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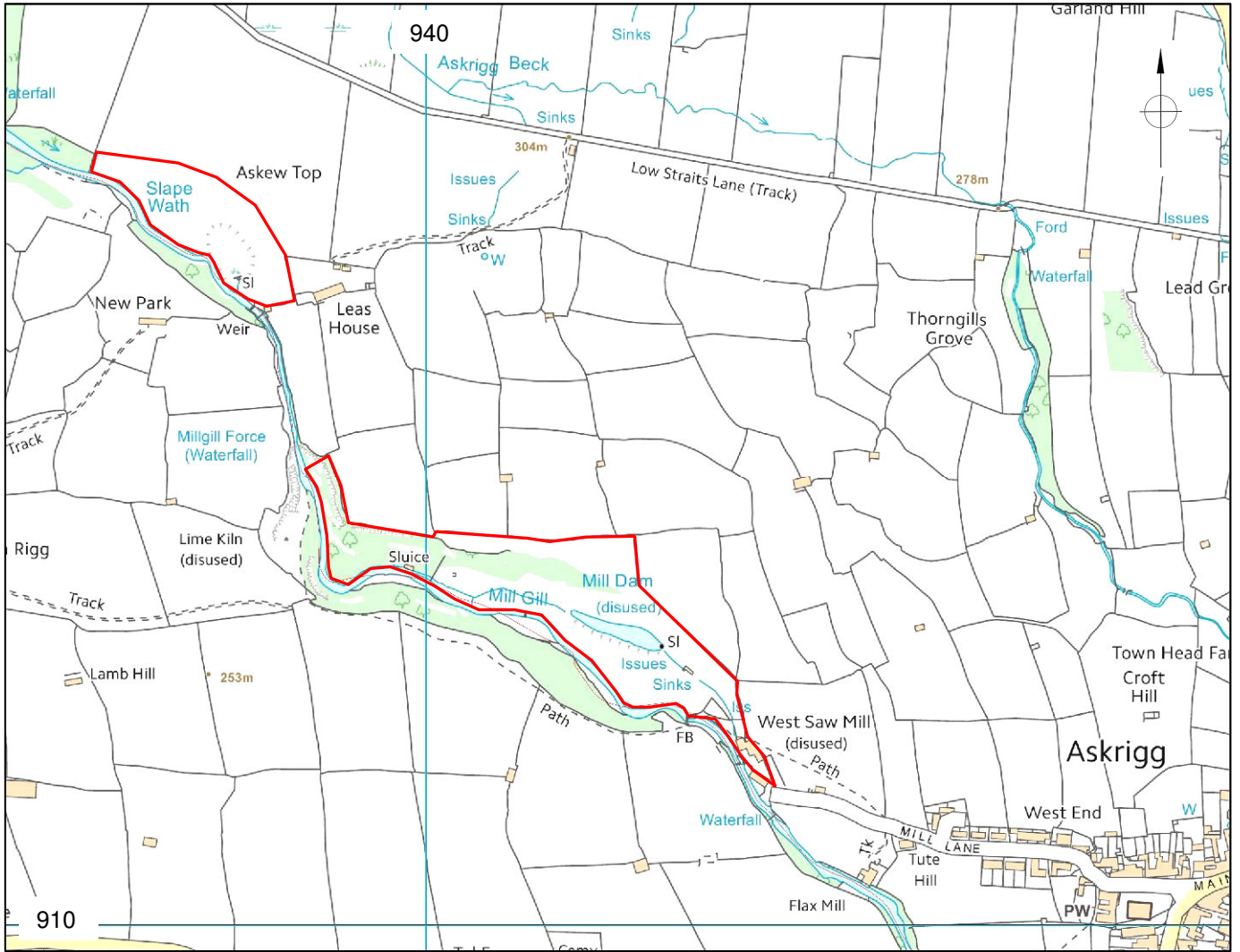

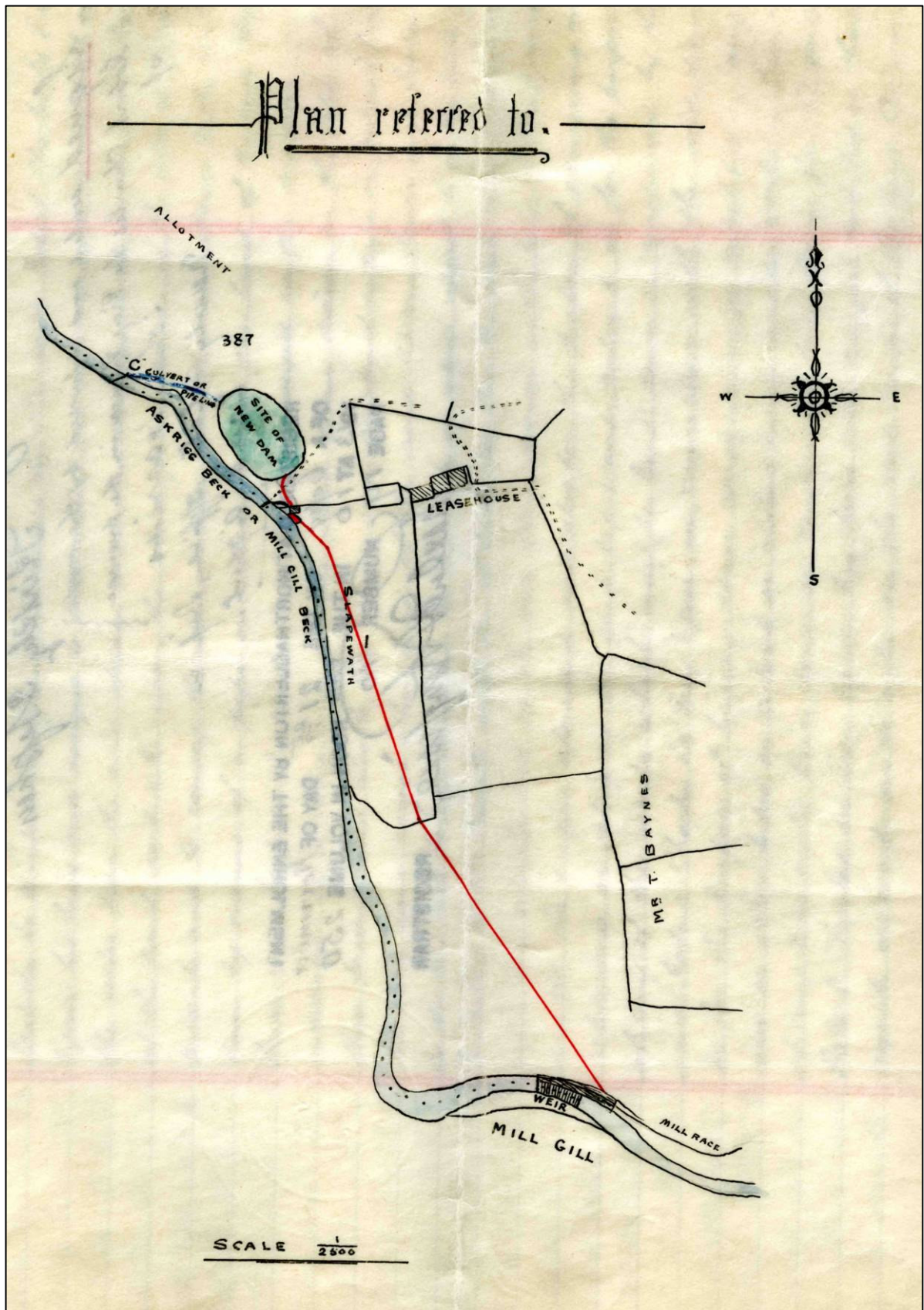

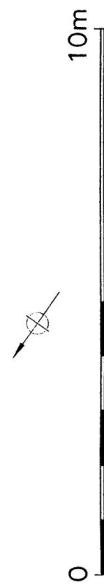


PROJECT	WEST MILL, ASKRIGG

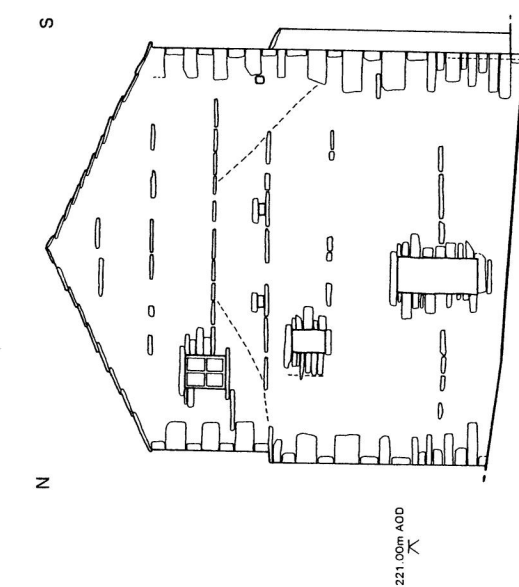




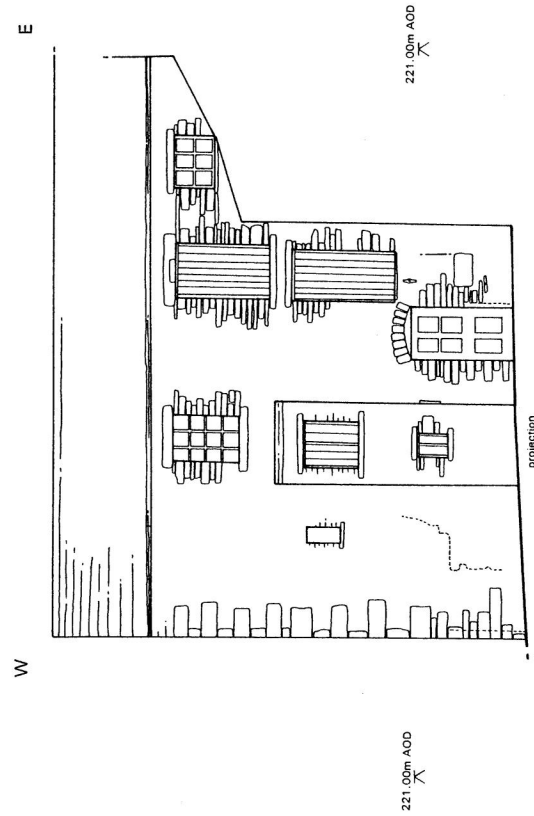
Elevation 4: east external elevation of mill

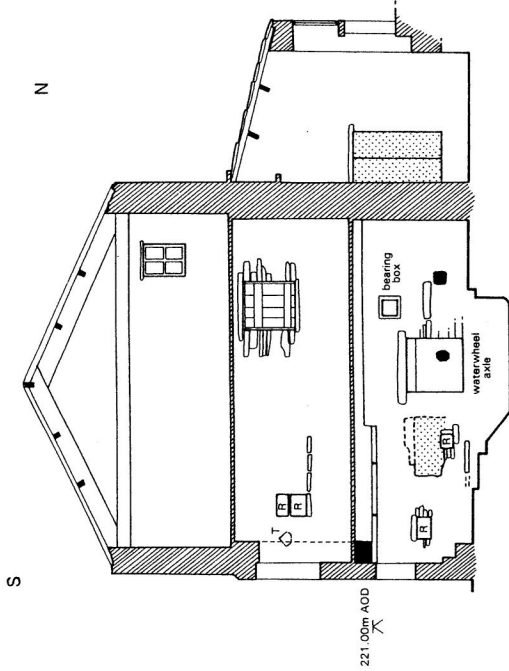
Elevation 11: south internal wall of mill

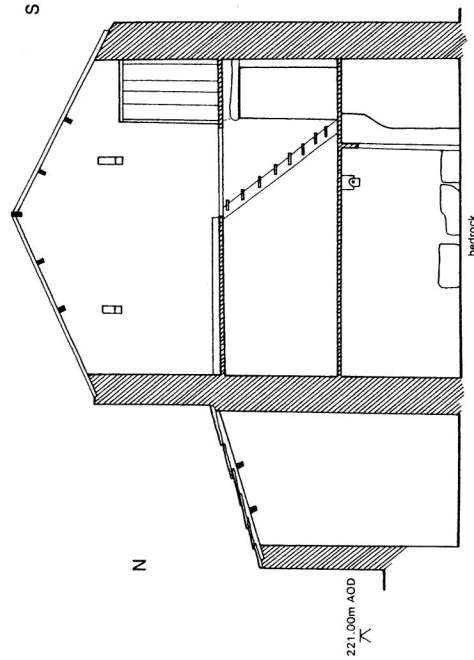

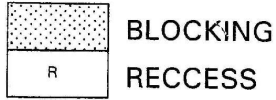


Elevation 14: east internal wall of mill

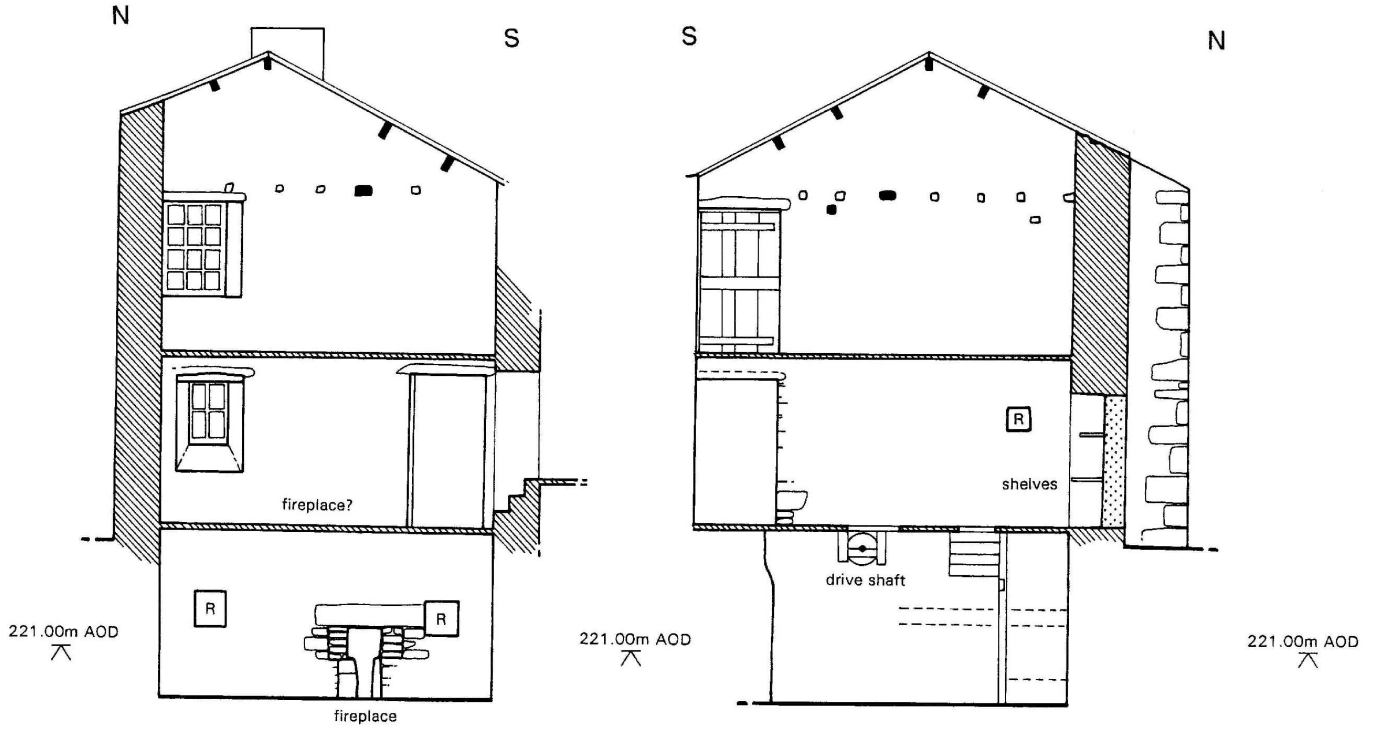

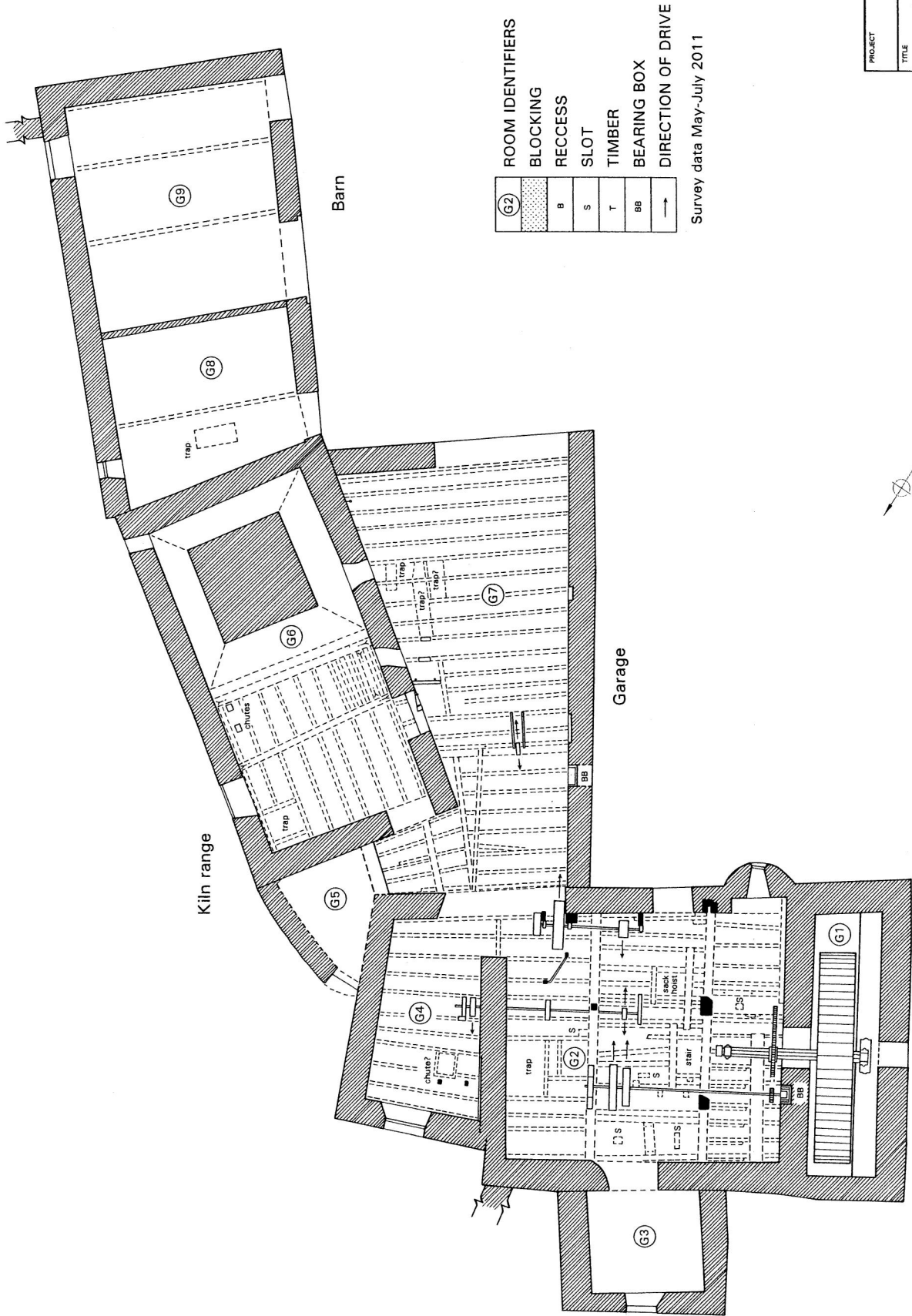


Elevation 15: east internal wall of 'domestic' end of mill

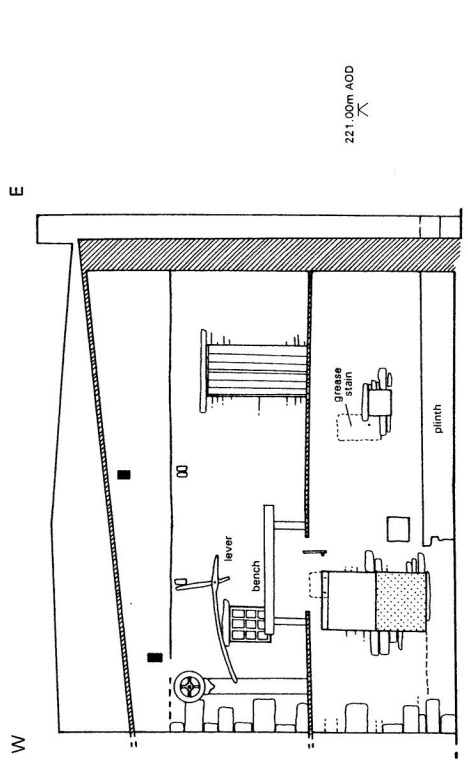
Elevation 21: south internal wall of garage



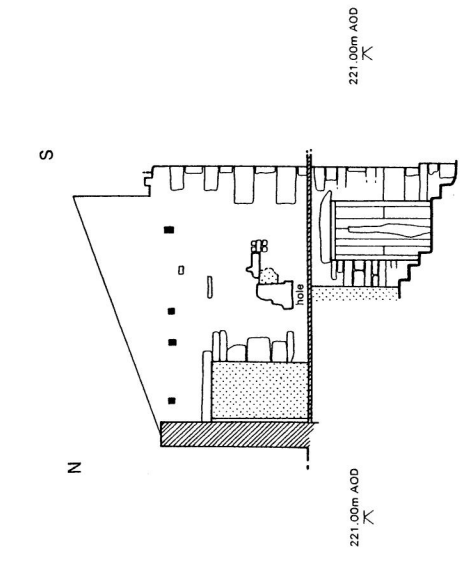

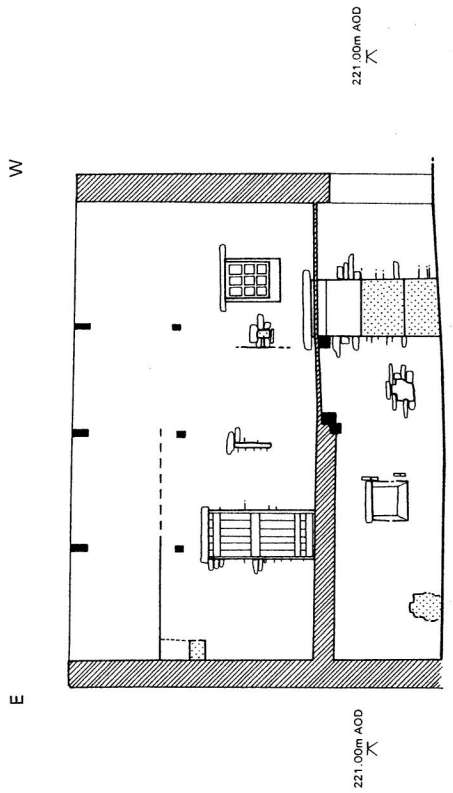
Elevation 19: south external wall of kiln range



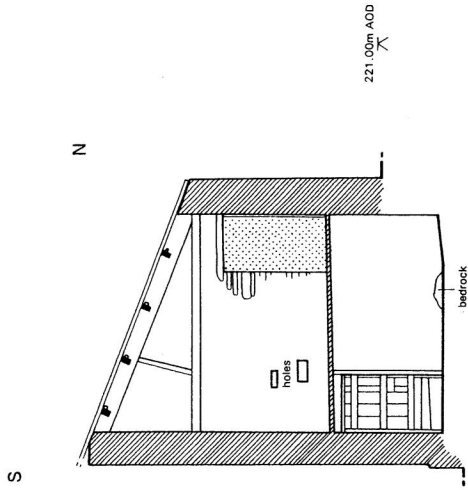

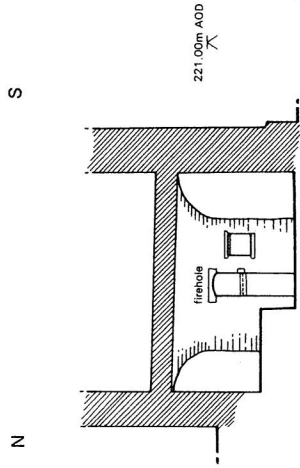

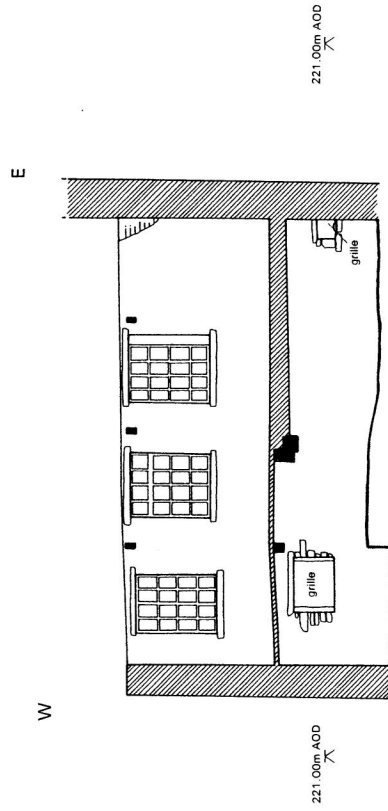
Elevation 25: south internal wall of kiln range



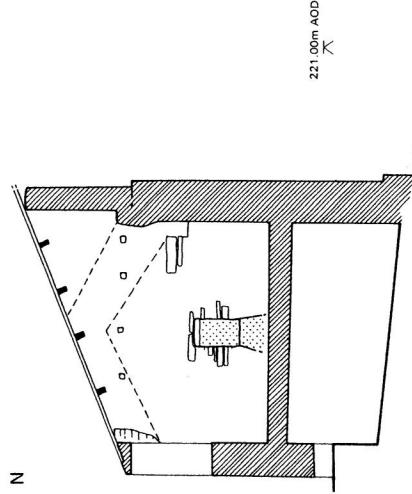

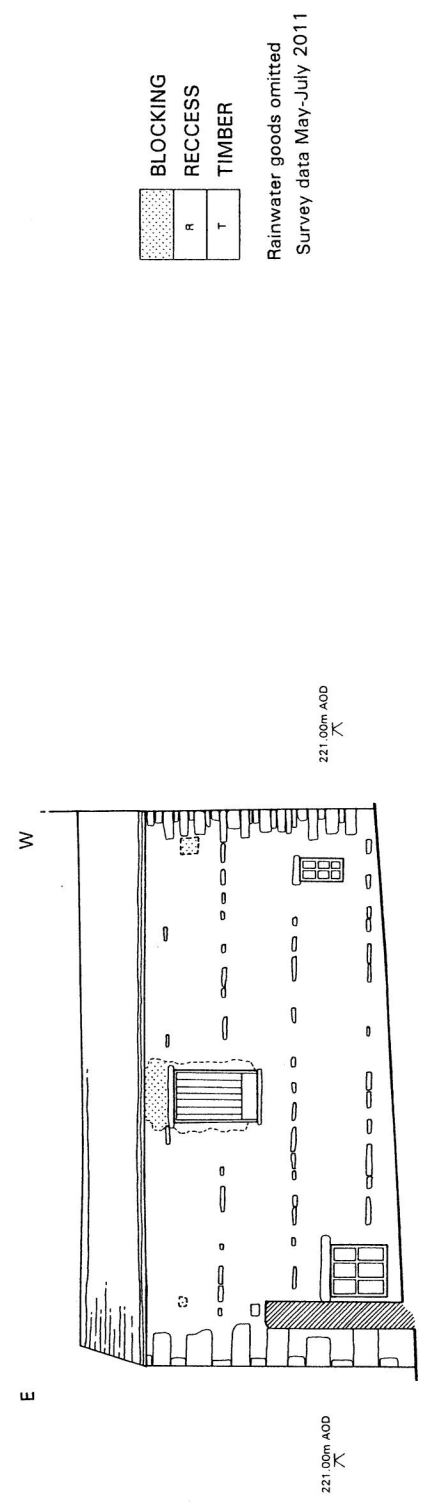




Elevation 7: east external wall of barn

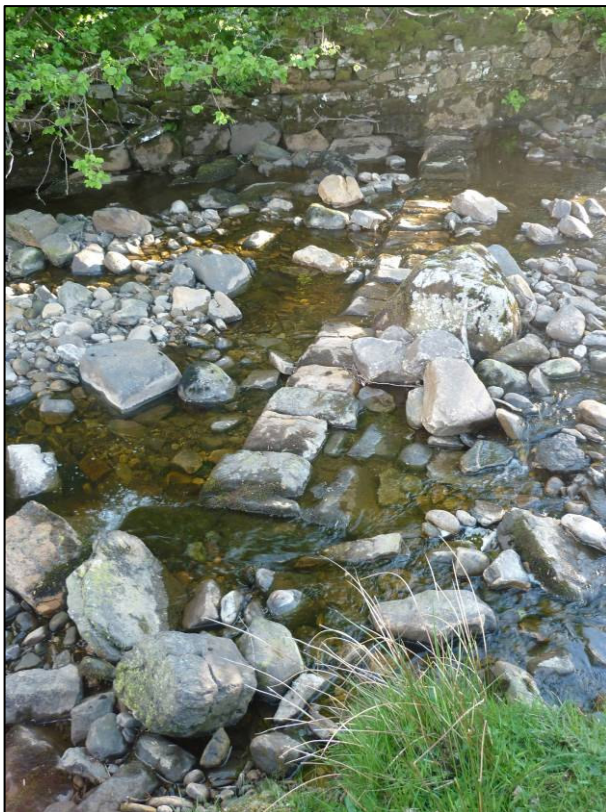


Plate 6: Leas House survey area, weir (Site 12a), looking W (photo 4/982).

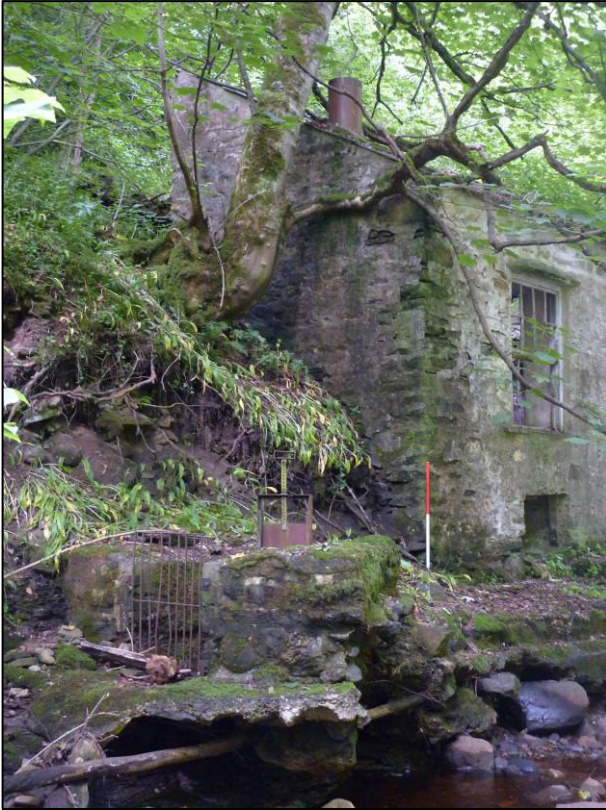

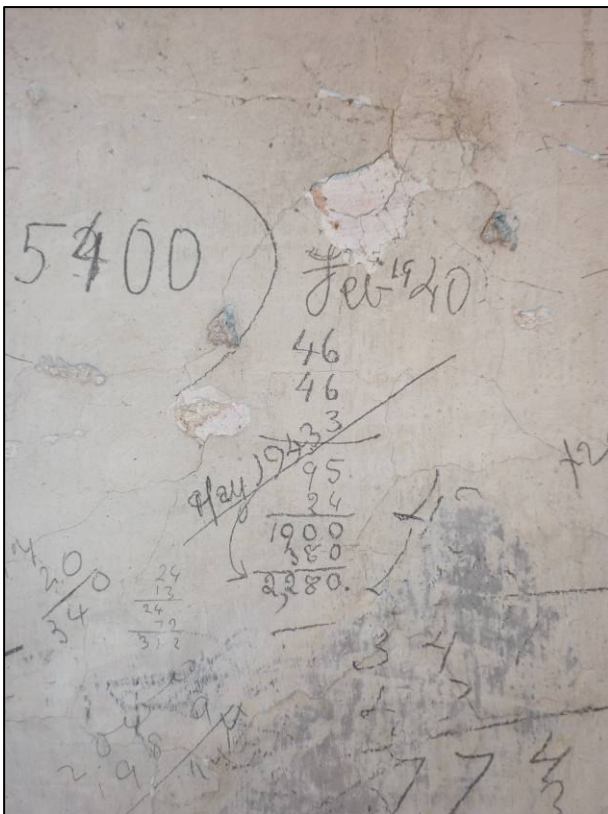

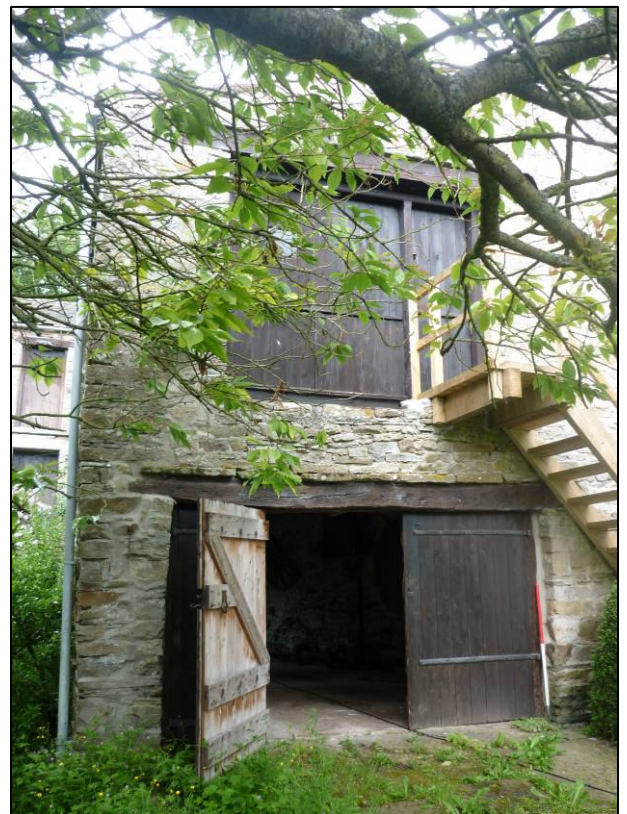

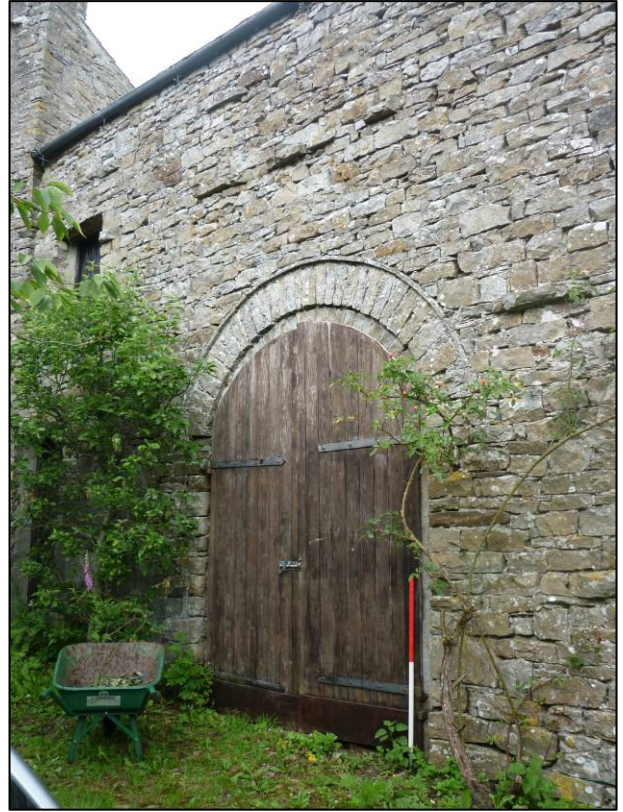
