SAMIAN STAMPS

Five samian vessels with stamps were recovered from the excavations at Latton Lands areas 6-9 and these all came from a single context (ditch 973); where they appear to have been deposited as part of a large dump of material. The stamps were all internal on central Gaulish form 18/31 dishes which were most likely made at Lezoux. A catalogue of stamps is presented below. Letters whose reading is slightly uncertain are underlined. It was not possible to ascertain any information on dies and therefore no additional information on the date of the vessels is available.
