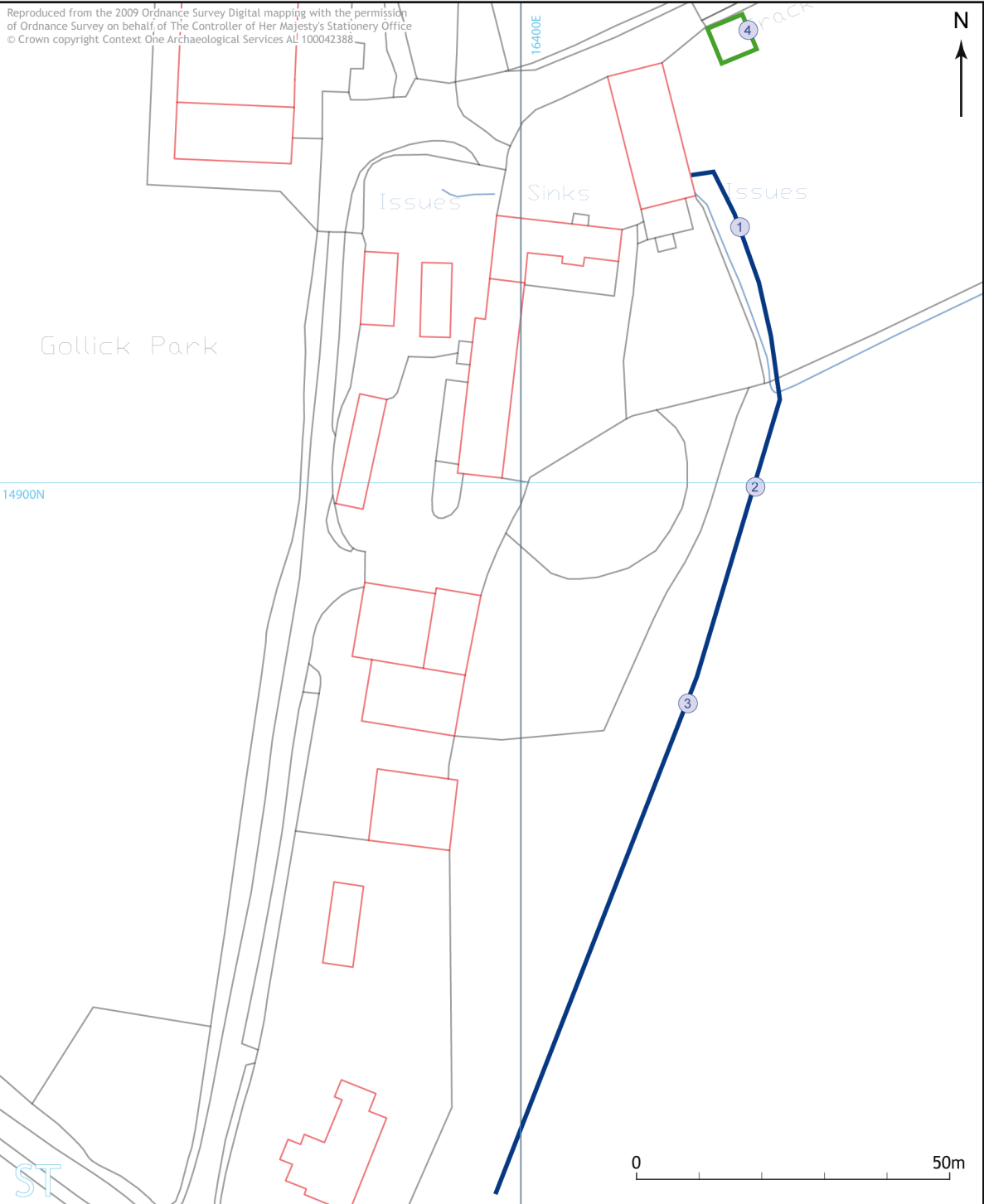

Description of works. Context One Archaeological Services Ltd (COAS) carried out an Archaeological Watching Brief on behalf of Mr & Mrs Bendle as a condition of granting planning permission for the conversion of an agricultural building into a live/work unit at Gollick Park Farm, Battle Street, Clayhidon, Mid Devon, Devon (see attached plan). In the Brief for Archaeological Monitoring and Recording it was stated that: "The farmhouse at Gollick Park dates to the 17th century, while the earliest documentary reference to the site is in 1566 as 'Gollakecoote'". The archaeological work involved the monitoring of a pipe trench dug across 180 metres of open ground and the excavation of foundations for a new garage. Four representative soil profiles were taken at regular intervals across the site (see attached plan); the stratigraphic sequence is presented below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Profile 1: 0m - 0.30m. Modern levelling layer. Soft sandy silty clay with gravel, modern pottery and tile inclusions 0.30m+. Natural. Bluish grey (GLEY 2 6/1) compact clay with occasional <0.05m chert inclusions • Profiles 2 to 4: 0m - 0.30m. Topsoil. Reddish brown (2.5YR 5/3) soft silty sand with gravel inclusions 0.30m+. Natural. Yellowish brown (10YR 5/6) compact silty clay with no inclusions No archaeological features or artefacts were observed or recovered.		Reference.
