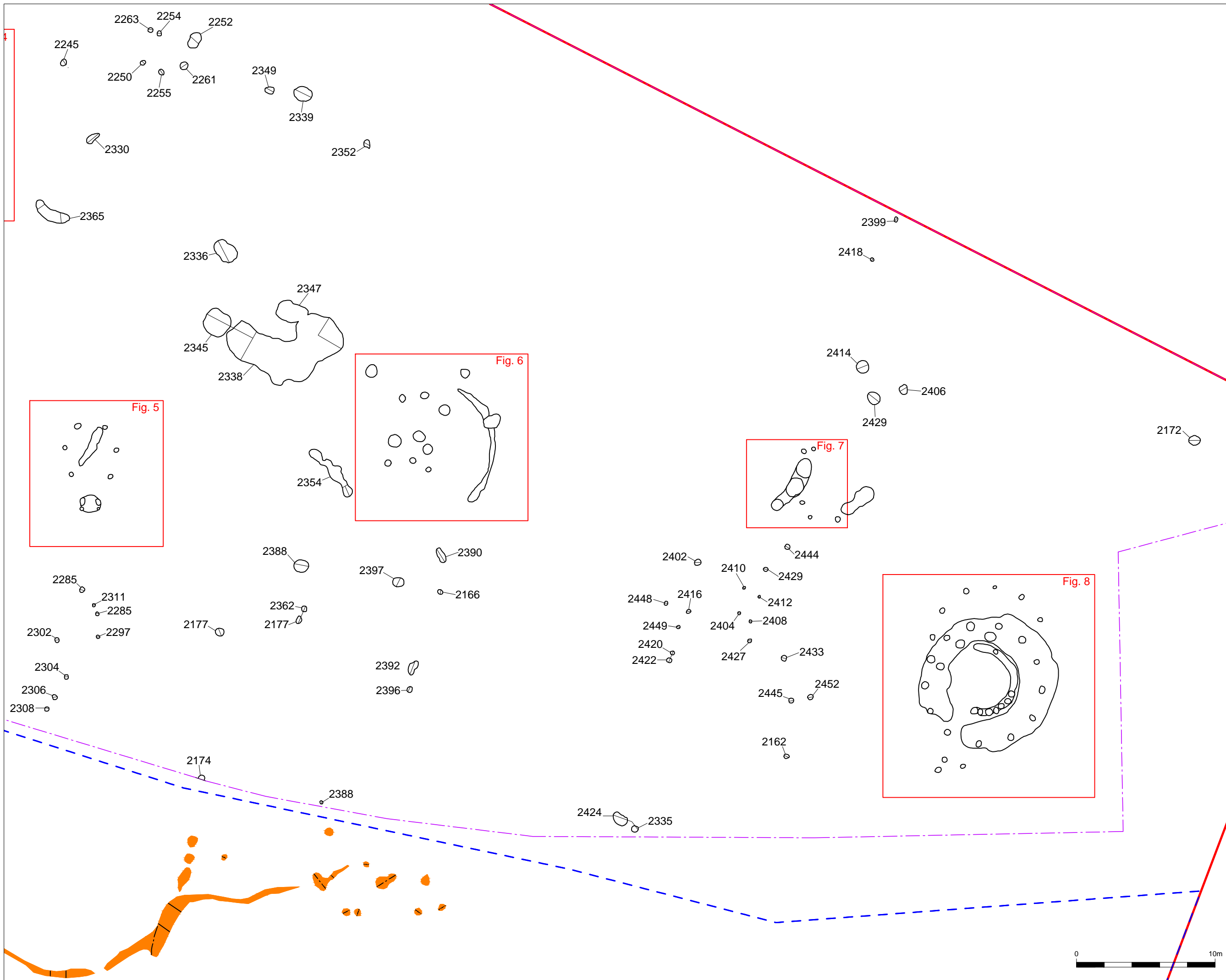

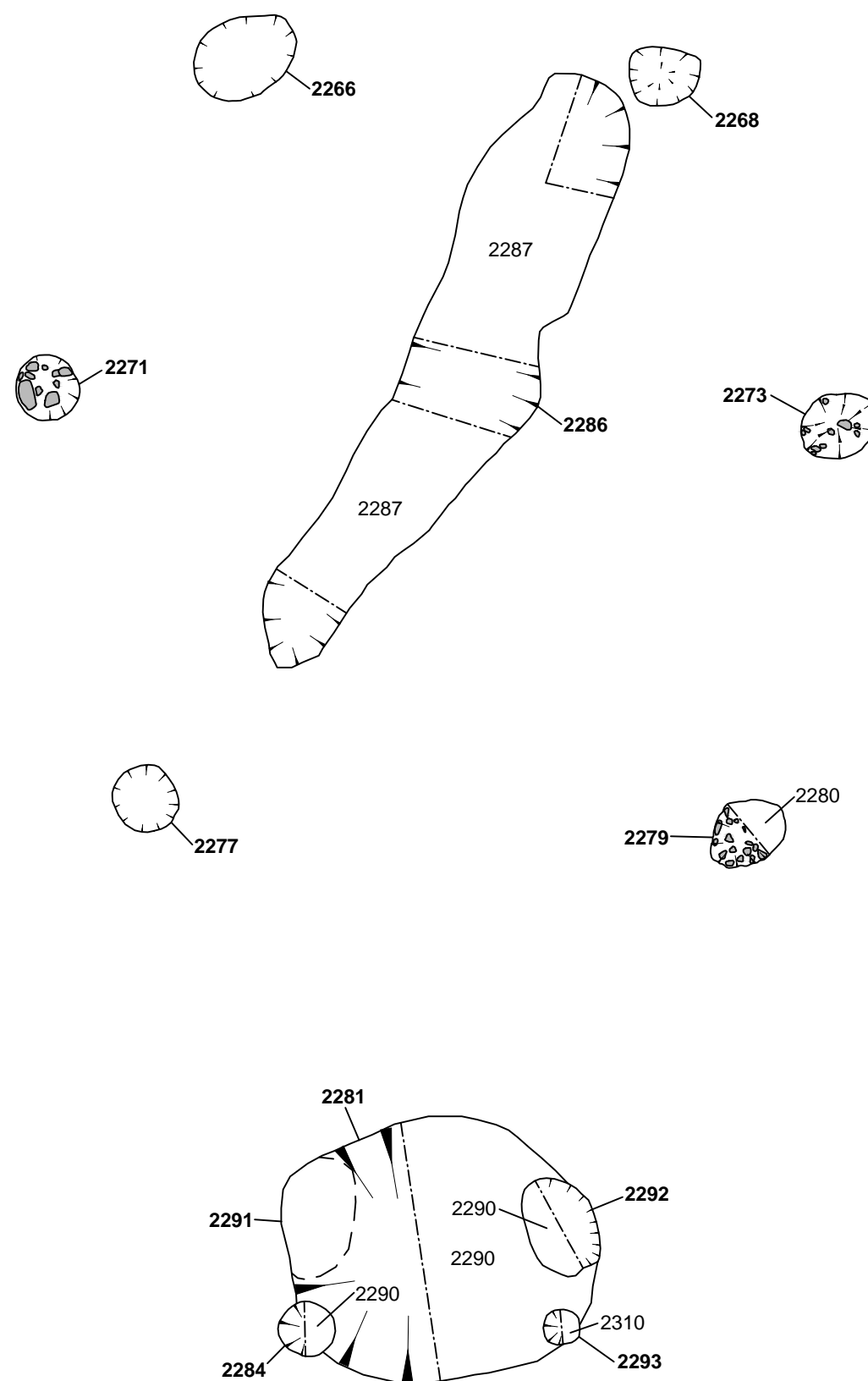

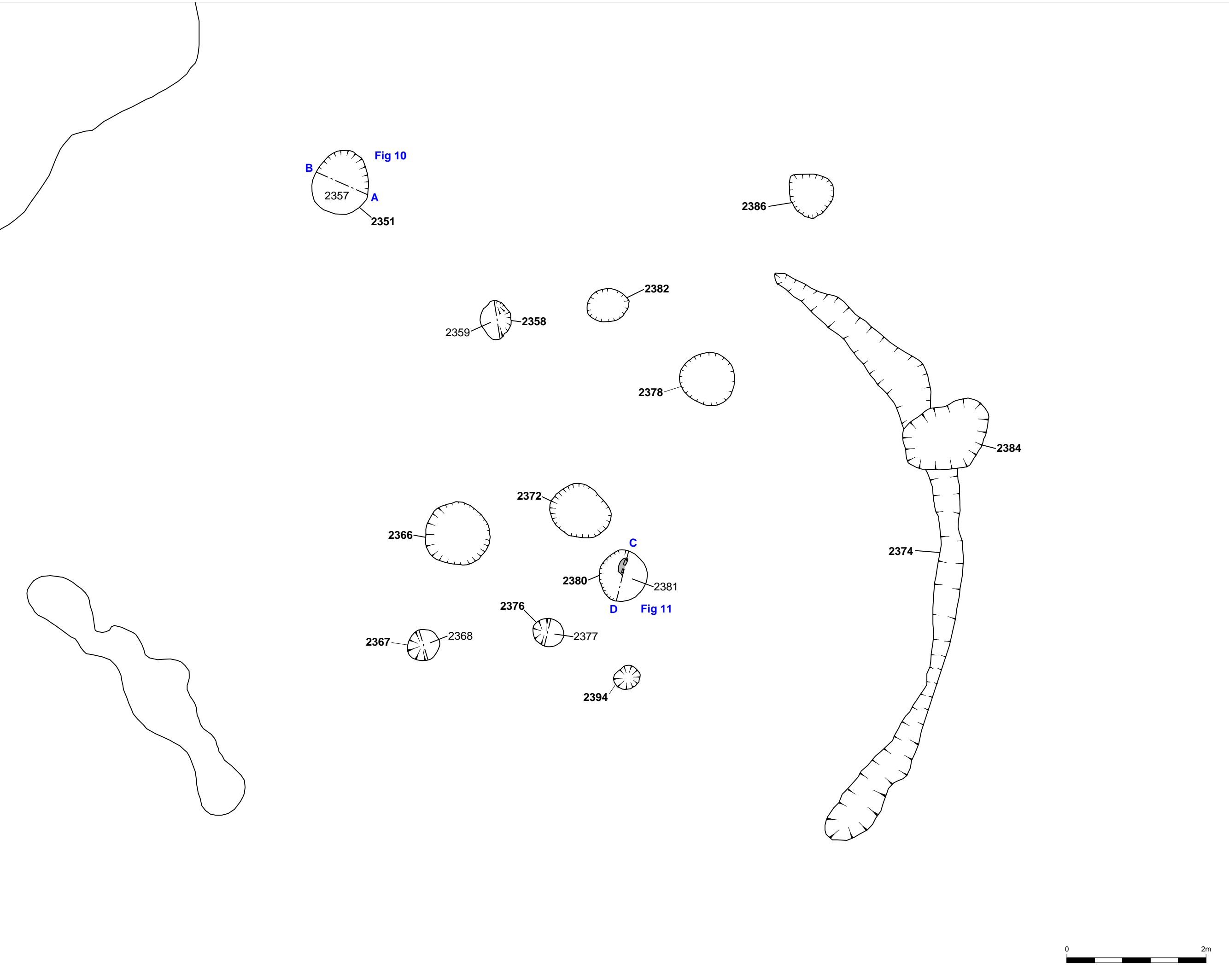

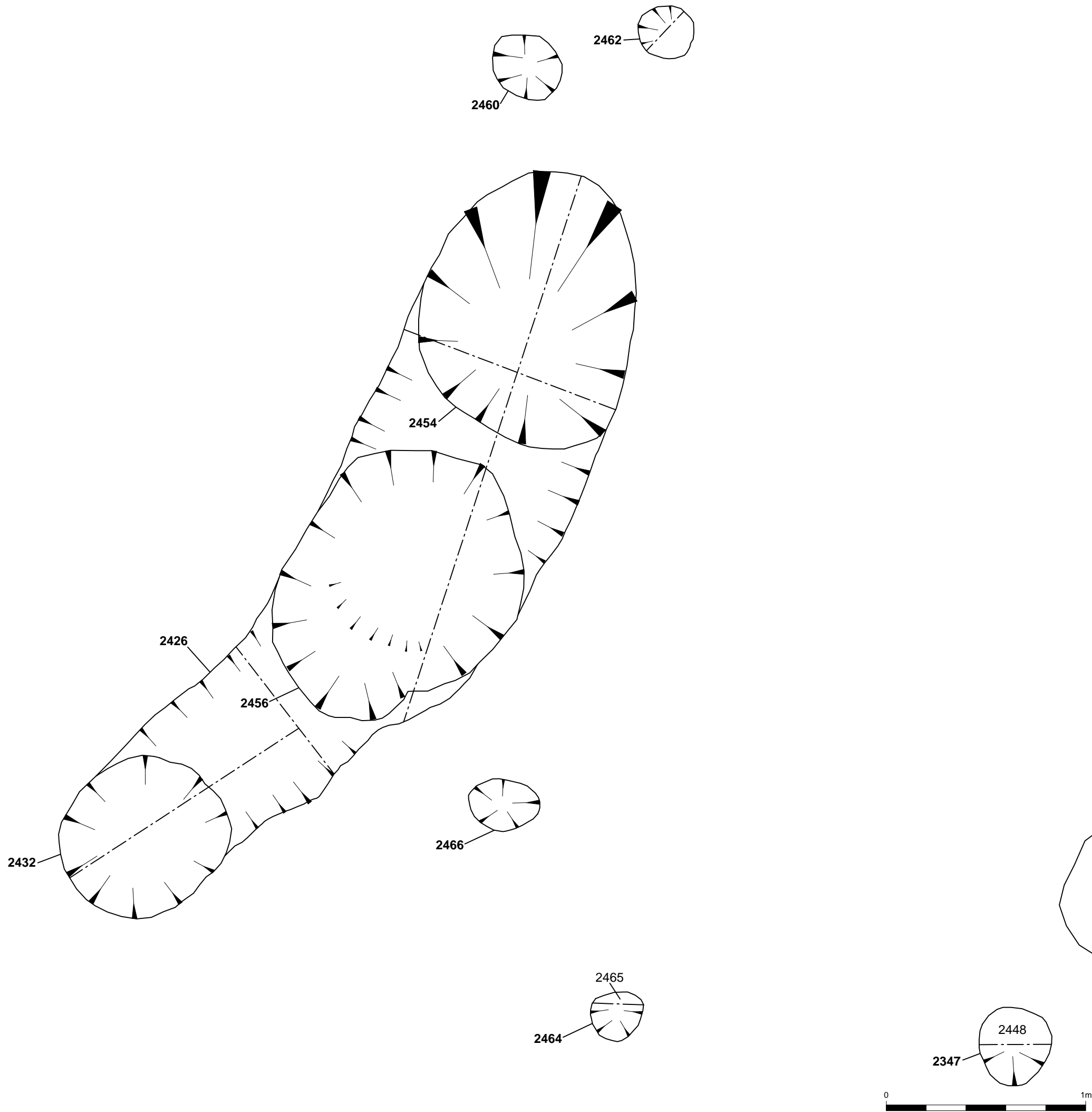

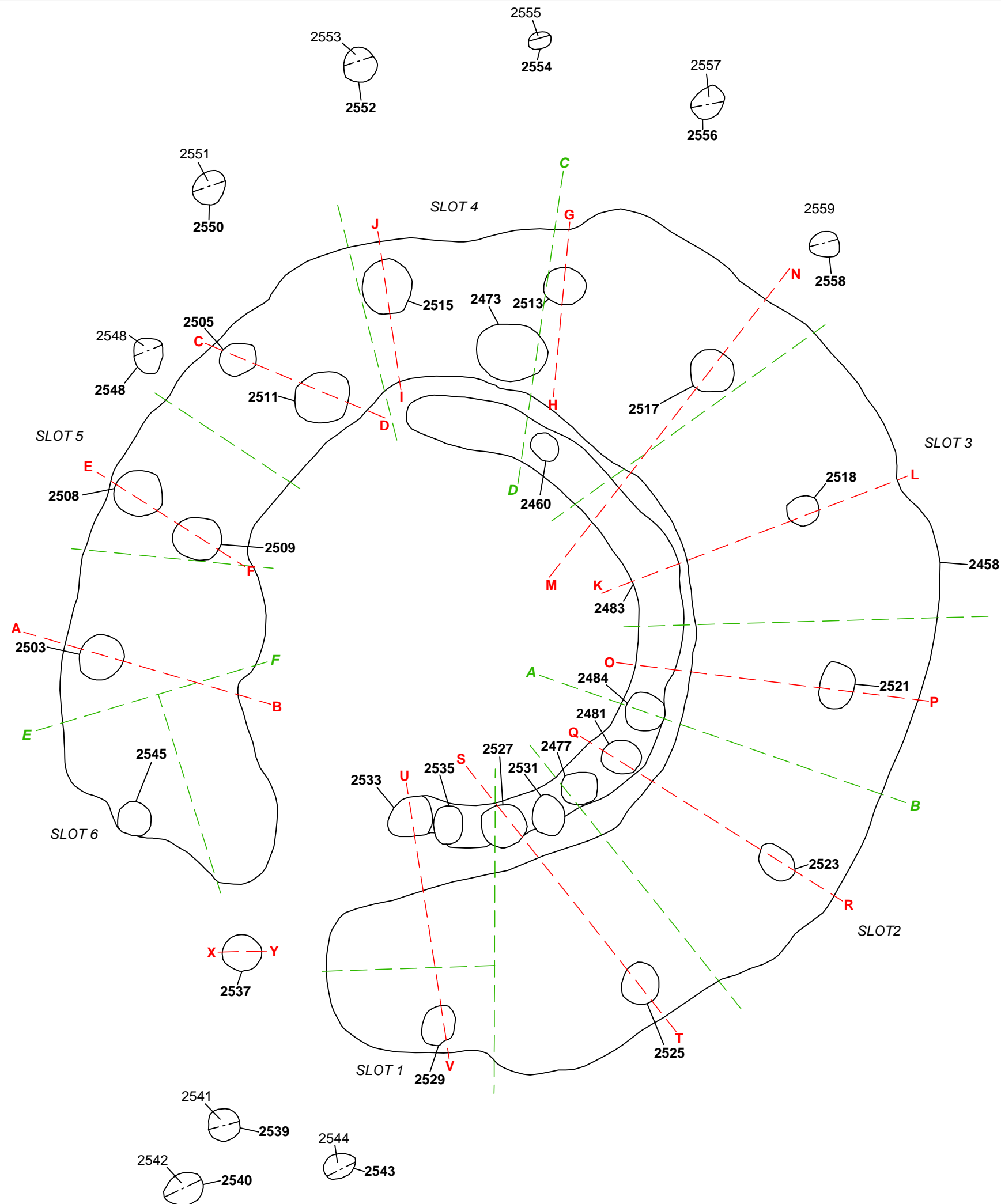

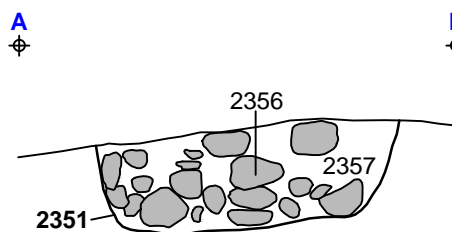


Fig.10 North-east-facing section of pit 2351

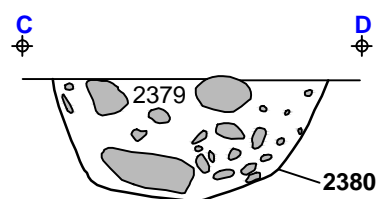


Fig.11 West-facing section through pit 2380

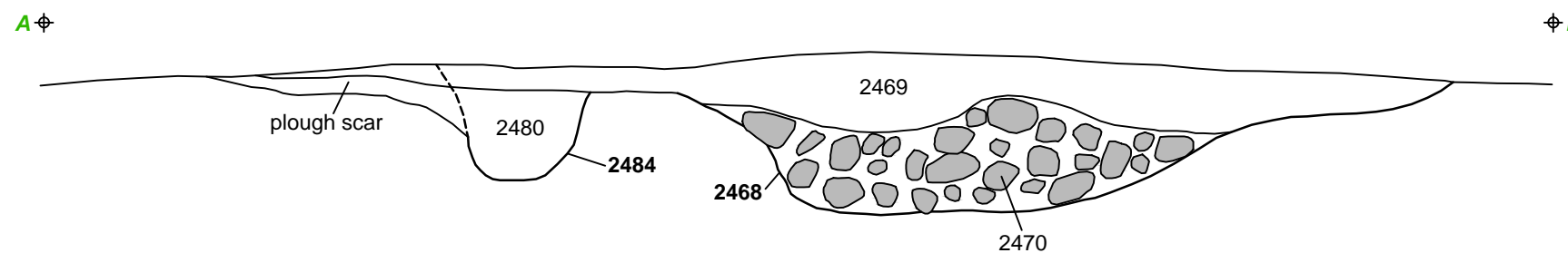


Fig.12a Section through ring-ditch

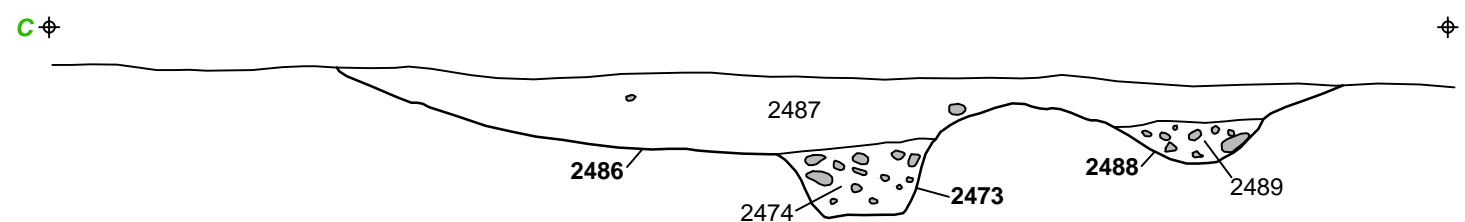


Fig.12b Section through ring-ditch

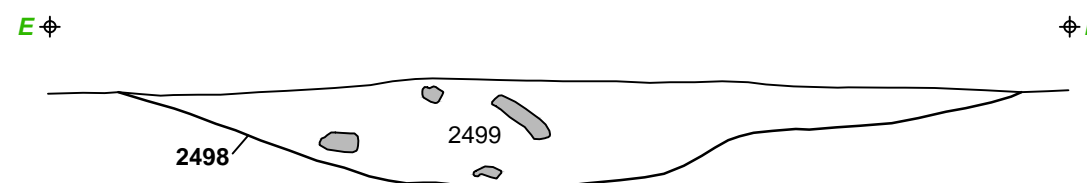


Fig.12c Section through ring-ditch

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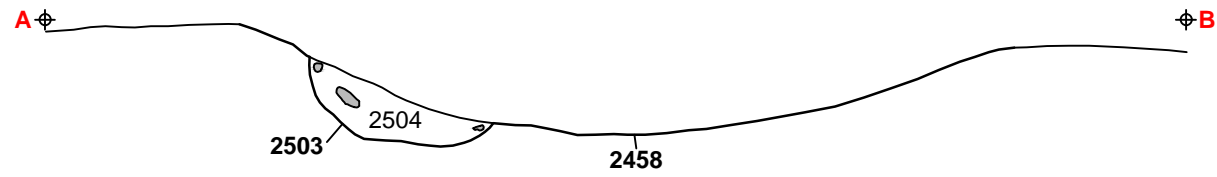

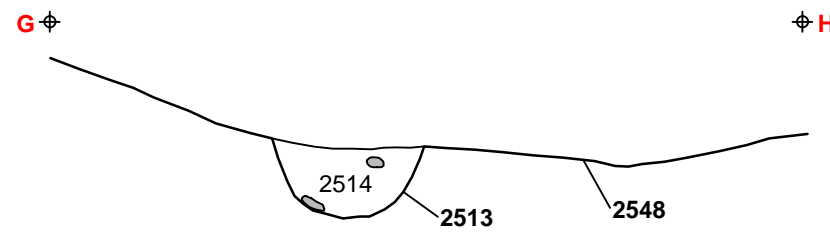

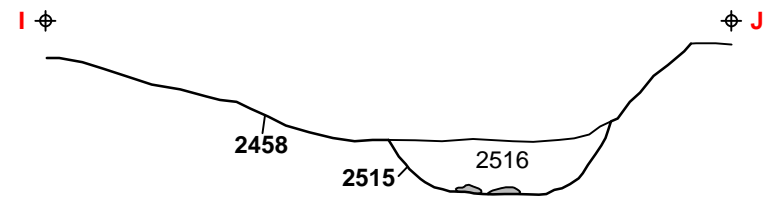

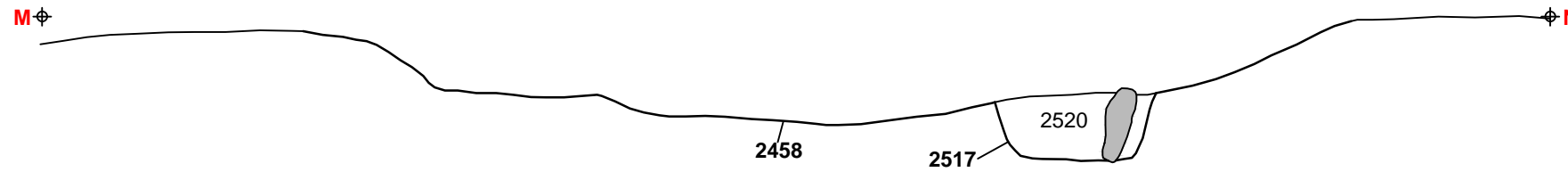

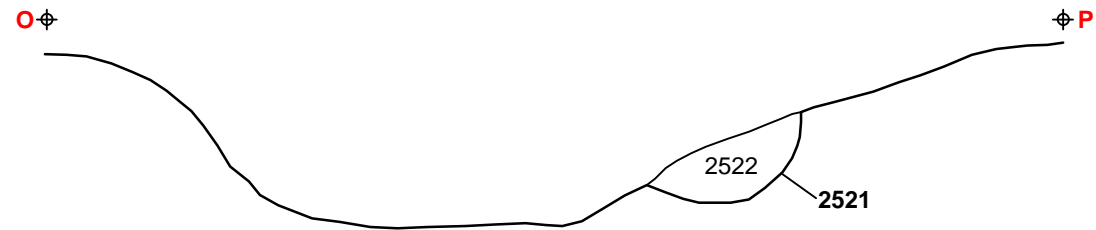

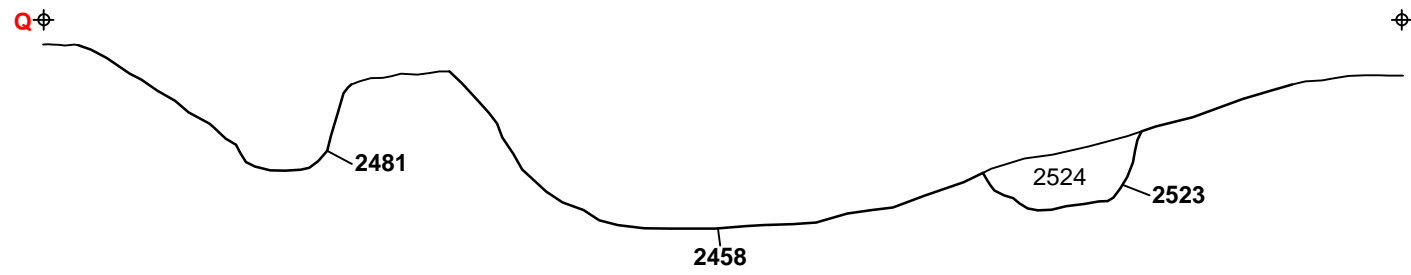

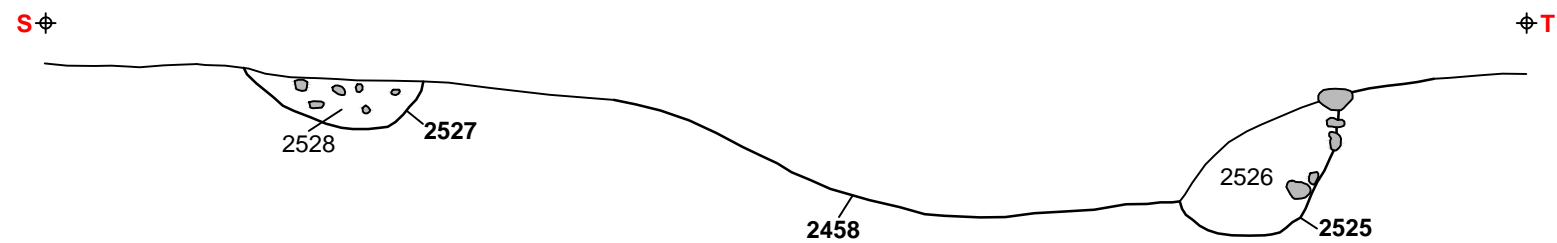

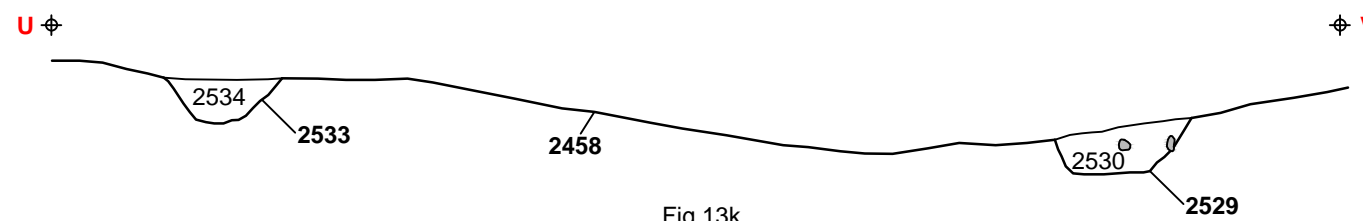

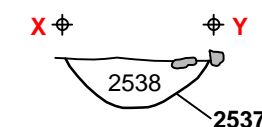
