Introduction (Fig. 1) Archaeological monitoring and recording was carried out by AC archaeology during groundworks associated with the construction of an extension to Canonsleigh Barton Farmhouse, Burlescombe, Devon (ST 06690 17368).				
Canonsleigh is the site of an Augustinian Abbey founded in the 12 <sup>th</sup> century. Surviving structures of the abbey consist of Grade I-listed 15th century gatehouse, and the Scheduled and Grade II-listed remains of a 14th to 15th-century probable <i>rere-dortar</i> or latrine block. Canonsleigh Barton Farmhouse lies within the former abbey precinct and is a Grade II-listed early 17 <sup>th</sup> century four-roomed house (Heritage List for England no. 1106456).				
<b>Description of Works</b> The groundworks comprised the excavations of footings for the extension footprint (Fig. 1 and Plate 1). An area measuring 7m by 4m was machine-excavated to a depth of approximately 0.5m below existing levels, with footings trenches measuring 0.6m wide dug around the perimeter to a total depth of 1.2m.				
The excavations exposed a simple sequence of a 0.3m thick dark brown clayey-loam topsoil overlying




