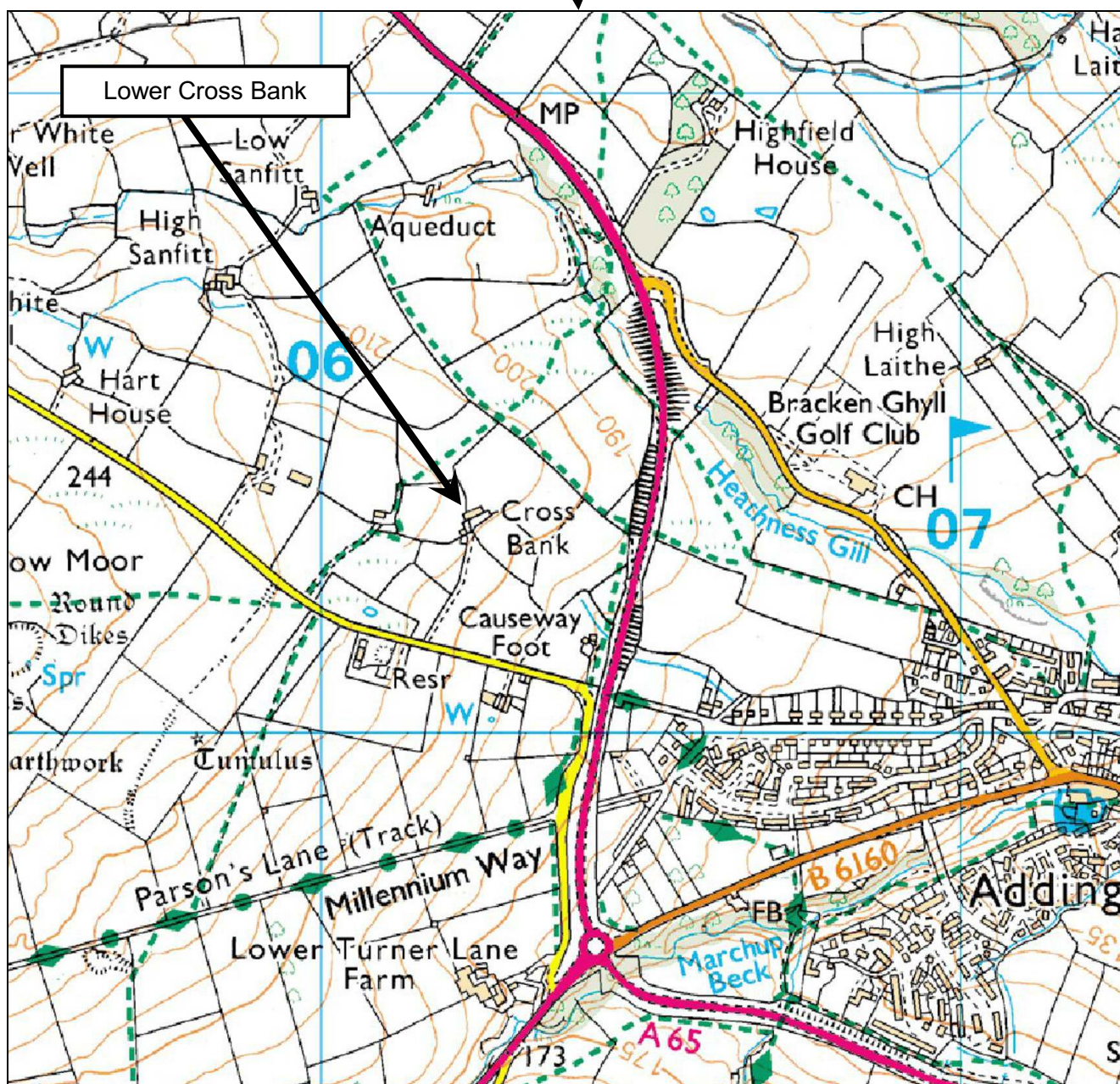


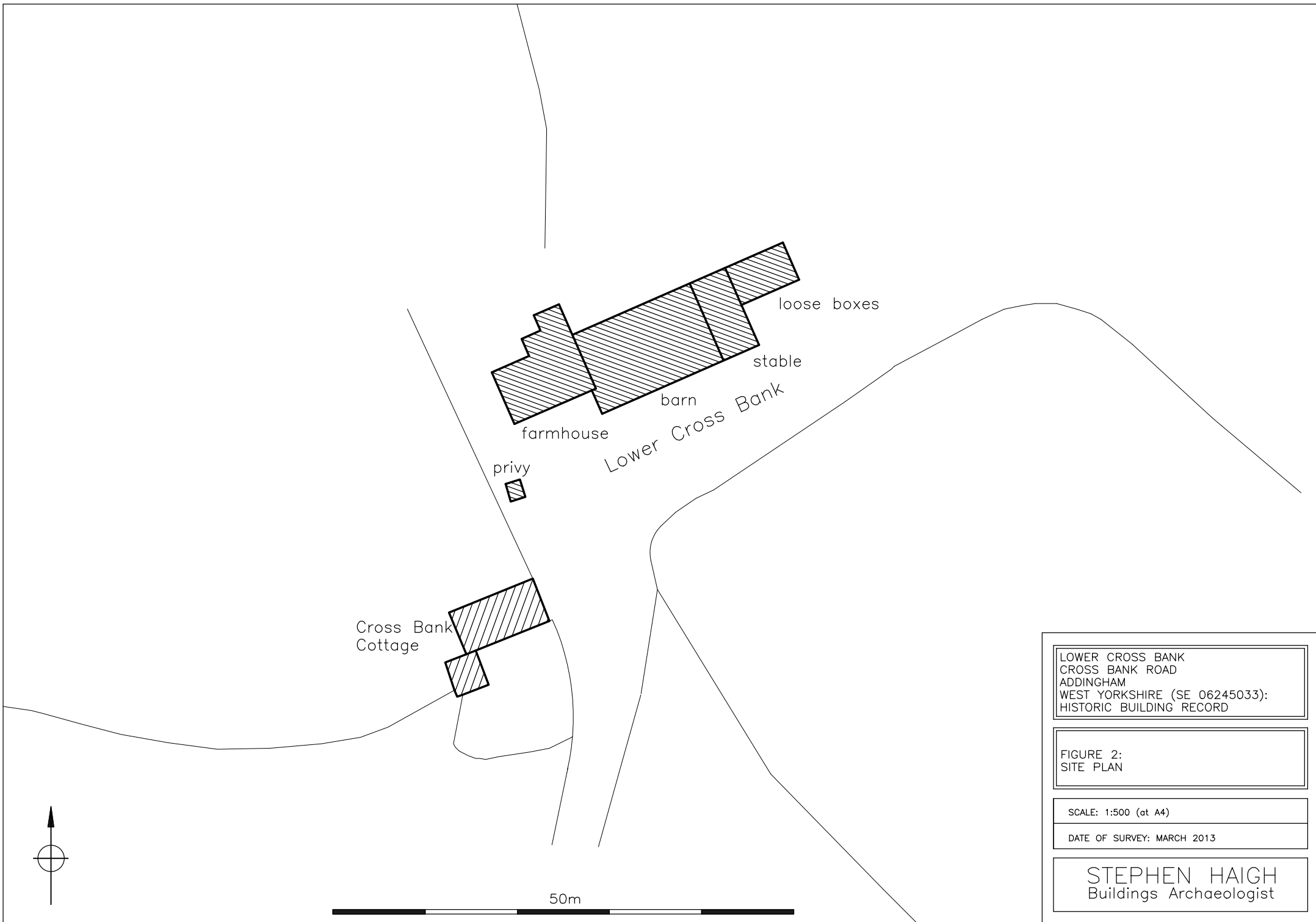

Figure 1: Location maps

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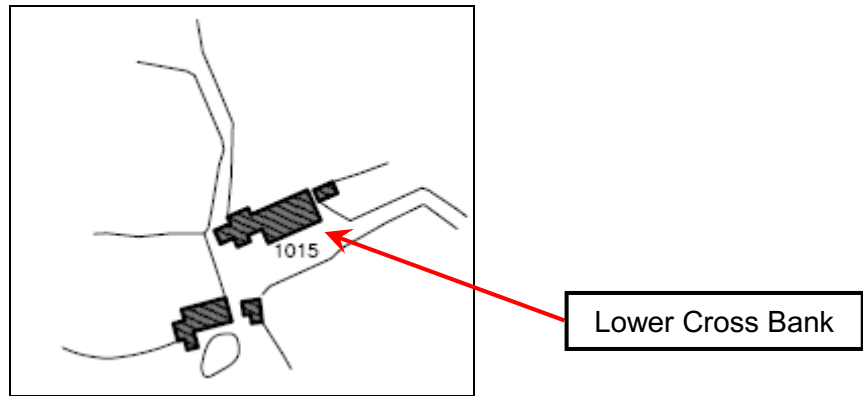


Figure 3: Sketched copy of map of 1817

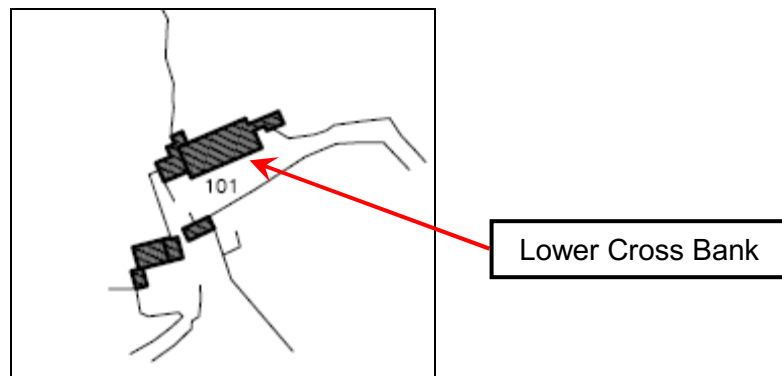


Figure 4: Sketched copy of map of 1843

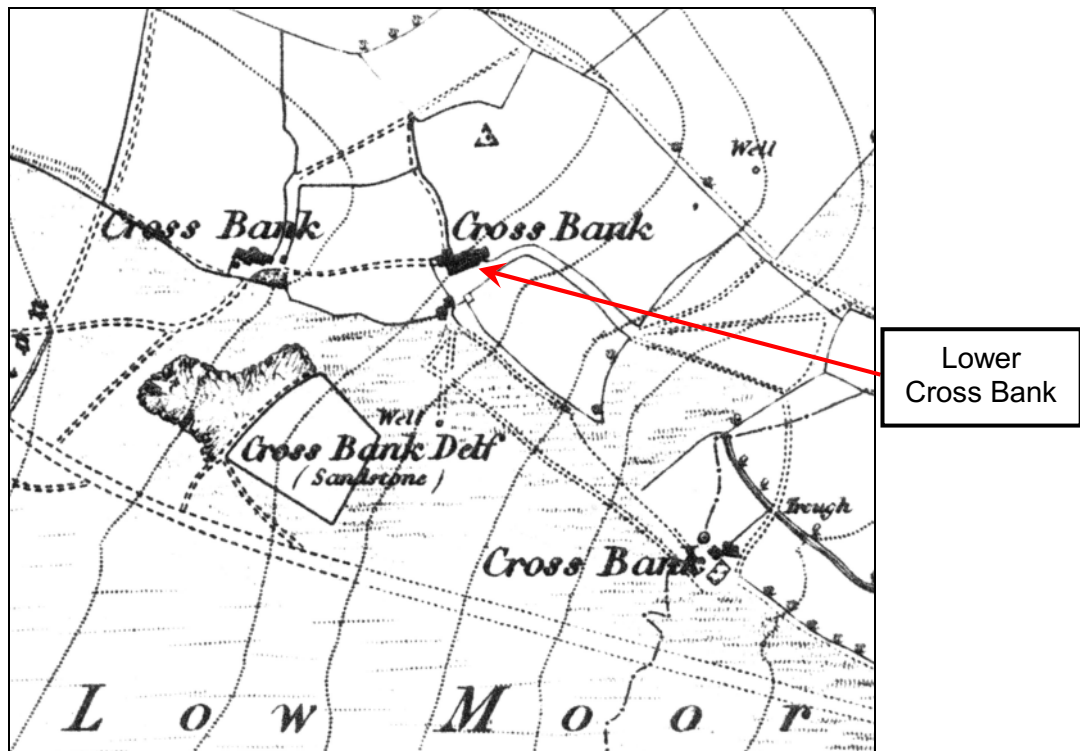


Figure 5: Ordnance Survey 1:10,560 map, published 1854 (surveyed 1850)

At this date Low Moor remained still remained unenclosed

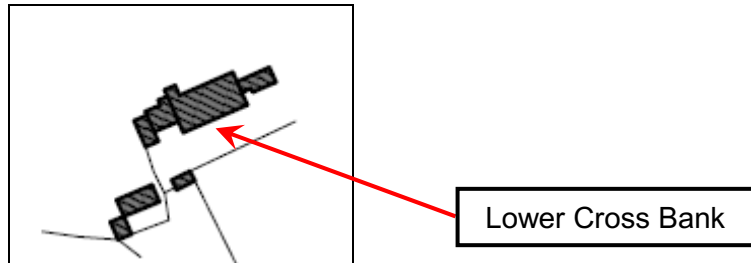


Figure 6: Sketched copy of map of 1873

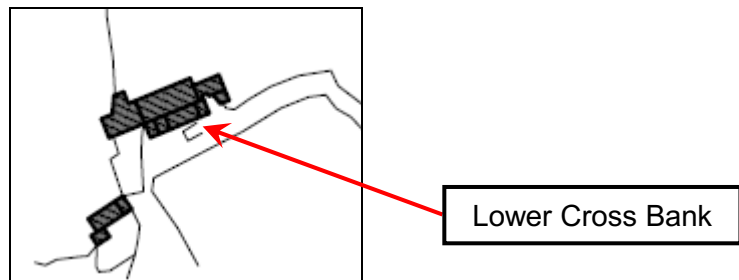


Figure 7: Sketched copy of Ordnance Survey 1:2500 map, published c.1893 (surveyed 1889)

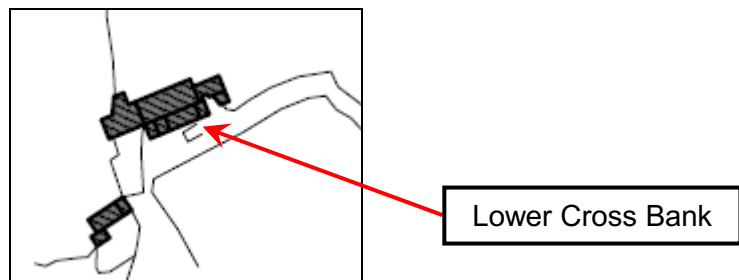
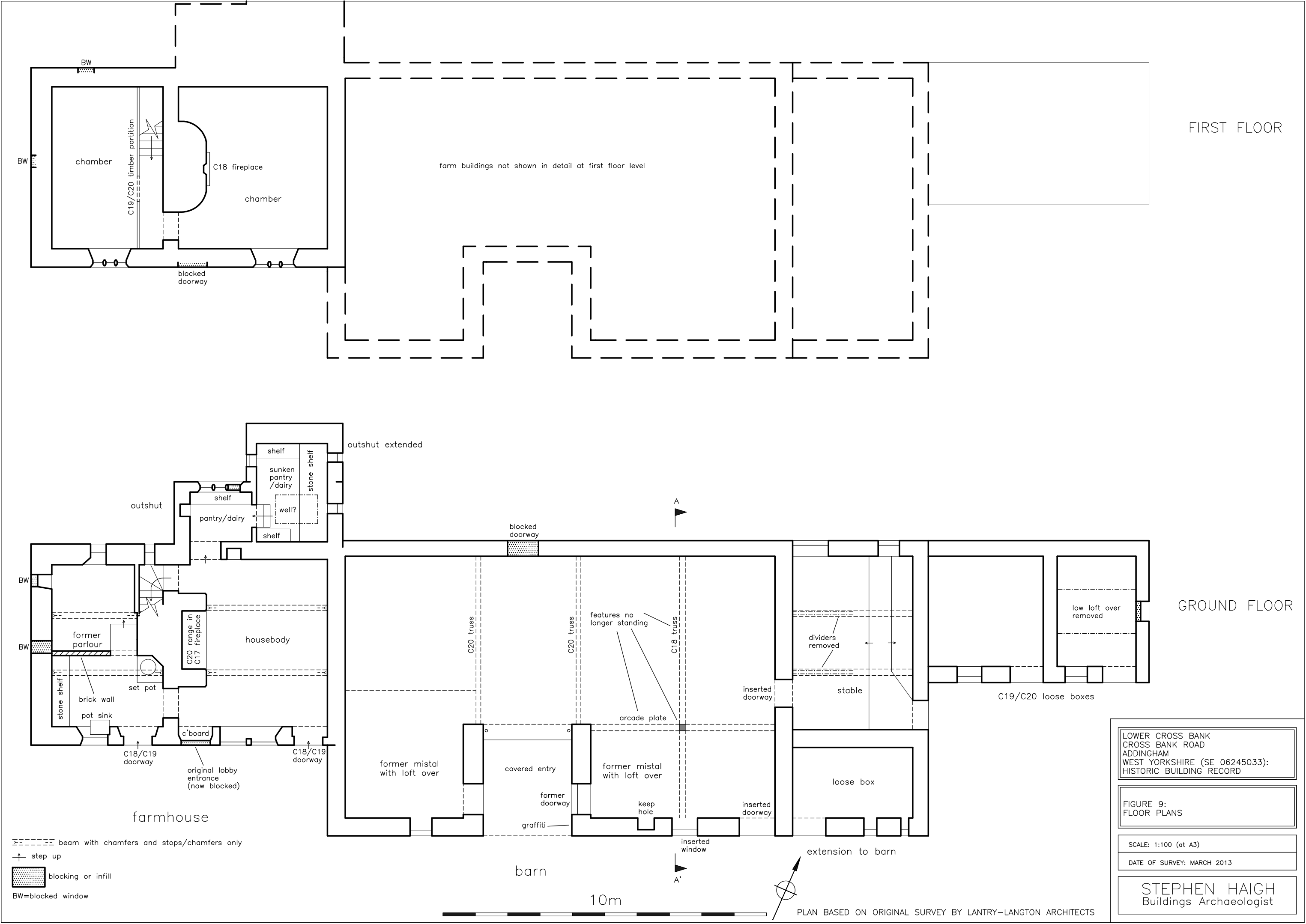
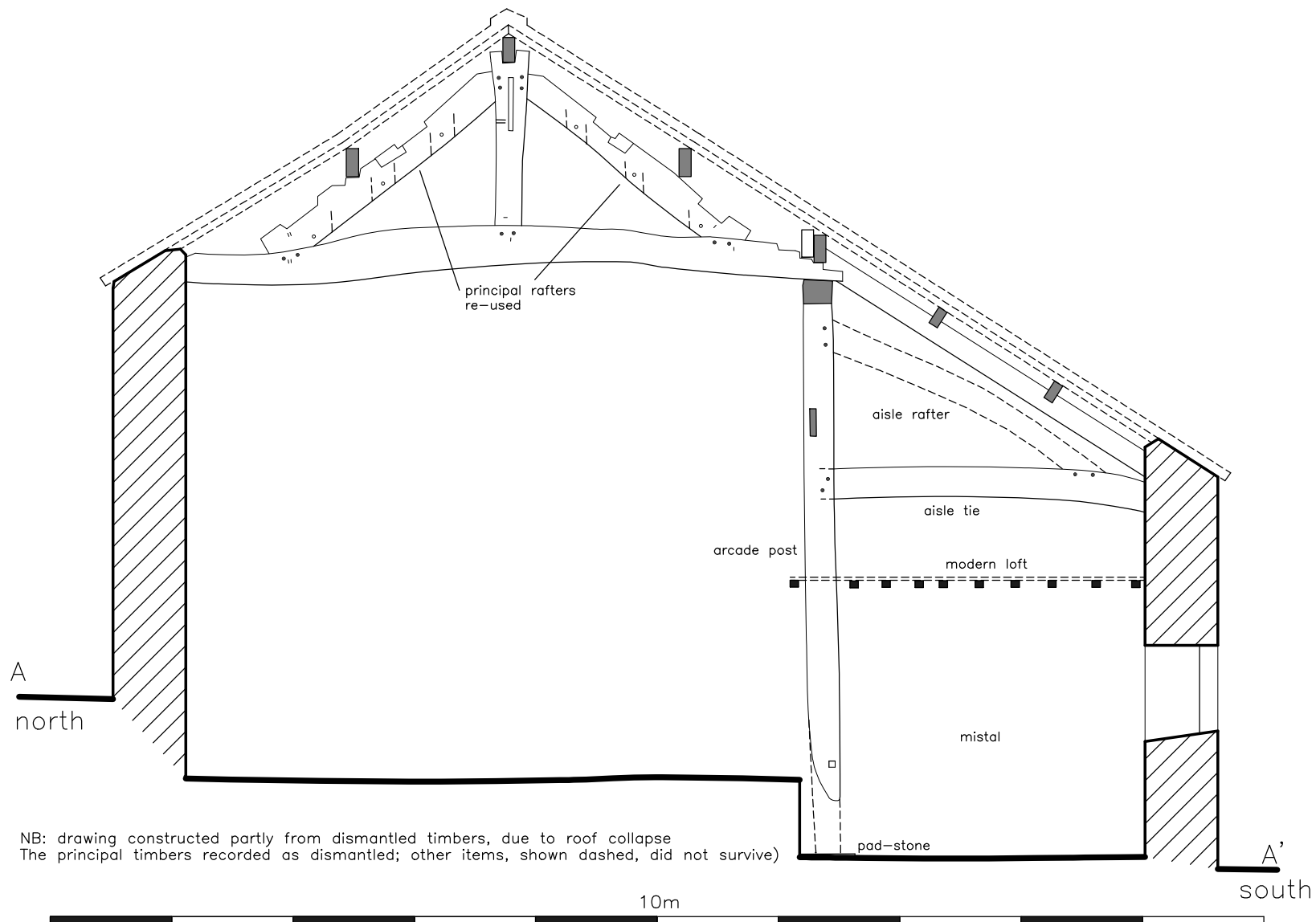


Figure 8: Sketched copy of Ordnance Survey 1:2500 map, published 1909 (revised 1907)
