Description of Works, Monitoring and Results: <p>The site was visited by L. S. Bray following a report that one stone had been knocked down and another two damaged. The visit identified the fallen stone as stone C on the RCHME plan, the northernmost in the row. It had been replaced upright (see attached photo), but considerable disturbance and widening of the socket was apparent. Tracks in the grass suggested the damage was caused by vehicle impact. The stone immediately to the north of stone B was seen to be damaged, probably also by vehicle impact with several small fragments having been chipped from it (see attached photo). The second reported damaged stone could not be found. Inspection of the remainder of the row suggested it to be in good condition, although the height of the vegetation precluded a detailed examination.</p>			Date of Site Visit(s): <p>6th August 2008</p>
