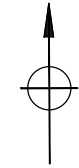
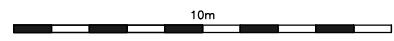
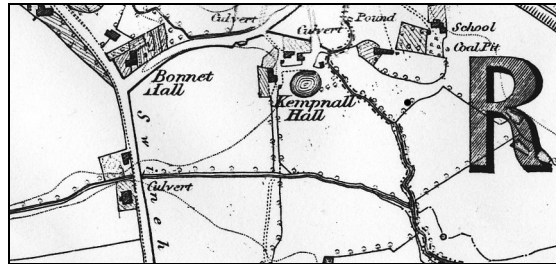




Figure 4: Depiction of Kempnough Hall on a map of c. 1590

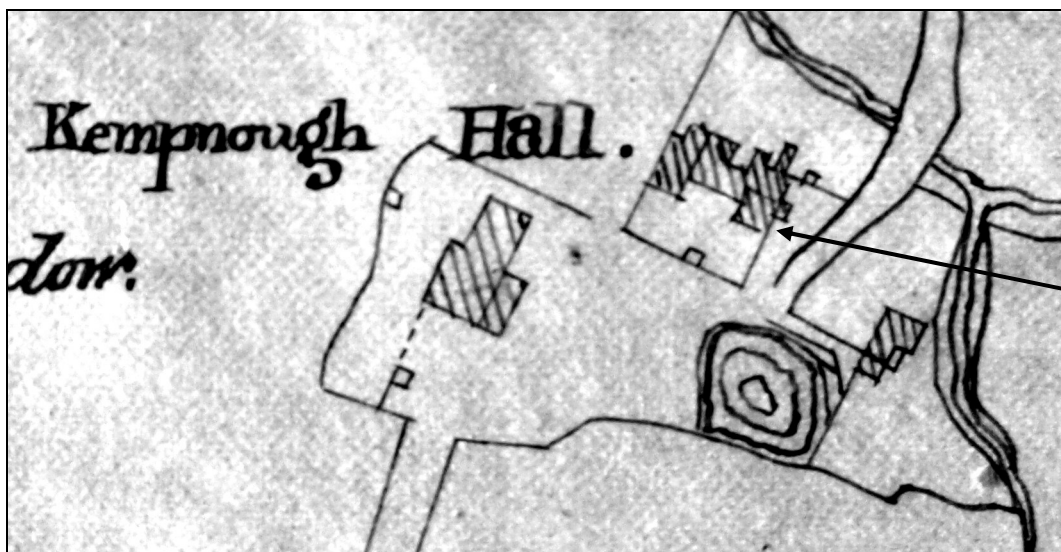
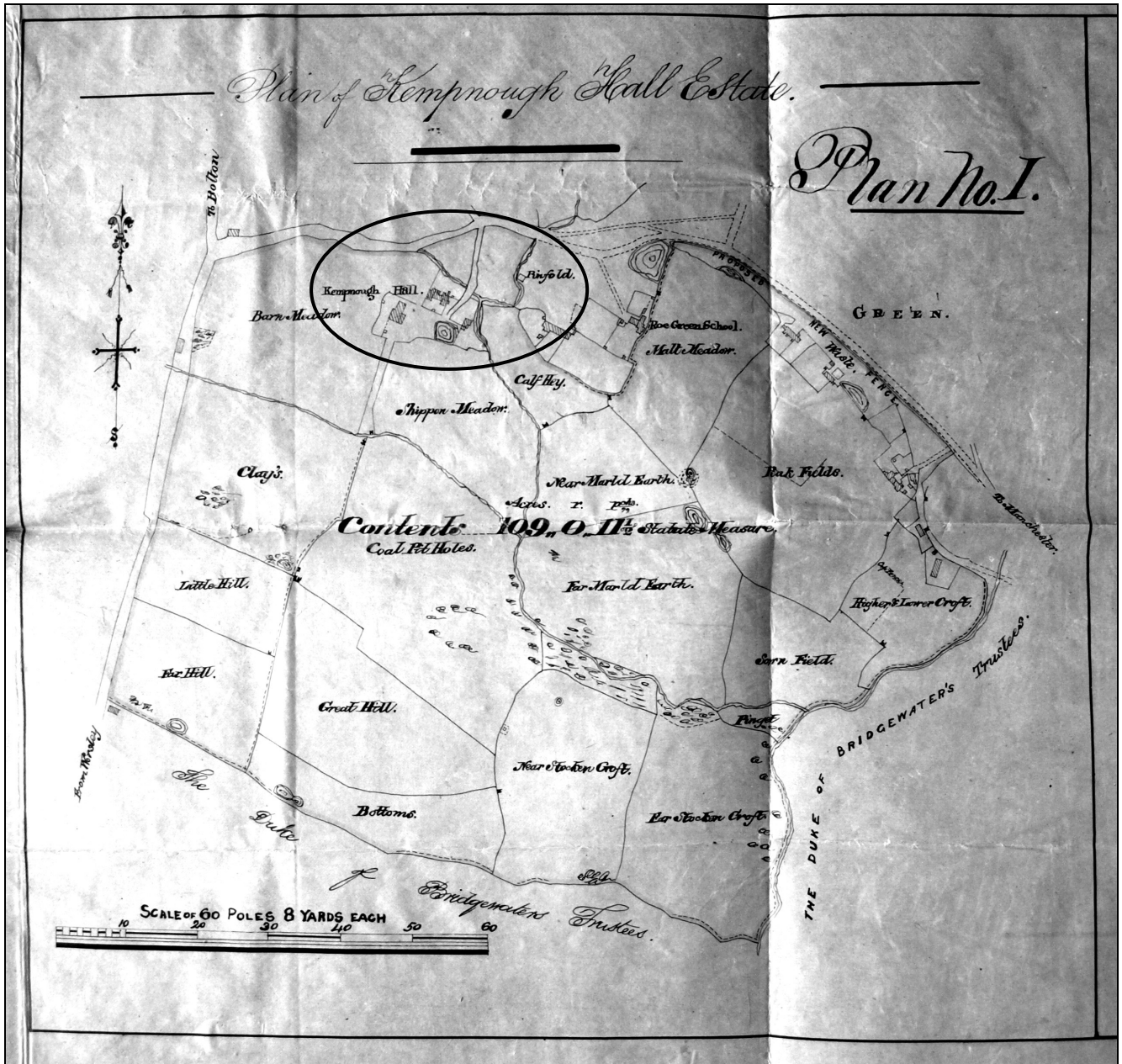


Figure 6: Plan of the Kempnough Hall Estate, 1874, with enlarged extract showing the hall and nearby buildings.

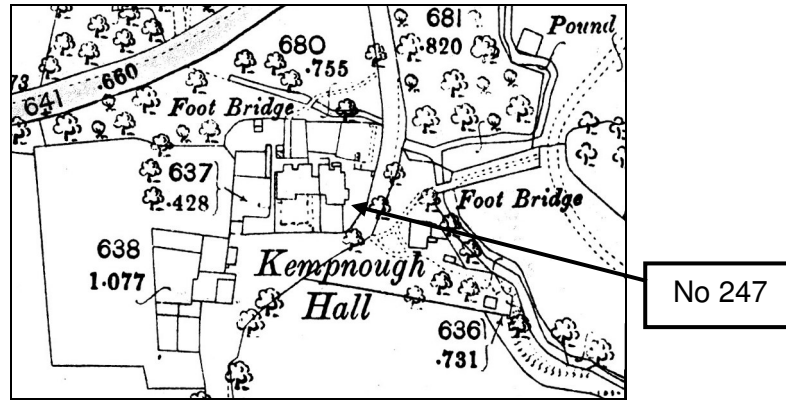


Figure 7: Ordnance Survey 1:2500 map, published 1893 (surveyed 1891)
Sheet no: Lancashire, 103.2

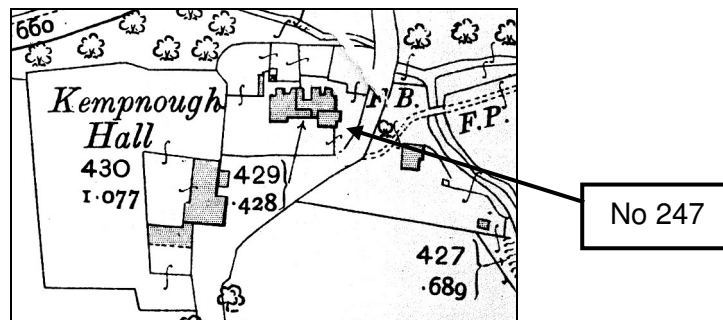


Figure 8: Ordnance Survey 1:2500 map, published 1908 (revised 1904)
Sheet no: Lancashire, 103.2

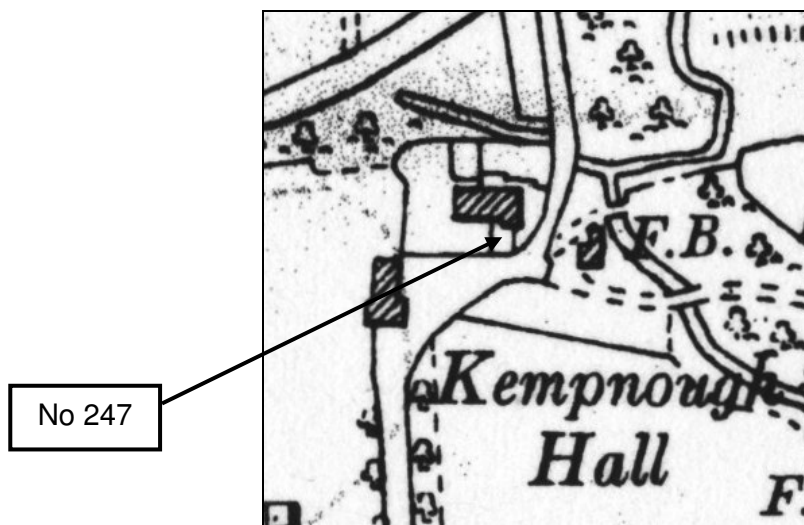


Figure 9: Ordnance Survey 1:10,560 map (enlarged to approx 1:2500), published 1929 (revised 1927)

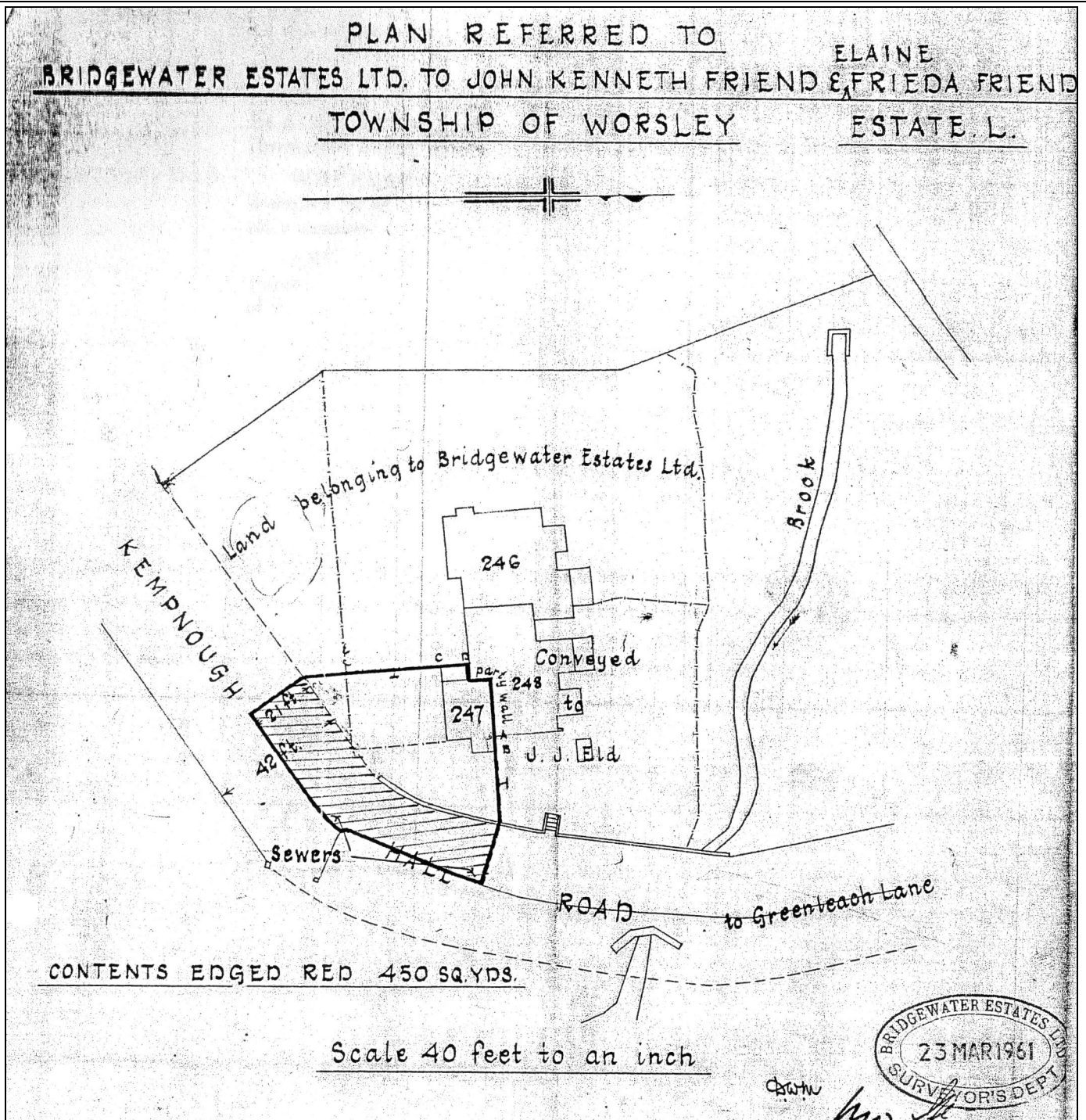


Figure 10: Plan of 1961, for the conveyance of the property from Bridgewater Estates Provided by Mr J Stott

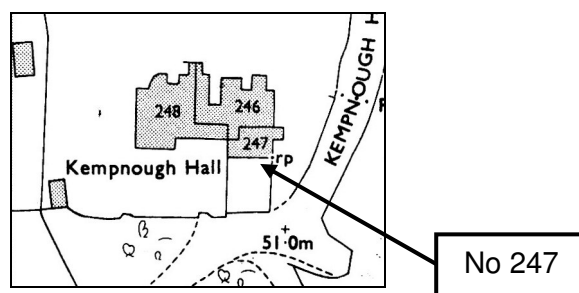


Figure 11: Ordnance Survey 1:1250 map, published 1972 Sheet no: SD 7401 NE
