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

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Plan of the House, or third floor




Plan of the Malt Kiln, within the Castle




Section of the Malt Kiln in the Castle




1782 ground floor plan (Source: King 1782, 326).




1816 ground floor plan (Source: Whitaker 1816).




1859 ground floor plan (Source: Jones 1859, facing p151).
















Plate 6: 1787 engraving of the east side of Harewood Castle by Sparrow.




Plate 11: Interior of Harewood Castle by J C Buckler, 1817, looking south (Harewood House Trust).




Plate 12: Harewood Castle by Whitaker (1816), looking south, reproduced by Jones (1859).




Plate 13: The buffet (left) and carvings over the main entrance (right) by Whitaker (1816), reproduced by Jones (1859).




Plate 20: East side of castle (elevations 2 to 8), looking north-west (May 2000).




Plate 24: South side of castle (elevations 9 to 13), looking north (May 2000).




Plate 26: North internal elevation of hall block (elevation 19) (May 2000).




Plate 33: Window W35 in north side of north wing (elevation 28) (May 2000).




